OVERVIEW

Envision spending entire seasons aboard and you seek a boat that marries family-minded comfort with effortless hospitality: the 100-foot Hargrave luxury motor yacht Second Amendment merits close attention. Ideal for extended coastal passages or refined weekends at anchor, she projects the calm authority of a true superyacht while offering the intimate warmth of a private sanctuary.

She affords more than 3,500 square feet of indoor–outdoor living spread thoughtfully across the flybridge, main deck, and lower deck, concentrating volume and amenity where they most enhance day-to-day life. The arrangement favors practical livability—ample storage, generous circulation and a pronounced sense of interior space—so that the yacht reads larger than her dimensions might suggest. The effect is a flybridge motor yacht that is simultaneously grand and welcoming, with rooms that unfold naturally from one to the next.

A stroll through Second Amendment quickly makes evident how the principal social areas feel larger than those aboard many European yachts in this class. Guest staterooms are generously proportioned, bathrooms have an impressive scale, and the main salon and dining spaces are bright and open, while the upper deck has been conceived specifically for sociable gatherings. Thoughtfully designed around how owners actually use their vessels, this luxury cruising yacht can host cocktail receptions for 50-plus guests with ease, all the while retaining the composure and refinement expected of a high-end motor yacht.

From the beginning she was engineered with charter capability in mind—a pragmatic benefit for buyers who value future charter flexibility, potential income and simplified planning—but her current owners have kept her for private enjoyment only and have never placed her into charter, preserving her

as a polished private superyacht ready for the next chapter.

DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Yacht description and details

A serene palette of silvers, cool taupes, slate and dusty blues flows throughout the yacht, with salon windows set twenty eight inches above the floor to frame fabulous views from every vantage point. Overhead, coffered style taupe ceiling beams with white lacquer recessed panels are paired with upholstered white inserts, while all illumination is rendered in crisp LED squares and rectangles, the latter appearing as polished chrome triple fixtures thoughtfully positioned above the dining table and main seating area for sculpted, glare free light. At the heart of the salon, a walk around white marble bar with silver faux leather upholstery anchors the space, attended by three elegant bar chairs in embossed pearl snake suede, a dedicated service counter with clear ice and a sink, and flanked port and starboard by broad upholstered columns that meet the ceiling perimeter and visually tie into the coffered beams. Along the port side, pale pewter ultra suede upholstery envelops a large sofa, a smaller companion sofa and a full size chaise lounge, balanced by two custom white marble side tables. Forward, the dining salon wall presents two floor to ceiling storage cabinets with gray glass doors in walnut frames, divided by an upholstered panel composition that echoes the silver upholstered bar front and discreetly conceals the entrance to the dog house storage area. The Main Salon is finished in semi gloss Walnut with Toseva Taupe/Gray veneer, features two custom marble tables, a walk around Bianca quartzite bar, upholstered mullion columns, a dining console capped in Bianco Rhino, a 65" screen TV, a custom dining table and base, an American Leather Savino sofa, eight custom dining chairs, three snake suede bar chairs, and refined Concertex wall covering, all composed to deliver both visual richness and practical comfort.

The Day Head is a study in luminous stonework: the vanity and floor border are rendered in gray Emperador marble, the sink is crystal white marble, and the floor field and half the walls continue in the same crisp white stone, while the remaining walls are papered in a hand-screened silver palm leaf. Underfoot lies a Bianco Rhino marble slab with an Emperador Gray border, complemented by Phillip Jeffries Ellie's View wall covering, a La Toscana polished chrome single-lever faucet, and a Sono Bath Custom Hydros/Silestone vessel sink detailed with river rock, resulting in a restroom that feels both polished and tactilely inviting.

The Galley embraces a warm country-kitchen sensibility with a huge settee and expansive windows forward and to port and starboard. Worktops in white Macabus Quartzite—a fully natural stone tougher than granite—pair elegantly with stainless steel appliances and the yacht's signature LED square lighting. Equipment includes a GE Profile stainless steel refrigerator with matching appliances, a Franke stainless steel sink, Sub-Zero refrigerator drawers with custom gloss walnut fronts, a thirty-two inch Samsung TV, two pull-out pantry units in the hallway, and a generous walnut table with coordinating walnut cabinetry. In the lower hallway, two Sub-Zero refrigerators and a wine cooler expand provisioning and service capability, making the galley as capable for serious provisioning as it is graceful in presentation.

Approached over a Lower Foyer detailed with a large Quartzite Bianco Rhino slab framed in Emperador Gray, the Master Stateroom continues the cosmopolitan theme in a freshly squared plan. The full-wall headboard is composed of large tufted panels in pale gray faux leather, while geometric metal sconces complement Kravet 33976 511 Silken Opulence/Vapor Blue throw pillows and add a glint of glamour. Sheer window shades carry silky, fluid threads across the face, and shimmery platinum drapes provide full blackout for decadent mornings. Finishes include semi-gloss Walnut with Toseva Gray accents, an upholstered bed base in Majilite Ovation light gray with Antelope embossing, a free-standing bench in Romo Z453/01 Deuce

Moonbeam, a matching Majilite Ovation light gray Antelope embossed headboard wall, two Kohler sinks and two Grohe faucets, with marble and frosted glass completing the suite to deliver both spa like function and layered texture.

