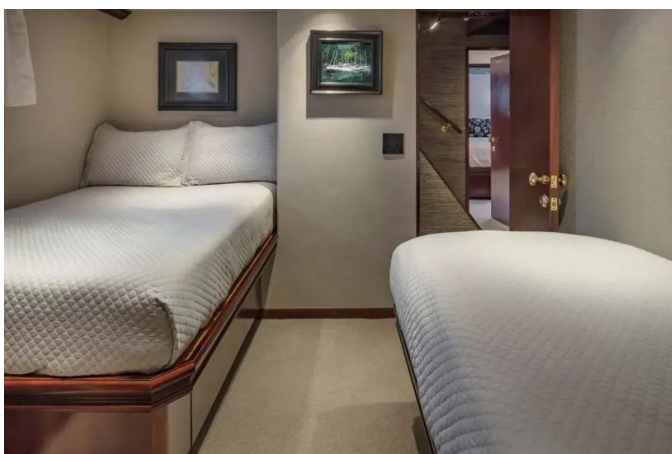

DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Overview

M/Y BLACKWOOD is a 31m (103') luxury yacht that underwent a comprehensive 2025 full refit, blending timeless character with the conveniences of contemporary cruising. She comfortably accommodates up to nine guests across four ensuite cabins—a full-beam master, a VIP, a double guest and a further guest stateroom—served by a professional crew of four. Prepared specifically for Alaskan waters, BLACKWOOD features a fully enclosed aft deck for dining in any weather, a cozy flybridge with generous lounge seating, a fireplace and a Bluetooth sound system, and a salon finished to welcome and relax. Modern comforts include climate control with air conditioning and heating throughout, Starlink Wi-Fi for reliable connectivity and stabilizers for a steady ride underway.

Inside, the yacht's layout is expansive and flowing, designed to maximize light and connection to the outside through large windows and seamless circulation. The full-beam salon and adjacent dining area form an elegant, sociable environment for entertaining or quiet relaxation, while the country-style galley introduces a homelike sensibility with abundant work surfaces, casual dining space and extensive storage.

The private, full-beam master suite serves as a tranquil retreat, appointed with a king berth, plentiful storage, dual vanities, a generous shower and dedicated dressing and entertainment areas. The VIP stateroom benefits from its own private entrance, substantial storage and a well-equipped ensuite, and the additional guest cabins provide flexibility to suit family cruising or friends aboard.

Outdoor life aboard BLACKWOOD is a defining feature: the enclosed aft deck creates a sheltered gathering place regardless of conditions, and the flybridge

extends the social footprint with expansive seating, a fireplace, wet bar, grill, firepit and adaptable open-air spaces. A swim platform offers straightforward access to the water, further strengthening the yacht's relationship to her surroundings.

Crew quarters for four are thoughtfully arranged to ensure privacy and efficient operation, preserving clear separation between guest and crew areas. Throughout the yacht, careful attention to storage, functionality and user-friendly systems supports comfortable extended stays. With her 2025 refit, classic lines, generous accommodation and versatile entertaining areas, M/Y BLACKWOOD is exceptionally well suited for exploring Alaska and beyond.

Salon / dining

Occupying the full beam, the salon and dining area are crafted for effortless entertaining—an expansive portside sofa anchors the space while additional lounge chairs to starboard create a refined conversation area, with ample, discreet storage integrated throughout. A formal dining arrangement comfortably seats eight guests and is complemented by dedicated cabinetry for china, glassware and flatware. Vast windows frame sweeping panoramic views and flood the interior with natural light, while the raised pilothouse is accessed via three steps for immediate command. Sliding doors open to both the port and starboard side decks, ensuring fluid circulation and an uninterrupted connection to the sea.

Galley

Arranged in an expansive country style, the galley serves as an inviting central living space that marries a full dining area with the practical ease of a contemporary home. Large windows bathe the room in natural light and frame wide-ranging views, highlighting tile flooring and elegant wood laminate

finishes. The culinary fit-out is comprehensive and residential in scale, featuring a stainless steel, residential-size Samsung refrigerator with freezer, a residential-size LG oven and cooktop, a Miele dishwasher, a KitchenAid ice maker, a trash compactor and two additional refrigeration units to ensure provisions remain perfectly chilled. Forward of the working galley, a generous dining settee comfortably seats ten or more guests and is complemented by bar-top seating for more informal entertaining. Entertainment systems are thoughtfully integrated, with a Samsung flat-screen television and a Fusion stereo system, while dedicated wine storage keeps prized bottles secure and conveniently at hand.

Primary suite

Occupying the yacht's full beam, the primary suite serves as a serene, private retreat centered on a king-size berth with built-in under-berth drawer storage, accompanied by an elegant combined desk and vanity. Flanked by his-and-hers cedar-lined closets for meticulous organization, the stateroom also offers a comfortable entertainment area with a large LG flat-screen TV, while an additional Elemis TV screen beside the desk provides an alternate viewing option; abundant storage is discreetly incorporated throughout the space. The adjoining primary head is appointed with his-and-hers vanities that bookend a generous shower and a separate head compartment, and heated towel racks lend an added note of refined comfort.

