## OVERVIEW

---

The C101 from YILDIZ SHIPYARD is a 141 ft (43 m) motor yacht built on a steel hull. Its naval architecture is by Ginton while the interior scheme is executed by Hotlab. Propulsion comes from twin MTU diesel engines, giving a cruising speed of 10.5 kn (12.08 mph) and a top speed of 14.5 kn (16.69 mph). The yacht's 28 ft (8.76 m) beam and 419 GT deliver generous volume, with sleeping arrangements for 12 (accommodates 9 overnight) across 7 heads and crew quarters comprising 5 cabins for 8 crew. ---

Opt for the C101 if you want a 43 m yacht that marries a classic motor yacht silhouette with the durability of a steel hull. The C101 is designed for steady, efficient cruising (10.5 kn cruise, 14.5 kn top) and offers substantial tankage (fuel 10,698.97 gal; water 1,738.25 gal) in a Monohull arrangement—an attractive choice for owners prioritizing volume, balanced performance, and robust construction. ## Features of the Model

---

- Constructed primarily from steel: a steel hull with Steel decks and a Monohull arrangement.
- Respected design collaborators: hull by Ginton with interior styling by Hotlab.
- Powered by twin MTU diesel units delivering 10.5 kn cruising speed and a 14.5 kn top speed.
- Large internal volume reflected in 419 GT within a 28 ft (8.76 m) beam.
- Guest and crew capacity that lists 12 in total, sleeping 9, served by 7 heads,

with crew accommodation of 5 cabins and 8 berths.

## Questions and Answers

---

Q: What are the principal dimensions of the C101? A: The yacht is **141 ft (43 m)** long overall, with a **28 ft (8.76 m) beam** and a **draft of 8.666 ft (2.6415 m)** , and it carries a volume of **419 GT** .

Q: What powers the yacht and how fast does it go? A: Twin **MTU** engines running on **Diesel** produce a **cruising speed of 10.5 kn (12.08 mph)** and a **maximum speed of 14.5 kn (16.69 mph)** .

Q: How is the yacht constructed? A: It is a motor yacht built with a steel hull, featuring **Steel** decks and a **Monohull** form, with hull lines by **Ginton** and interiors by **Hotlab** .

Q: What accommodations does it offer? A: The internal layout records an **accommodation count of 12** , with sleeping capacity of **9** , serviced by **7 heads** , and crew quarters comprising **5 cabins** and **8 beds** .

## Owner Experience Review

---

Owners who commissioned the C101 from YILDIZ SHIPYARD specified a

family friendly motoryacht capable of comfortably hosting three generations, and subsequent use has affirmed that brief. The internal circulation separates guest and crew movements to protect privacy, while the exterior spaces prioritize outdoor living: a sizable sundeck equipped with a bar/BBQ and a pop up lift, an aft beach club, and foredeck storage arranged in explorer style for tenders and toys. Interior appointments are bespoke and premium—rich timber finishes and designer furnishings—anchored by a full beam owner's suite on the upper deck with its own outdoor terrace and a private elevator that serves all three decks. Practical amenities for family and charter play include a dedicated lazarette for swimming, diving and casual fishing, complete with a compressor and gear storage.

Underway, the C101 performs like a high volume displacement yacht: prioritizing comfort and seakeeping over speed. Reported cruising numbers vary by source—some reference around ~13.5 knots while others cite a more conservative ~10.5 knot cruising figure—with top speeds generally in the mid teens; captain reports of passages in rough conditions and quick course changes indicate the yacht can handle mixed sea states. From an operational standpoint, owners typically plan around twin MTU 8V 2000 M72 main engines, RINA classification, and tankage on the order of ~40,000 L fuel and ~6,600 L water. The captain has noted a handful of unexpected mechanical issues during the first seasons of operation, but these were largely addressed through close shipyard and technical support during build and handover; there is no evidence of pervasive problems in public forums, and long term owner commentary remains limited.

## Pros and Cons

---

- Private elevator and an upper deck, full beam owner's suite provide enhanced privacy and convenient access.
- Layout amenable to charter with distinct guest and crew circulation for

discreet service.

- Generous outdoor amenities—sundeck bar/BBQ, beach club, and explorer style foredeck—are ideal for family gatherings and watersports.
- Not designed for high speeds; the emphasis is on volume and stable displacement cruising rather than rapid passages.
- Published cruising speed estimates differ between sources, so realistic performance expectations should be established.
- Early operational seasons included some unexpected mechanical failures reported by the captain, underscoring the importance of thorough maintenance and ongoing support.
