OVERVIEW

The motor yacht Endless Sun offers an exceptional high-end platform for exploring American coastlines and far-flung seas. Immaculately kept and presented turn-key with comprehensive outfitting, she stands poised to deliver memorable moments for owners and guests alike. Stretching a full 100 feet with five lavish cabins plus separate crew accommodation, she pairs striking Italian styling with a fresh, modern sensibility and a poised, seaworthy demeanor.

Constructed by Azimut-Benetti S.p.A. in Viareggio, Italy, in 1999 and comprehensively refreshed between 2021 and 2023, this 100-foot luxury motor yacht showcases warm, elegant joinery, pale leather accents, and refined stone surfaces throughout, offering a compelling gateway into the superyacht arena at an attainable level.

Her commanding 24-foot beam translates into exceptionally generous interior volume while still preserving wide walk-around side decks, ensuring effortless movement along the yacht's exterior.

Endless Sun provides five guest staterooms amidships for ten, arranged as two king suites, one queen stateroom, and two twin cabins. Each includes an ensuite bath; the owner's suite adds dual vanities and a walk-in wardrobe. Forward, accommodations for up to four crew span two cabins, each with its own ensuite.

Highlights encompass an expansive upper deck ideal for hosting, a generous, beautifully finished main salon, an additional aft dining space, foredeck sunpads and lounging, and a versatile beach club/garage that opens to the sea for watersports, plus a full-service galley and state-of-the-art navigation and control systems in the pilothouse and flybridge.

DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Key features

Designed for effortless enjoyment, this yacht showcases a large sundeck perfect for entertaining, a spacious, well-appointed main salon for refined relaxation, and an inviting aft deck dining area that sets the stage for alfresco meals. Forward, a dedicated foredeck lounging and sunbathing area invites long, sun-soaked days, while a versatile beach club/garage stands ready for all your water activities. Culinary ambitions are met by a full galley, and confidence at the helm is elevated by updated, state-of-the-art helm and flybridge electronics.

Recent updates (2022/2023)

A comprehensive program of mechanical and systems enhancements includes new pistons and sleeves by RPM Diesel, an upgraded stabilizer system with new NAIAD stabilizers, new five-blade high-efficiency propellers, and added line cutters. Six of eight heads were upgraded to self-contained macerator systems, the black water tank and sensor were renewed, and both 30 kW gensets were replaced in 2019 and 2020. Climate control was modernized with ten A/C air handler units and two chillers replaced, while a new watermaker was installed. Maneuverability and thrust were improved with a higher-horsepower bow thruster and new bow thruster lines, complemented by two new water heaters, a new engine fan air intake and exhaust system, renewed wet exhaust sections of the risers, and a one hundred percent thru-hull replacement from stem to stern.

On deck and below the waterline, the yacht benefits from new anchor windlasses, a new chain wash-down system, a replaced boarding ladder

system, and an upper-level teak deck replaced with a striking compass rose inlay. Watertight doors were renewed, underwater lights refreshed, and the bottom received fresh paint with PropSpeed, completed at Rybovich, and backed by a two-year warranty through January 2025.

Navigation, monitoring, and power systems were equally elevated with new Garmin equipment in the wheelhouse and on the flybridge, new VHF radios in both stations, Garmin camera systems covering aft and integrated to the wheelhouse, and an added FLIR night vision camera system. Night operations are further supported by a new spotlight system to port and starboard. Engine interface and control were refined with replaced and renewed MTU controls, while a new Atlas power system delivers worldwide power compatibility (110/220/230/240) 50/60 Hz. Connectivity and oversight are assured by Starlink internet and a cloud-based SuperYacht Support maintenance platform.

The interior was refreshed with new décor including carpet, carpet runners, and new white leather couches, a new window shade system in the main salon alongside new blinds, a 72-inch TV in the main salon, and new TVs in all five guest quarters. The galley received new appliances, the space was converted to refrigerators with two additional freezers added in the garage, high-end stainless steel washer-dryers were installed in the garage, and the crew enjoys a new shower.

For outdoor living, a new refrigerator and a modern electric grill were added on the sundeck, new canvas covers were fitted on the upper deck, and entertainment is elevated by a new Fusion stereo with XM on the upper deck. The toy inventory expands with the addition of a Spark jet ski and a Seabob F5.