VIP stateroom

Secluded behind its own private entrance reached via a dedicated staircase from the galley, the VIP stateroom serves as a serene retreat with a refined desk area, a generous cedar-lined closet and a double berth styled to offer the proportions of a queen; an LG flat-screen TV provides in-room entertainment,

while the en suite head indulges with a full bathtub and a separate shower stall.

Day head

Located just aft of the raised pilothouse access, the guest day head is exquisitely appointed to provide effortless convenience and refined comfort, offering a calming space for guests to freshen up and be perfectly accommodated between periods spent on deck.

Starboard guest stateroom

The starboard guest stateroom is furnished with an inviting double berth and a cedar-lined closet, with a Samsung flat-screen TV for onboard entertainment. Ample storage discreetly accommodates personal belongings, while a matching ensuite head with shower provides privacy and refined convenience.

Port guest stateroom

Inviting and highly adaptable, the port guest stateroom is appointed with a comfortable double berth plus an additional single berth, an arrangement that suits families or extra guests with ease. A cedar-lined closet and a Samsung flat-screen TV add refined practicality and onboard entertainment, while a generous storage area keeps personal effects neatly stowed. Privacy and comfort are assured by a private ensuite head with shower, and an A/C access panel provides straightforward serviceability and reliable climate control.

Pilothouse / helm

The elevated pilothouse helm affords panoramic sightlines and assured control, while an integrated settee with concealed storage provides a refined

watchkeeping retreat. Movement around the yacht is effortless, with direct access to the flybridge and a passarelle positioned beside the pilothouse for smooth boarding at berth. A professional-grade electronics suite marries a Simrad electronics package with Furuno navigation systems, and Detroit Diesel Marine Power displays supply accurate, real-time engine data. The navigation arrangement is further enhanced by supplementary screens to keep critical information continuously in view, and generous helm storage keeps charts, equipment and accessories immaculately stowed for an uncluttered, highly efficient command environment.

Aft deck and cockpit

The full-beam aft deck is completely enclosed to form an elegant sanctuary, fitted with beige-upholstered seating laid out throughout to comfortably accommodate eight to ten guests. Entertainment is effortless courtesy of a Fusion stereo system with integrated controls and access, while a dedicated beverage cooler keeps drinks perfectly chilled. Circulation is effortless via a starboard-side Hollywood staircase, and boarding is made simple with convenient access from the starboard side.

Swim step

Shaded by a midship awning that throws a cool veil across the swim platform, this elegant waterside retreat is crafted for relaxed days afloat, delivering effortless access to the water and a refined boarding area that ensures smooth arrivals and departures.

Flybridge & upper helm / command bridge

Offering commanding panoramic vistas, the flybridge and upper helm—also

functioning as the command bridge—have been conceived as a refined entertainment sanctuary that gracefully extends into a generous outdoor social area. A sleek wet bar, appointed with three built-in barstools, anchors this space and is paired with a Magic Chef mini refrigerator and a Fusion stereo system with its own dedicated storage, while additional lockers and concealed compartments are thoughtfully incorporated throughout. The adaptable layout encourages relaxed gatherings, with five movable lounge chairs arranged around a portable coffee table and a relocatable firepit, and culinary occasions are elevated by a residential-size, movable Weber grill. Practicality meets pleasure with a hydraulic lift for the RIB tender, ensuring smooth, effortless transitions from sun-drenched relaxation to exploration on the water.

Crew quarters

Designed to maximize both discretion and operational efficiency, the crew quarters accommodate four to five crew members and provide direct access from the swim platform so service remains unseen and guest areas stay undisturbed. Sleeping arrangements comprise three twin berths and one double berth, complemented by ample hanging lockers, generous storage throughout, cedar-lined closets and a full-length mirror to enhance everyday comfort. A well-equipped utility area—complete with a Miele washer and dryer, sink, microwave, refrigerator and additional storage—allows the crew to maintain impeccable service and seamless operations on every passage.

Crew head

Designed to balance comfort with practical efficiency, the crew head affords complete privacy and includes a dedicated shower stall, while heated towel racks provide a spa-like warmth. Ample storage keeps supplies and personal items neatly stowed, and refreshed fixtures and appliances create a clean,

contemporary aesthetic paired with dependable, everyday functionality.

