OVERVIEW

Recently listed, this Hargrave luxury motor yacht is among the most individually outfitted and comprehensively equipped vessels afloat. She accommodates eight guests in four elegantly appointed staterooms, with comfortable living quarters for four crew, and her interior is finished in hand-treated walnut joinery paired with refined maple cabinetry to create a warm, sophisticated atmosphere. Outdoor life is celebrated with alfresco dining on both the aft deck and the flybridge, where a jacuzzi, a full bar and ample seating form an exceptional entertaining environment. Propulsion is provided by low-hour Caterpillar C32A mains with approximately 1,500 original hours, backed by Northern Lights 38 kW generators and a full Garmin navigation suite. Naiad stabilizers, a bow thruster and dual watermakers enhance true blue-water capability, while a Headhunter waste treatment system simplifies operations. A 15' AB RIB tender and a Marquipt 2,000 lb davit complete this refined Flybridge Motor Yacht—an elegant luxury yacht with genuine superyacht pedigree for confident blue-water cruising.



DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Highlights

LOLA T is a bespoke Hargrave Raised Pilothouse Motor Yacht, meticulously outfitted and thoughtfully customized to elevate every moment aboard. She welcomes eight guests in four sumptuous staterooms, each with an ensuite bath, complemented by private captain and crew accommodations for four. A luminous interior by Shelley DiCondina pairs a palette of light taupe, silver, and white with rich, high gloss walnut joinery and maple cabinetry, creating a refined harmony of texture and tone. Al fresco entertaining unfolds across multiple decks: the aft deck centers on a generous dining table with five teak chairs and an aft bench seat, while the expansive sun deck indulges up to twenty four guests with abundant seating, dining areas, a full bar, shaded sunpads, a gas grill, and a built in hot tub. The boat deck carries a 15' AB tender served by a Marquipt 2000 lb davit. Powered by twin Caterpillar C32A engines with low original hours, LOLA T sprints to 23 knots and cruises comfortably at 20 knots; with 3200 gallons of fuel, she offers a maximum cruising range of 1000 nm.

Main salon & dining area

A grand sweep of high gloss walnut joinery and maple cabinetry sets a polished tone throughout the main salon and dining area, where a custom upholstered L shaped sectional anchors the lounge alongside two leather club chairs. A marble topped cocktail table and a large end table with concealed storage create an elegant conversation setting, while aft a walk up bar with a white marble top, U Line icemaker, sink, and glass storage keeps service effortless. Entertainment is centered on a Samsung 75" LED Smart TV, discreetly integrated to preserve sightlines. Forward, a custom rectangular

maple dining table seats eight in upholstered comfort, flanked port and starboard by a built-in console buffet capped in Calcutta marble with custom lofted storage. The forward bulkhead conceals two Sub-Zero refrigerators and two wine coolers, complemented by floor-to-ceiling lofted storage designed expressly for stemware. An upholstered forward bulkhead with custom decorative sconces, a sculpted tray ceiling, and overhead soffits with walnut borders and integrated lighting frame the room, while custom window treatments, bespoke wallcoverings, and Cantalupi LED lighting complete the ambiance. The day head is equally refined, featuring a Calcutta white marble vanity, marble inlay flooring, and a distinctive Sono sink with a twelve-inch slot drain, elegantly covered in Silestone with river rock and marble inlay, finished with custom wall covering and a polished chrome faucet.

Galley equipment

The galley is crafted for culinary confidence with White Macabuz Quartzite countertops and backsplash, a GE Monogram stainless steel refrigerator/freezer, and Sub-Zero refrigerator drawers faced in walnut. A GE Profile cooktop and oven pair with a GE Monogram microwave and GE dishwasher for seamless prep and cleanup, while a center island bar in matching Macabuz Quartzite integrates a sink for efficient workflow. A Franke stainless steel double sink with instant hot and stainless gooseneck faucets is supported by a GE garbage disposal and three pantries for provisioning. Conveniences include a Samsung 32" TV, a step-up settee with leather U-shaped seating and a large walnut table, expansive windows forward, port, and starboard, and durable WDI soundproof porcelain plank wood flooring underfoot.

Boat deck & bow equipment

On the boat deck and foredeck, seamless operations meet effortless relaxation. Boarding is simplified by Marquipt sea stairs, while safety is assured with two Revere 12 person life rafts. Ground tackle features a 316 stainless steel anchor weighing 210 lb on 300' of chain, handled by a Maxwell Nilsson VW4000 hydraulic windlass. The bow invites lounging with a bunny pad and forward seating with integrated storage, illuminated by bow deck lights. All exterior furniture enjoys renewed protection with all new canvas covers and cushions completed in 2025.

Flybridge equipment & tender

Beneath a full hardtop with a forward Isinglass panel, the flybridge is a private resort at sea. Two custom helm bench seats to port and starboard flank a full upper helm station to starboard, while two expansive L shaped settees with bench seating gather around a large adjustable high gloss teak dining table, complemented by two additional adjustable high gloss teak tables. A teak faced bar hosts a U Line refrigerator, two Sub Zero refrigerator drawers, a U Line clear ice machine, and four upholstered bar stools, mirrored by a built in jacuzzi with a teak bar top and three upholstered bar stools. Amenities include a Fire Magic gas grill, an EdgeStar top loading freezer, large sunpads shaded by the hardtop, chaise lounges, a built in cooler, a Fusion stereo driving six Wet Sounds overhead speakers, and a Marquipt Quick Lift 2000 lb davit. All cushions and covers are new in 2025. Tender: a 15' AB tender powered by a Suzuki 60 HP outboard completes the package.

