The generators were replaced with brand new units in 2022, providing reliable power for all your needs. In 2022, we also installed new electric fin stabilizers, enhancing your comfort on the water. The air conditioning system was upgraded in 2022, ensuring a cool and pleasant atmosphere onboard. The hull received a fresh blue coat in 2021, while the transom was elegantly finished in silver the same year. The swim platform boasts new teak decking from 2022, and the foredeck will feature new teak in 2024, adding to the yacht's luxurious appeal. The captain meticulously maintains the vessel and has expertly managed all upgrades and refits, making this yacht for sale a prime choice for discerning buyers. CLARITY has been meticulously maintained since her launch, with numerous enhancements made over the years. In many respects, she is in better condition today than when she was first delivered, offering excellent value for money. This yacht is an ideal choice for those seeking their first boat or looking to upgrade. Her exterior is stunning, ensuring any new owner would be proud to call her their own.

Inside, the master cabin is a standout feature, boasting a split-level design and a full-beam bathroom, providing a luxurious and spacious retreat. Dining options on board are plentiful, with a wonderful sun deck table and an equally impressive aft deck table, offering flexibility and style for entertaining guests.

Prospective buyers can rest assured knowing that CLARITY has already depreciated, making her an attractive investment. The yacht has undergone a full "W6" engine rebuild and the generators have been replaced, ensuring reliability and performance for years to come. Additionally, the garage is spacious enough to accommodate a good-sized tender and even jetskis, should you desire.

In summary, CLARITY is a beautiful yacht that combines elegance with practicality, making her a perfect choice for both new and seasoned yacht owners.

Decks

The decks of this yacht are designed with both luxury and functionality in mind. The aft deck features a beautifully crafted table and chairs, perfect for alfresco dining or simply enjoying the view. Moving up to the sun deck, you'll

find a hot tub 'Jacuzzi' that promises relaxation, along with space for four sun loungers at the aft, ideal for soaking up the sun. Midships, there is a well-appointed bar and another high-quality table that can be adjusted in size, serving as either a dining table or a coffee table, depending on your needs. Additionally, the sun deck boasts a flybridge station, offering a delightful experience for navigation enthusiasts. This combination of features ensures that the decks provide a perfect blend of leisure and practicality.

Lounge and dining area inside

The main deck salon of this yacht is a haven of comfort and style, featuring a well-appointed bar and plush seating arrangements. Moving further forward, you'll find a stunning dining table, all maintained in mint condition. Large windows surround the area, allowing guests to enjoy breathtaking views from the comfort of the interior. In a thoughtful design choice, the full carpet has been replaced with more practical flooring complemented by a rug, offering both elegance and ease of maintenance. Should the buyer wish for a different material or finish, the flooring can be easily changed to suit personal preferences. Guests will also appreciate the stability provided by the electric fin stabilizers, ensuring a smooth experience whether at anchor or underway. This combination of features makes the lounge and dining area a perfect blend of luxury and functionality.

Cabins

The cabins on this yacht are a testament to luxury and thoughtful design, especially considering the yacht's price point of under €3 million. The master cabin is truly a highlight, offering an impressive amount of space and comfort. It spans the full beam of the yacht and features steps leading down to an equally expansive full-beam bathroom. For entertainment, a pop-up TV is

seamlessly integrated into the cabin's design. Beneath the bathroom floor lies a huge storage space, a feature that the crew greatly appreciates for its practicality.

Family and friends will find equal delight in the beautifully appointed guest cabins, ensuring that everyone on board enjoys a comfortable and luxurious stay. The combination of space, amenities, and thoughtful design makes the cabins a standout feature of this yacht, providing an exceptional experience for all who step aboard.

Galley

The galley on CLARITY is both spacious and practical, thoughtfully designed to meet the needs of any culinary enthusiast. Conveniently located on the main deck next to the dining room, it ensures seamless service and easy access for meal preparation. A door leading to the deck allows for excellent ventilation, making the space comfortable and airy. The galley is well-equipped with ample storage space, a walk-in fridge, and three freezers, providing plenty of room for provisions. A double sink facilitates efficient wash-up, while the bright and well-lit environment enhances the overall cooking experience. This galley is a perfect blend of functionality and comfort, making it an ideal space for both casual and gourmet cooking.

