Powered by triple Mercury outboards, carrying 564 gallons of fuel and fitted with a single practical head, it blends offshore capability with straightforward day-boat functionality. - What are the key dimensions? The 39 Offshore has an **LOA** of 39 ft (12.09 m) and a **beam** of 11 ft (3.5 m).
- What propulsion and fuel does it use? It runs triple Mercury **outboards** with

**Gas/Petrol** fuel.

## Owner Experience Review

---

Owners who operate the 39 Offshore by YELLOWFIN tend to push it hard: it's commonly used for offshore sportfishing, tournament runs, fast weekend trips, and mixed family cruising, according to real-world reports. Sea trials in the magazines support these accounts, praising a stepped deep V hull and broad beam that help keep the boat relatively dry and steady in rough conditions. It tracks responsively and holds course well, and with high-output outboards many reviewers have described its performance as “blazingly fast”—one owner even said, “I’ve broken the 70 mark twice maybe.”

The design emphasizes fishing functionality and helm ergonomics. Owners and reviewers note a large, uncluttered cockpit, a spacious forward area, a 165 gallon fish box, multiple livewells, plus bolster seating and conveniently placed electronics. Accessibility is repeatedly praised: “I love the layout of the lazarette on this and all Yellowfins. You can access everything very easily.” On the maintenance front, several owners reported lower unit cracking with early Yamaha XTO 425 installations; some units were replaced and warranty or claims processes often involved dealers, Yamaha and YELLOWFIN. Fortunately, the tidy lazarette and engine-area layout typically simplifies diagnostics and routine servicing.

## Pros and Cons

- Dry, stable offshore ride from the stepped deep V and beam that testers and owners highlight.
- Fast, sure tracking handling; several testers call it “blazingly fast,” and one owner reports breaking the 70 mark.
- Fishing-first layout with a large cockpit, roomy bow, a 165 gallon fish box and multiple livewells.
- Multiple owners reported lower unit cracks on early Yamaha XTO 425 installations, with some requiring replacement under warranty.
- Resolving drivetrain issues sometimes meant navigating dealer, Yamaha and YELLOWFIN warranty channels.
- Beyond the XTO lower unit threads, publicly shared long term owner data in our sources is limited.

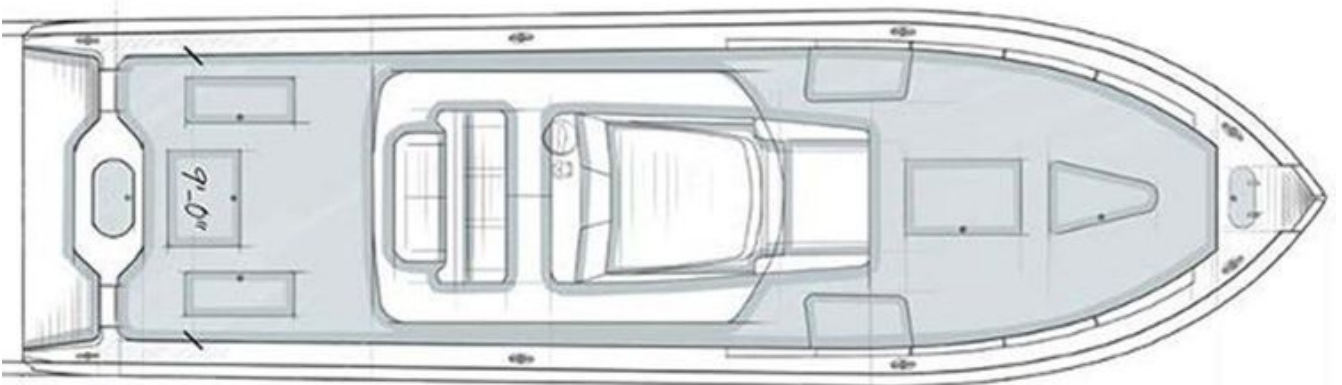