Main salon

Step in from the aft deck through the double curved sliding glass doors and the main salon immediately reveals its generous volume, bathed in natural light from oversized port and starboard windows that are thoughtfully shaded

from direct sun by the walk-around overhangs. Large windows with adjustable privacy shades frame the view, while an adjustable blind system offers complete control of privacy and ambience across varying light conditions. Immediately to port, a marble-topped wet bar with a glasses rack, ice machine, and sink sets an elegant tone for entertaining. Opposite and along both sides, two large crescent-shaped designer upholstered sofas in elegant white leather provide stain-resistant, easily maintained seating, gathered around a central adjustable three-part wood cocktail table. Beautiful inlaid wood craftsmanship and ample built-in cabinet storage enrich the space, complemented by a designer carpet with a protective cover underfoot.

Forward, a large 72 frame TV screen can display art or panoramic scenes to set the mood, while the dining area anchors the far end of the salon for seamless transitions from lounging to formal meals. Looking aft, a second TV accommodates multiple programs or sporting events, and both this display and the stereo equipment and electronics stow neatly behind a rolling cabinet door. Thoughtful amenities, including storage for various board games, combine with LED overhead lighting and mood floor lighting to create a refined, inviting atmosphere tailored for both lively gatherings and quiet evenings at sea.

Dining area

Forward in the main salon, the dining area is anchored by an elegant eight-person table showcasing beautiful inlaid wood. This large, expandable and adjustable dining table can be set for six or eight guests as desired and is complemented by eight chairs, ensuring every place is perfectly appointed. Lighting can be tailored for breakfast, a formal dinner, or a focused workspace, shaping the ambience to suit the moment. Adjacent cabinetry provides an abundance of built-in storage for the high-end dining room set, keeping service pieces conveniently at hand while preserving a refined, uncluttered aesthetic.

On deck day head

Positioned forward of the main salon on the starboard side, the on-deck head and powder room showcases rich dark wood paired with a marble sink and marble flooring, providing a convenient facility for guests entering from the main salon while leaving a refined and lasting impression.

Galley

Set forward of the main salon on the port side, this well equipped galley is designed for effortless service and discreet preparation. A dedicated service door offers direct access to the main salon and dining area and is kept closed during food preparation, while crew have their own entry through a door leading to the exterior walk around deck. Abundant countertop and storage space centers on two generous granite countertops, complemented by all the necessary appliances and a stainless-steel sink with faucet for efficient, professional workflow. Along the entranceway, a set of large four bay refrigerators provides ample cold storage; formerly a combination refrigerator/freezer, this bank has been converted to refrigeration only and is complemented by a large capacity stand up freezer and an additional stand up refrigerator added to the garage.

Beach club/garage

Endless Sun features an aft transom garage section that folds down to create a beach club, transforming every anchorage or dock into your own waterfront entertainment venue. From the aft deck, access is effortless via the hydraulically deployed passerelle, leading to a sea-level haven where you can paddleboard, swim, float, or simply dangle your feet over the water as the crew deploys the jet ski from its remote-controlled slider. It is an ideal spot to

suntan, board a tender, and savor the view, while the garage provides upright storage for dive tanks, various water toys, and accessories.

Upstairs master stateroom

Endless Sun features an on-deck master, a privilege typically reserved for larger yachts, where expansive windows bathe the suite in natural light and place it only steps from the dining area and main salon—ideal for those who prefer not to climb stairs to reach their cabin. Appointed with a queen bed dressed with bed linens and complemented by bath towels, the suite includes a built-in desk oriented to the port-side window and a comfortable lounge seating area to starboard. Entertainment is at your fingertips with a TV and DVD with Direct TV, while practical luxuries include a walk-in closet, an ensuite head with shower, a granite sink, and plenty of additional built-in storage.

VIP stateroom

Step into the VIP stateroom, where a queen bed dressed in crisp bed linens is paired with plush bath towels for refined comfort. Entertainment is at your fingertips with a TV and DVD complemented by DirecTV, while thoughtful storage includes a hanging locker and a walk-in closet (WIC). An ensuite head with shower and sink enhances privacy and convenience, and stainless steel porthole covers provide total blackout for uninterrupted rest.