Commercial status

CLARITY is commercially registered in Malta, granting her the legal ability to conduct charter business. She holds a prestigious classification with ABS A1 notification, ensuring that all surveys are up to date and that she meets the highest standards of safety and performance. The yacht is required to operate within 60 nautical miles of a safe haven, adhering to commercial regulations. All safety equipment on board is current and regularly checked in compliance

with commercial rules.

Her current berth in Loano offers a great and secure option for consideration, although it is not included in the sale. For those interested in chartering, CLARITY commands a charter rate of €78,000 per week during the high season and €68,000 in the low season. This commercial status not only enhances her appeal as a charter yacht but also underscores her readiness and capability to provide exceptional experiences on the water.

Engine room

The engine room of this yacht is impeccably maintained, reflecting a commitment to excellence and reliability. In 2024, the engines underwent a complete rebuild, bringing them to a "like new" condition with zero hours, ensuring optimal performance and longevity. While the yacht has accumulated 3,800 hours since it was new, the hours since the W6 rebuild are minimal, highlighting the recent enhancements. The generators, installed new in 2022, have less than 700 hours on each, showcasing their relatively light use. These modern Kohler 55kW generators are designed for quiet operation, enhancing the onboard experience by minimizing noise. This attention to detail in the engine room underscores the yacht's readiness for smooth and efficient voyages.

Garage and swim platform

The yacht features easy, wide steps that gracefully lead down from the aft deck to the swim platform, offering seamless access to the water. The fixed swim platform is particularly well-suited for the Mediterranean, providing a stable and preferable alternative to fold-down platforms. The transom opens to reveal a spacious garage, which houses the Williams jet tender, ensuring both convenience and style. The silver paint on the transom adds a fantastic touch,

enhancing the yacht's aesthetic appeal.

For added convenience, there is a swim ladder and shower, making it easy to enjoy the water. The yacht also boasts nice wide side decks that extend all the way forward, with beautifully designed curves that highlight the expertise and flair of renowned designer Bill Dixon. This thoughtful design ensures both functionality and elegance, making the garage and swim platform a standout feature of the yacht.

Other technical information

The yacht's hull has recently undergone non-destructive testing (NDT), confirming that there are no issues with the GRP, ensuring structural integrity and peace of mind. In 2022, the flexible couplings between the gearbox and shaft were replaced, and both ZF gearboxes received comprehensive servicing. The next shaft survey is scheduled for 2025, while the five-blade, 920mm propellers were balanced in 2024. The rudders were also surveyed in 2022, maintaining the yacht's excellent handling capabilities.

Powering the yacht are two 55kW Kohler generators, new in 2022 and manufactured in 2021, model reference 55 EF OZDJ. These are complemented by two John Deere generator alternators, model reference 4045TFM85, also new in 2022 and manufactured in 2021. Both generators operate on a 3-phase 50Hz system and are housed in soundproof boxes, ensuring quiet operation. The yacht is equipped with a hydraulic bow thruster for enhanced maneuverability and features a shore power system with a 3-phase connection and 20 meters of cable, although it does not include a shore power converter. The battery service pack consists of Exide Marine gel batteries, new in 2022, along with emergency batteries and a second set for lightning strike protection. The main engine battery packs include four Varta N9 12V 225Ah batteries, while the generator battery packs consist of two Varta M18 12V 180Ah batteries. A Victron inverter is installed for emergency lighting, and each

battery bank is supported by a MasterVolt battery charger, with the service battery pack having both a main and a spare charger.

Additionally, the yacht features a custom-made hydraulic passerelle, equipped with a manually installed rope handle on one side, providing safe and convenient access. This comprehensive suite of technical features ensures that the yacht is not only reliable but also equipped to handle a variety of conditions with ease.