Both Port and Starboard Guest Staterooms feature twin beds that convert to queens with the effortless lift of half a nightstand, and each headboard wall echoes the master's tufting in a crushed pearl look faux leather to maintain an elegant continuity throughout the guest accommodations. Appointments include a Romo Z453/01 Deuce Moonbeam upholstered headboard wall, Majilite Ovation Light Gray with Embossed Antelope above the nightstands, drawers under the beds, and semi gloss walnut nightstand countertops. The VIP Stateroom is a second king, its headboard wall articulated as a series of rectangles tufted in a refined faux skin; the room is spacious, airy, and endowed with abundant closet space. The head is large, fully marble, and perfectly appointed, and a six foot locked storage closet in this area accommodates owner items for charter or extra gear. Finishes include semi gloss Walnut, a Majilite Baby Ostrich White upholstered headboard wall, a large walk in storage closet, drawers under the bed, dual window treatments, a Kohler sink, a Grohe faucet, and marble flooring that together create a serene and practical owner suite.

On the Flybridge, soft tones of taupe, steel blue and stone create a tranquil outdoor salon, while the bar front in Aqua Leather from Spinneybeck adds a sophisticated pop of color. An expansive thirty six foot entertaining zone flexes effortlessly from intimate gatherings to vibrant celebrations. Amenities include a spa tub, two helm benches, three Sub Zero refrigerators with an insulated cooler, a large U shaped outdoor sofa, a sunless sun pad, and a walk around bar with six leather barstools. An aft spa bar provides two additional stools, a side bar integrates a Sub Zero wine cooler and ice maker, and a grilling station with a fold down table completes this alfresco haven, making the flybridge both a private retreat and a full service entertaining

deck.

Crew accommodations comprise one Captain's Stateroom and two Crew Staterooms sleeping five. The Captain's Stateroom offers a queen bunk that conveniently splits into twins when needed, with capacious drawers below, additional storage above, and a huge hanging locker. The nightstand and headboard area supply ample outlets for personal electronics. Across the hall, two spacious crew cabins share a centrally located head for optimal functionality, ensuring that service and operations remain efficient and discreet.

Mechanical equipment is comprehensively specified for reliability and ease of service: a 316 stainless steel 210 lb anchor with three hundred feet of chain driven by a Maxwell Nilsson VW4000 windlass; four 4 inch stainless steel shafts in Aquamet 22 riding five 5 blade bronze propellers on main bronze struts designed for four 4 inch shafts; an emergency tiller; a Racor 1000 FG fuel filter/water separator serving each engine; Hynautic hydraulic steering adaptable to autopilot; Cruise Air chilled water three four ton units with Soft Start; Northern Lights generators 38 kW 60 Hz single phase two units with gauges and sound shields; Kraus & Naimer C80 booster switches for the isolation transformer two units; double insulation in the engine room and watertight bulkheads; Naiad Stabilizers Model 302 with 9.0 sq.ft. fins and a Datum controller; a double stabilizer and bow thruster backup pump on port and starboard transmissions; a Reverso gear pump GP 706 24C oil change pump for engines, gearboxes and gensets; Glendinning 100 amp Cablemasters with 125 foot cords at the transom two units; an additional 100 amp shore power connection inside a recessed bow locker; Glendinning controls with one remote; SeaFire smoke and temperature alarms in ten units; two thirty gallon water heaters; Mastervolt battery chargers—one eighty Amp 24V, one thirty Amp 24V, and one thirty Amp 12V; Delta "T" engine room filters and fan system; Tide Seal dripless rudders and dripless shaft logs; an in line recirculating hot water pump; dual generator exhausts; and a Sea Fire

automatic FM200 fire extinguisher system, all specified and arranged to prioritize redundancy, ease of maintenance, and safe long range passagemaking.

Interior equipment is curated for tactile luxury and quiet performance, including a gloss Walnut wood interior with Toseva wood veneer in the Main Salon, a custom ceiling soffit in the Main Salon, two bar stools in the galley, a stainless steel pull out pantry in the starboard walkway, and a custom designed wood and upholstered club chair in the aft Main Salon. The Lower Foyer features a marble floor with a three inch stainless steel inlay and a custom ceiling, with Samdam K Pro insulation between the Master and Lower Foyer for superior acoustic privacy. Bath appointments include Kohler Escale sinks in the VIP and Port and Starboard Guest Staterooms, five Grohe Essence lavatory faucets in Starlight polished chrome, eight Headhunter heads, a marble bathroom floor in the Starboard Guest, marble shower seats in both Port and Starboard Guest heads, and frameless clear glass shower doors in both guest bathrooms. Ingenious berth mechanisms abound: a sliding mechanism to allow one single bed to glide in the Starboard Guest Stateroom, a pneumatic lift for the twin bed in the Starboard Guest Stateroom, and a pneumatic lift for the bed in the Port Guest. Marble nightstand tops refine the Port Guest, Starboard Guest and Master Staterooms, with mirrored backs on closet doors in all three, while Majilite upholstery throughout unifies the tactile signature.