Electronics & navigational equipment

Command and control are delivered by a comprehensive Garmin suite,

including 4 kW and 8 kW radar, a GHC20 autopilot, a Garmin 8000 flat screen, four Garmin 8617 17" monitors, and Garmin Grid 20 keypads. Handling is refined with Naiad stabilizer controls and a Naiad bow thruster control, while communications are supported by a Garmin VHF. A multifunction indicator provides depth, speed, temperature, and wind data. Entertainment and awareness are enhanced by KVH TracVision, three dome cameras, an ACR spotlight with remote, a KEP closed circuit TV system, and a commanding Kahlenberg M485 air horn.

Engine room & mechanical equipment

Meticulous engineering defines the machinery spaces: double Racor fuel filters protect the main engines, while Naiad stabilizers and a Naiad bow thruster ensure poised handling. Endurance at anchor is supported by two Blue Water watermakers producing 65 GPH each and a three unit Cruise Air chilled water A/C system rated at three tons per unit. A sea chest simplifies seawater intake, and a Reverso gear pump with dedicated oil change pumps streamlines service. Reliability is enhanced by two Jabsco A/C bilge pumps, two 30 gallon water heaters, and a Delta T filter/fan system. Driveline integrity comes via Tide Seal dripless rudders and Tides Seal dripless shaft logs, with an inline recirculation hot water pump for instant domestic hot water. Waste is managed by a Headhunter Tidal treatment system, and safety is assured by a SeaFire automatic fire extinguisher system paired with SeaFire smoke and temperature alarms.

Master stateroom

The full beam master is a sanctuary, centered on a king size upholstered berth with custom bedding and generous under berth storage. A custom upholstered bulkhead and headboard with large tufted panels add tactile

luxury, flanked by two marble topped nightstands with lamps and a built in dresser, with an upholstered settee to starboard. Entertainment is at hand via a Samsung 40" LED TV paired with a Bose sound bar. Custom window treatments and elegant oval portlights soften natural light. The His & Her bath presents marble countertops, two Kohler sinks with Grohe stainless faucets, and a centerline marble shower with a frosted glass enclosure, complemented by a Headhunter toilet system, teardrop portlights, and marble flooring.

Queen guest stateroom, port

On the port side, the queen guest stateroom features a queen berth with custom bedding and storage below, set against upholstered bulkheads and headboards in refined faux leather. Built in nightstands and a dresser keep belongings orderly, while a Samsung 40" LED TV provides entertainment. A cedar lined hanging closet preserves wardrobe freshness, and custom window treatments elevate the finish. The private bath offers a marble countertop, a full glass shower with a marble seat, a Kohler sink with a chrome faucet, marble flooring, and a Headhunter toilet. Adjacent on the lower foyer, convenience is amplified by a GE washer and dryer, large cedar lined storage closets, and durable quartzite flooring.

VIP guest stateroom, forward

Forward, the VIP stateroom presents a queen berth with custom bedding and storage drawers below, set before an upholstered bulkhead and headboard with tufted faux leather. Entertainment comes via a Samsung 40" LED TV. A private six foot lockable cedar lined walk in closet offers exceptional wardrobe capacity. The private bath is appointed with a marble vanity top, stall shower, sink, marble flooring, and a Headhunter system.

Crew quarters, aft

Aft crew accommodations are purpose built for comfort and efficiency. To port, the captain's cabin features a double berth that converts to twin berths, with storage and shelving above and below, a cedar lined hanging locker, a Samsung 19" LED TV, and a private bath with a stall shower, sink, and Headhunter system. To starboard, the crew cabin offers upper and lower oversized bunks with storage drawers and a hanging locker, served by a shared bath with a stall shower, sink, and Headhunter toilet. A welcoming crew dinette with settee and table anchors the common area, complemented by a custom six foot granite countertop with sink, a GE undercounter refrigerator, a GE microwave, a Samsung 28" TV, and a GE washer and dryer.

Electrical equipment

Electrical independence is secured by Northern Lights 38 kW generators with sound shields (port generator 1419 hours, starboard generator 1421 hours), supported by two Glendinning 100 amp Cablemasters and a 100 amp shore power connection in the bow locker. Charging is handled by Mastervolt battery chargers, with power quality protected by three Mastervolt 100 amp isolation transformers for both alternating and direct current.

Aft deck equipment & swim platform

The aft deck is tailored for gracious entertaining with bench seating fitted with upholstered cushions and a large teak table on a hi lo mechanism, accompanied by four teak dining chairs. A portside bar integrates a U Line refrigerator, U Line icemaker, and an adjacent sink, while a Samsung drop down 42" TV transforms the space for movie nights at anchor. An electric glass sliding door with a sensor opens to the salon, with stairways leading up

to the bridge deck and down to the lower crew quarters. Practical touches include a port locker for boarding ladders, aft stainless steel gates, teak decks, and a Euro style transom with stairways port and starboard descending to a teak swim platform. Removable handrails, stainless steel corner hawse pipes with rollers, removable cleats to port and starboard, freshwater washdown, and an electric lift door into the lazarette complete this versatile alfresco terrace.

Pilothouse equipment

The raised pilothouse commands with a Stidd leather captain's chair before a full helm station, accompanied by a step up L shaped leather settee and a maple table for chart work or quiet observation. A stairway with a secure grab rail leads directly to the flybridge deck, ensuring swift movement between command posts.

Convertible twin guest stateroom, stbd

To starboard, the convertible twin guest stateroom offers twin berths that join to form a queen berth when desired, set against a custom upholstered headboard. A removable nightstand, three hanging lockers with drawers and shelves, and custom window treatments elevate both function and finish. An oval portlight brings in natural light. The private bath is handsomely appointed with a marble countertop, shower, Kohler sink, chrome faucet, marble flooring, and a Headhunter toilet.