Bridge equipment

The bridge of this yacht is equipped with a comprehensive array of advanced navigation and monitoring systems, ensuring both safety and ease of operation. Central to the navigation suite is the Raymarine Axiom XL 16, running Lighthouse 4 and integrated with radar, providing precise and reliable plotting capabilities. Complementing this is the Raymarine Axiom 12, which is also repeated on the flybridge for added convenience. Additionally, a Simrad NSS 12 Evo 2 further enhances the navigational options available to the crew. For GPS functionality, the yacht is equipped with a Furuno SC 50 GPS, ensuring accurate positioning. Wind conditions are monitored via a Calypso Instruments anemometer with Bluetooth connectivity. While the depth sounder is currently due for repair or replacement, the bridge is otherwise well-equipped with a new Furuno BR510 bridge watch navigation alarm system and a Navtex JRC, both installed in 2024.

The autopilot system is managed by Raymarine, with controls repeated on the flybridge, including a second Raymarine controller for redundancy. Safety and monitoring are prioritized with systems such as watertight door monitoring, an alarm panel system featuring bilge, tank level, and navigation light alarms, as well as grey and black water monitoring systems. The fire alarm system, a Marinelec Carina, was newly installed in 2021, further enhancing onboard safety.

This suite of bridge equipment ensures that the yacht is not only equipped for precise navigation but also for comprehensive monitoring and safety, providing peace of mind for both crew and passengers.

Communication

The yacht is equipped with a robust communication system designed to ensure safety and connectivity at sea. On the bridge, the VHF ICOM IC-M 330, installed new in 2020, is integrated with GMDSS, providing reliable communication capabilities. Complementing this, the flybridge features an FHF Simrad HS90 with a Distress button, ensuring quick access to emergency communication if needed.

For satellite communication, the yacht is equipped with a KANNAD Marine EPIRB 406, strategically located on the sun deck, and KANNAD Marine Rescuer 2 SART radar transponders, enhancing the vessel's safety profile. Portable communication is facilitated by two NAVICO AXIS 30 VHF transceivers, also GMDSS compliant, offering flexibility and mobility.

The Raymarine AIS 700, installed in 2019, provides advanced tracking and identification capabilities, crucial for navigation and safety. All communication systems are powered by a standalone battery system, supported by a Victron Orion 24/20 charger, ensuring uninterrupted operation.

For internet connectivity, the yacht is equipped with Starlink Maritime, featuring one antenna, providing high-speed internet access even in remote locations. Additionally, the Kahlenberg Air Horn S-2 ensures that the yacht can signal its presence effectively when necessary. This comprehensive communication suite ensures that the yacht is well-prepared for any situation, offering peace of mind to both crew and passengers.

Lifesaving appliances

The yacht is well-equipped with a comprehensive array of lifesaving appliances, ensuring the safety and security of all on board. It features two 12-man liferafts and an additional 8-man liferaft, providing ample capacity for emergency situations. The vessel is also equipped with five liferings and seventeen lifejackets, ensuring that all passengers have access to essential safety gear.

For colder conditions, there are two immersion suits available, along with fourteen thermal protective aids, offering additional protection against hypothermia. The yacht is also equipped with a set of eight flares and smoke signals, crucial for signaling distress and ensuring visibility in emergency situations. This extensive range of lifesaving appliances underscores the yacht's commitment to safety and preparedness, providing peace of mind for both crew and passengers.

Tank capacities

The yacht is equipped with a comprehensive array of tanks designed to support extended voyages with ample storage for various needs. The aft section houses a grey water tank with a capacity of 668 litres and a substantial fuel tank holding 7,980 litres. Additionally, there are black water and oil tanks, each with a capacity of 744 litres, ensuring efficient waste management and engine lubrication.

For daily operations, the yacht features two day tanks, one on the starboard side and one on the port side, each with a capacity of 660 litres. The forward section of the yacht is equipped with a central fuel tank that holds an impressive 9,361 litres, along with a forward grey lift tank of 315 litres and a forward grey water tank with a capacity of 1,359 litres. Fresh water needs are met with a tank that holds 2,600 litres, ensuring a reliable supply for all on

board.

In total, the yacht's fuel capacity, including the day tanks, amounts to 18,661 litres across four tanks, providing extensive range and flexibility for long-distance cruising. This comprehensive tank system underscores the yacht's capability to support extended journeys with efficiency and reliability.
