Her generous beam imparts an interior volume more commonly found on larger superyachts, while a fiberglass hull and structure promise a quiet, solid ride with lower upkeep—an appealing combination for owners who value both comfort and seaworthy capability.

Boarding introduces a succession of outdoor living environments designed for sunset cocktails and sunlit relaxation. A sweeping aft deck invites alfresco dining and unbroken vistas, flowing through wide-opening doors into a bright main salon enclosed by expansive windows. The interior spaces are composed to suit both formal gatherings and casual family life: an elegant lounge for conversation, a dining area that shifts seamlessly from intimate to celebratory, and a thoughtfully equipped galley ready for anything from relaxed breakfasts to chef-driven tasting menus.

Sleeping quarters are arranged for extended cruising in genuine comfort. The owner's suite offers generous volume and private seclusion, while guest staterooms are exquisitely finished and attended by well-appointed bathrooms—five heads in total—so each cabin reads as its own tranquil refuge. Superior joinery, soft fabrics, and restrained detailing create an atmosphere that is simultaneously sophisticated and warmly livable, whether your itinerary takes you through the Sea of Cortez or along the Pacific Riviera. Powered by twin MTU diesel inboard engines, she delivers confident, efficient performance and a reassuring sense of range. Large fuel reserves paired with ample freshwater capacity equip her for long passages or prolonged weekends offshore. Practical features such as a wide swim platform provide effortless water access for tenders, snorkeling, and evening dips, while plentiful on-deck

stowage keeps toys and gear neatly concealed yet readily available.

Every element has been arranged to emphasize gracious life at sea: a fluid indoor-outdoor flow, generous headroom, and the hushed comfort afforded by a well-insulated fiberglass hull. Equally suited as a private family cruiser or an elegant venue for entertaining, this yacht offers the enduring pleasures of yachting with a modern, understated sensibility.

For those seeking a 100-foot platform that balances volume, range, and timeless style in one harmonized package, this 2012-built vessel in Mexico represents a compelling opportunity—ready to be enjoyed, admired, and explored.

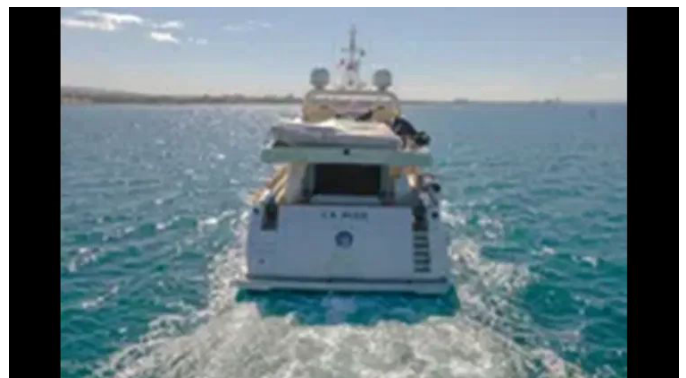

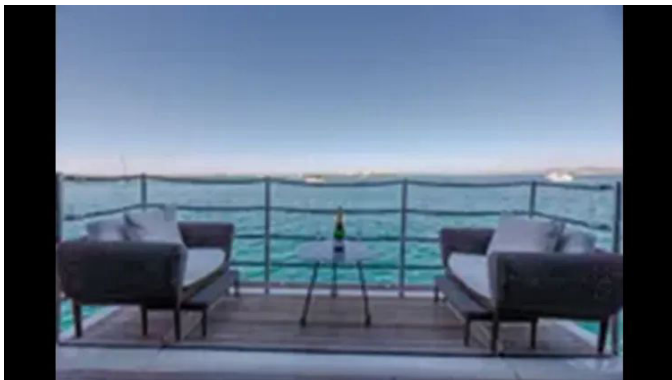

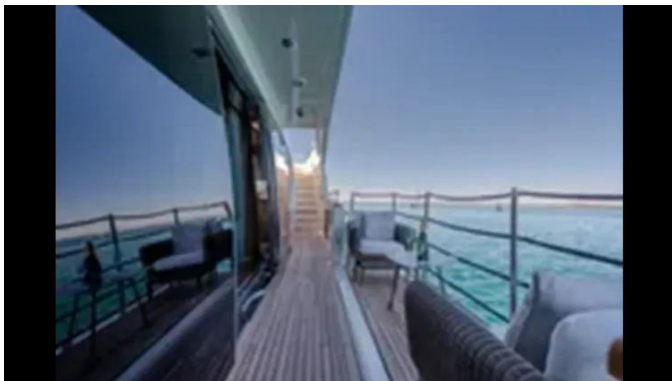

# DETAILED DESCRIPTION

---

## Description

---

Preliminary listing: a first glimpse at a meticulously specified yacht, with full photography and comprehensive details to follow. Enquire now to secure priority access as updates are released.