Exterior equipment amplifies versatility and safety with thirteen inch L shaped cleats at the swim platform, stainless steel baby gates on the aft deck, stainless steel corner hawse pipes with rollers and cleats to port and starboard on the aft deck, and generous aft deck seating. Entertaining elements include an aft deck wet bar with sink hidden beneath a lift up wing top, a varnished aft deck teak table with sliding and hi low mechanisms, and a TV on a fold up lift, all served by an electric aft deck sliding door with sensor and manual override. A stairway from the aft deck grants direct access to the

aft crew cabins, with a dedicated locker for the boarding ladder. On the flybridge, a forward L shaped wet bar with four bar stools and a solid granite top partners with a custom helmsman chair with storage, cup holders at both sides of the port and starboard settees, stainless steel footrests for the forward starboard FRP cabinet and seating as well as for the port FRP cabinet and seating, custom FRP side cabinetry with lift up tops for insulated coolers, additional thin custom FRP cabinets to starboard, and a second custom helmsman chair with storage. An American Whirlpool hot tub with FRP seating is crowned by a varnished teak countertop at the hot tub bar with bar stools, while an FRP cabinet houses a Fire Magic BBQ grill. Signaling and deck lighting are assured by a Kalenburg air horn, an FRP bow seat with storage and non skid finish, eight waterproof bow deck lights, and two quartz floodlights. Appliance selections are robust and yacht grade: a GE white washer and GE white dryer in the Crew Lounge, a GE white refrigerator in the Crew Lounge, a GE white washer and GE white dryer in the Lower Foyer, a GE Profile stainless steel refrigerator in the Galley, two Sub Zero walnut panel refrigerator drawers in the Galley, a GE Profile black cooktop with stainless steel oven, a GE Profile stainless microwave vented outside, a GE Profile stainless trash compactor, a GE Profile stainless dishwasher, a GE black disposal, a Blanco stainless galley sink, a Blanco 441408 polished chrome faucet, and an Insta Hot and filter faucet in the Galley. In the Main Salon, two U LINE 1215WCB 00A black wine coolers, a Kohler Compass white sink, and a Kohler chrome faucet elevate service. On deck, a U Line stainless refrigerator and a U Line stainless ice maker enhance the aft deck, while the flybridge features a U Line stainless refrigerator, Sub Zero overlay panel refrigerator drawers, a U Line stainless ice maker, an Edgestar FP861 freezer in white, and a Fire Magic propane gas grill with insulating liner, ensuring every entertaining setting is supremely equipped.

The AV Package immerses guests with Wetsounds SW 808 W speaker pairs on the flybridge and on the aft deck, Wetsounds SW 650 W speaker pairs at the

bow, Speakercraft Accufit CRS7 One in ceiling speakers two units in the pilothouse, and a Samsung 48" TV on the aft deck with DirecTV H25 service. Visuals include a Samsung 65" TV in the salon, a Samsung 32" TV in the galley, a Samsung 19" LED LCD HDTV in the Captain's Cabin, a Samsung 28" LED TV in the Crew Lounge, and Samsung 40" LED TVs in the Master, Port Guest, Starboard Guest, and VIP, delivering cinematic clarity throughout the vessel. The NAV Package is specified for clarity and redundancy with a Furuno 2014 NavPilot 700 autopilot, a Furuno 2014 200WX ultrasonic weather station, NMEA2000 integration, Digital 500 Series capability, four Furuno 2014 RD33 displays, and a KEP Marine seventeen inch display. Communications and situational awareness are enhanced by a NEWMAR Hailer Horn 60/40, three Concord Marine dome cameras, Masters M19 4IGPL nineteen inch LCD monitors with two video inputs three units on the flybridge, two KEP Marine KEPL 17" displays on the flybridge, Standard GX5500S fixed mount VHF's two units on the flybridge and in the pilothouse, a Panasonic PH 824 ADV Hybrid KSU phone system with Panasonic PH 824 Caller ID Card, and eight Panasonic speaker phones. Night operations are supported by twin ACR RCL 100D 24VDC spotlights mounted on the hard top, ACR URP 102 Point Pad Kits at both lower and upper helms, and full Furuno system installation cabling, all arranged to provide redundant, professional grade navigation and communications. The Safety Package thoughtfully assembles life jackets, fenders, fire extinguishers, dock lines, flares, and a dual life raft, complemented by a Quick Lift 2000 lb davit with 360° rotation, a 1500 GPD watermaker, a Stidd 500N Low Back Slim line chair, and UMT Sea Stairs. Every detail underscores a yacht crafted for refined living, effortless entertaining, and confident passagemaking.


