OVERVIEW

The Maiora 30 Walkaround (2024), a 30.5 meter motor yacht, elevates luxury cruising with a refined walkaround layout and expansive floor to ceiling glazing that floods the interior with natural light while framing uninterrupted, cinematic views of the horizon. Designed to host with effortless grace and to offer quiet retreats, she accommodates up to 10 guests across 5 sumptuous cabins with 5 bathrooms, while 3 crew cabins configured for up to 5 crew members ensure discreet, attentive service. The full beam master suite sits on the main deck for privacy and convenience, and the lower deck presents two generous VIP cabins alongside two additional guest cabins, a versatile plan equally suited to family voyages or entertaining friends aboard this contemporary performance cruiser.

Beneath the elegant lines lies engineering that inspires confidence: twin MAN V12 2000 engines, each delivering 2000 hp through ZF V drive gearboxes, provide assured responsiveness and a top speed of 22 knots with a comfortable cruising speed of 19 knots. Hotel systems are sustained by two KOHLER generators rated at 45 kW apiece. With a beam of 7.5 meters and a draught of 2.1 meters, the yacht displaces approximately 110 tons at full load, offering notable volume and stability. Long range capability is assured by a 12,500 liter fuel capacity and a 3,000 liter freshwater reserve, enabling extended passages with minimal interruption.

Every aspect of the Maiora 30 Walkaround reflects meticulous craftsmanship and seaworthy poise. Presented like new and thoughtfully specified, she represents a rare turnkey opportunity for discerning buyers to step aboard a modern superyacht ready to cruise immediately with grace, confidence, and style.

DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Electrical equipment

A comprehensive Furuno navigation suite anchors the raised pilothouse helm, where an integrated monitoring system is paired with two 24-inch Hatteland monitors and two 19-inch Hatteland touchscreens. Precision comes courtesy of Furuno GPS, a Furuno DRS12A four-foot open array radar, a Furuno graphic echosounder, and a Furuno satellite compass, all complemented by an Airmar weather station and an Airmar log/speed/temperature data-only sensor with echosounder. Command is effortless with the Furuno autopilot, AIS, and VHF DSC Class A GMDSS. On the flybridge helm, one Furuno 16-inch multifunction touchscreen display works in concert with an autopilot second-station repeater and a Furuno remote handset, while in the crew dinette a dedicated monitoring system keeps vital vessel data instantly accessible.

Tenders

A Williams D505 tender powered by a Yanmar 110 bhp diesel delivers swift, surefooted transfers between ship and shore and agile exploration throughout the anchorage.

Galley

The galley is appointed for gourmet service with a Miele 90 cm cooker hood drawing above a Miele 90 cm induction hob, paired to a Miele 90 cm oven for precise heat and consistency. Daily operations are streamlined by a Miele 60 cm dishwasher and a dedicated ice-maker, while cold storage is generous with a Liebherr refrigerator standing 185 cm tall and 60 cm wide, plus an additional 60 cm refrigerator. Entertaining flows naturally on the flybridge, where bar

furniture integrates a sink, an icemaker, and a cooler drawer for effortless al fresco hospitality. In the crew dinette, practical amenities include a sink, a compact under-counter Miele minibar 60 cm, and a full Miele laundry suite with washing machine and dryer.

Accommodations

Thoughtfully arranged accommodations welcome ten guests across five cabins, supported by three crew cabins for five professionals. The master suite commands pride of place on the main deck, while the lower deck hosts two VIP cabins and two guest cabins, all designed for privacy and quiet repose. Comfort is assured by five guest bathrooms, complemented by two crew bathrooms and a convenient day-head for seamless circulation. For the crew, one dedicated captain's cabin for one person is joined by two twin cabins providing berths for four, ensuring efficient service and a well-rested team.

Mechanical

Performance and reliability are delivered by twin MAN V12 2000 engines rated at 2000 hp each, showing 360 hours as of Oct 2025, driving through ZF series gearboxes in V Drive configuration. Shipboard power is assured by two Kohler generators of 45 kW each, with 1065 hours as of Oct 2025. Climate control is robust, featuring a Condaria system at 180,000 BTU supplemented by an 18,000 BTU microchiller serving the tech room. Precise low-speed handling comes via electric bow and stern thrusters rated 28 kW and 16 kW respectively, while the electrical system runs 380 V, three-phase, 50 Hz for dependable, global-ready operation.