## Other details

Step inside a salon conceived for effortless indoor–outdoor living, where an aft manual glass sliding door with a stainless steel frame opens to the cockpit and fixed lateral panoramic glass windows to starboard flood the space with light. Concealed overhead lighting, a fitted carpet with soundproof lining, and a Bose Hi-Fi system set a refined mood for the Seamphony master audio/video media server, iPod docking station, Blu-ray/DVD player, and a 46" LCD TV, while four additional speakers in the cockpit extend the soundscape outside. Comfort and connectivity come naturally with a cordless telephone and two electric Roman blinds serving the portside glass window. The dining area elevates every gathering with complete tableware and cutlery for twelve, a lacquered dining table on a stainless steel frame measuring 2400 mm by 1000 mm, and eight leather chairs. Overhead, ceiling openings with electrically operated sliding 3Form closures and integrated spotlights pair with architectural lighting panels, all set above a plush, sound insulated fitted carpet. Two electric Roman blinds ensure ambience at the touch of a switch. Designed for serious culinary pursuits, the galley features a side-by-side fridge/freezer rated at 504 lt and 230 V with icemaker, complemented by an additional 141 lt refrigerator and a 98 lt freezer for expanded cold storage. A ceramic electric 4+1 ring cooktop with pan holders, an electric oven, a microwave oven, and a dishwasher for twelve streamline preparation and service, while a 230 V

extractor fan with external outlet keeps the air fresh. Practical touches include vinyl flooring, Venetian blinds, a manual side exit door with electric lock, a garbage compactor, and a technical locker housing the main deck electric panel and electronic equipment. The full beam master stateroom is a private sanctuary, anchored by a double bed with mattress, pillows, bedspread, and sheets, and enriched by natural ventilation under the mattress and a leather upholstered headboard. A Seamphony media server unit and a 32" LCD TV deliver entertainment, while a lateral panoramic hull window frames the sea. Bespoke furnishings include a desk with drawers and glass top partnered with a leather armchair and bookshelves; a dressing table with mirror, two drawers, glass top, and leather ottoman; and two leather armchairs with a coffee table. Smart storage abounds with four drawers under the bed, a walk in wardrobe with mirror, shelf, and side wall curtains, and a wardrobe hanger with a mirrored door. Air conditioning with manual control and external air inlets completes the climate comfort, and a digital safe secures valuables. The day head combines practicality and polish with a ceramic electric WC, an electric ventilation fan, Laminam flooring, a mirror, and a washbasin set on a wooden countertop. A WC control panel with a gauge indicating three quarters and full levels and wooden lacquered Venetian blinds underscore the thoughtful detailing. On deck and throughout, premium additional equipment enhances capability and pleasure: full teak decks; stern and bow thrusters; twin watermakers; and comprehensive stabilization that includes fin stabilization by Trac and four Mitsubishi gyro units, ensuring poise both underway and at anchor. The yacht is configured with a US 60 Hz electrical system and is powered by two Kohler 55 kW generators showing 14,220 hours. Seamless circulation is assured by electric sliding doors at the aft salon and the side balcony, as well as pantograph mounted doors in the galley and lobby. Social zones adapt instantly, thanks to a reversing cockpit sofa that can face forward or aft, while eight underwater lights set a dramatic nighttime scene. Entertaining is effortless with dual Gaggenau electric grills, Loro Piana

soft goods, and an audiophile grade audiovisual system installed in Italy by seasoned US specialists. The master suite features his and hers heads for ultimate privacy. On the foredeck, an awning and misters provide cool shade, supported by electric equipment on the bow, and the timeless profile is finished with elegant wood cap rails. Power comes from twin MTU diesel engines, each rated at 2600 hp, driving inboard and showing 3922 hours apiece. This robust pairing delivers confident performance, long legged range, and the smooth, composed ride expected of a yacht in this class.

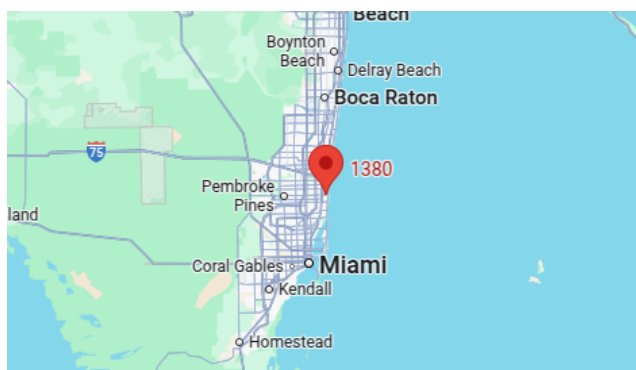