Downstairs master stateroom

The downstairs master stateroom centers on a king bed dressed in refined bed linens, with plush bath towels provided for added comfort. Entertainment is thoughtfully integrated with a TV and DVD system paired with DirecTV. Storage is ample, including a dedicated hanging locker and a generous walk-in closet.

The ensuite head features a shower and a double vanity with granite sinks, creating a private retreat of effortless elegance.

Port twin stateroom

Thoughtfully appointed for comfort and convenience, the port twin stateroom offers twin berths dressed in crisp bed linens, with plush bath towels provided. Entertainment is at hand with a TV featuring DVD and DirecTV service. A full-height hanging locker keeps personal items neatly stowed, while the ensuite head adds everyday ease with a shower and sink.

Starboard twin stateroom

Thoughtfully designed for comfort and privacy, the starboard twin stateroom features twin berths appointed with bed linens and bath towels, a TV and DVD with Direct TV for onboard entertainment, a hanging locker for wardrobe storage, and an ensuite head with shower and sink.

Crew quarters

Thoughtfully designed for comfort and efficiency, the crew area features two crew cabins accessible directly from the foredeck, each served by its own ensuite bathroom. Both cabins can be configured as two double berths, or as one single berth and one double berth in an upper/lower arrangement, allowing flexible accommodations to suit the voyage. A dedicated stall shower is positioned forward for added convenience.

Aft deck

A generous, varnished teak dining table anchors the space, offering elegant seating for eight guests, while walk-around side decks provide effortless access

to both port and starboard. A centerline, aft-facing boarding door opens to steps leading down to the swim platform and the garage, ensuring smooth transitions from alfresco dining to on-water adventures.

Flybridge

Command comes effortlessly from the spacious flybridge, where a helm station to port is appointed with canopy shading, a radar arch, autopilot, bow thruster controls, VHF, and two remotes for the spotlights.

Sundeck

The spacious sundeck is perfect for entertaining and taking in the views while at anchor, underway, or entering port, with three areas of seating that provide plenty of room for guests to relax and enjoy each other's company. A collapsible bimini shade extending forward of the radar arch, complemented by additional canopy shading, delivers generous protection when you wish to escape the sun yet still savor the fresh air.

Midship, white leather U-shaped seating surrounds a centered table for convivial dining and conversation, while aft a white leather L-shaped lounge invites relaxed lounging. Forward on the starboard side, another white leather L-shaped settee with a cocktail table creates a refined perch for taking in the panorama. Entertaining is effortless with a BBQ, a fresh water service sink, and a refrigerator discreetly integrated to keep refreshments at hand. The aft teak decking is distinguished by a custom compass rose inlay that underscores the yacht's craftsmanship, and ample storage beneath the seating keeps the deck beautifully clear.

Foredeck

The foredeck invites relaxation with two seating areas framing a large suntanning expanse topped with plush bunny pad cushions. Seamless anchoring is assured by two hydraulic windlasses, new in 2022, complemented by new ground tackle installed the same year. The setup includes two anchors with 300-foot and 200-foot lengths of chain led through 5/8-inch hawse pipes with integrated wash-down, while convenient chain locker access and a dedicated Bosun locker keep the area orderly. A forward shore power connection completes this versatile, well-appointed space.

Safety equipment

The yacht is equipped with two twelve-person liferafts, an ACR EPIRB, and a fire control system, delivering robust, dependable protection for guests and crew on every passage.

Exclusions

The sale specifically excludes the owner's personal items, while a jetski and a Seabob may be added as optional equipment under separate agreement.

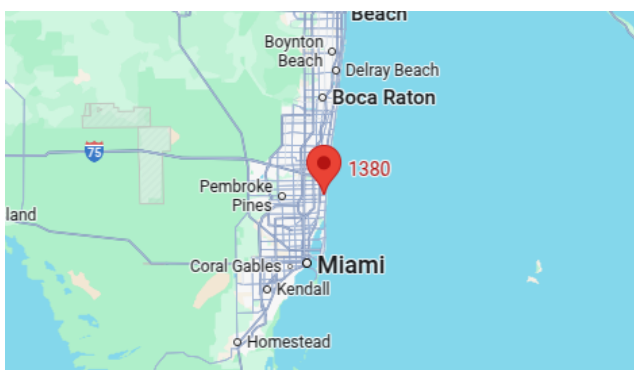