Engine room

Forward access from the crew quarters opens into a meticulously arranged machinery space, where dedicated tool storage and multiple workbench areas create an environment tailored for efficient routine and complex maintenance. A robust inverter and an integrated watermaker are incorporated into the vessel's comprehensive mechanical systems, and the overall layout affords generous service access throughout. Electronic displays for the Detroit Diesel engines are installed port and starboard in the engine room and are repeated at both helms, supported by a Detroit Diesel engine room interface module alongside a backup power module. An oil transfer system with separate fresh and waste tanks streamlines fluid management, highlighting the space's purposeful engineering and readiness for extended cruising.

Laundry & utility

Meticulously positioned in the lower deck stair foyer, a Miele washer and dryer set makes onboard laundry effortless, allowing wardrobes to be refreshed with ease between port calls. The electrical panel is directly accessible in this same space, simplifying routine inspections and service to help preserve smooth, uninterrupted cruising.

Deck & hull

Every structural and finishing choice aboard emphasizes both utility and refinement: a raw-water washdown simplifies deck maintenance while underwater lighting envelops the hull in a soft, atmospheric glow. The silhouette is finished with a custom flybridge hardtop, complemented by a full

flybridge enclosure with curtains for all weather comfort and a full cockpit enclosure with curtains that offers added protection whether at anchor or underway. Protective mooring canvas shields exterior finishes when the yacht is at rest, and two Current Designs kayaks are stowed on flybridge chocks, ready for spontaneous exploration. For reliable machinery ventilation, port- and starboard-mounted engine exhaust fans with an integrated controller have been thoughtfully installed.

Water & waste systems

Meticulously engineered for dependable onboard performance, the yacht is fitted with a brand-new Blue Water Explorer watermaker to produce abundant potable water and is complemented by a new Water Worker water accumulation tank that preserves smooth, consistent system pressure; a city water inlet is also installed, intended for use only when attended.

Electrical equipment

The yacht's electrical architecture is appointed for steadfast performance and refined efficiency: four Corrosion Consultants Zinc Saver II galvanic isolators provide protection from stray current, while an Auto Shore 100 amp 208-240 volt AC shore power management system delivers seamless, secure dockside power. Two Glendenning Cable Master reels manage heavy-duty shore cords with effortless refinement, and motor control is handled by two new Lenze AC Tech SMVector variable frequency drives, complemented by a new WEG CFW300 variable frequency AC drive to ensure smooth, reliable operation throughout the vessel.

Electronics

A comprehensive navigation and communications suite is arranged to support confident long-range passagemaking, anchored by a Furuno GP-32 MFD complemented by four Simrad MFDs and a PC running Nobeltec charting software. Depth and speed are provided with precision through two Datamarine Link DEPTH digital displays and two Datamarine Link SPEED digital displays, while situational awareness is reinforced by two Simrad open array radars. Helm control is robust and redundant, featuring two Robertson AP9 MK II autopilot units, four Robertson RI-40 rudder angle indicators and two Robertson FU 91 follow-up steering levers. Communications are similarly well-appointed with a new Standard Horizon Quantum GX5500S VHF with Distress, an Icom IC-M330 VHF with Distress and a Standard Horizon GPS HX870 VHF with Distress, supported by five new Hytera handheld PoC radios and three Kenwood ProTalk two-way radios. Connectivity at sea is assured by an Intellian v60E Ku-Band VSAT antenna system alongside an Intellian satellite antenna and Starlink Marine Internet, and the flying bridge carries three new Furuno digital multi-function displays for immediate situational data; entertainment systems in the guest areas have also been updated to elevate life aboard.

Mechanica equipment

An engine-driven hydraulic pump provides the muscle behind the bow thruster, windlass and stabilizers, delivering precise, responsive control in all maneuvers. A newly installed Speedaire air compressor (5.7 CFM at 90 PSI) meets onboard pneumatic requirements, while a Fill Rite rotary manual fuel transfer pump paired with a Fill Rite Series 900 meter guarantees accurate and trustworthy fueling. Deck operations are enhanced by a raw water washdown system and underwater lighting, and the custom flybridge hardtop

is complemented by a full flybridge enclosure with curtains alongside a matching full cockpit enclosure with curtains for adaptable protection in any weather. Protective mooring canvas preserves the vessel's finishes, and two Current Designs kayaks sit securely on flybridge chocks, poised for effortless exploration. Rounding out the fit out is a P/S engine exhaust fan with its controller, providing efficient, controlled ventilation.

Safety & navigation

Onboard safety is anchored by an annunciator panel that keeps propulsion and other critical systems immediately visible, supported by an engine room alarm bell (label application) and a high-powered loud hailer for clear communications; emergency preparedness is further reinforced by an ACR EPIRB (exp. 1/10/2024) and a Honda engine-powered fire/bilge pump complete with a 100' fire hose. A vessel-wide surveillance system of cameras and monitors heightens situational awareness throughout, while precise heading information is provided by a Danforth Constellation magnetic compass with a 5-inch card and a newly fitted Ritchie magnetic compass with a 4-inch card, all complemented by class-compliant navigation lights. For sound signaling the yacht is fitted with three trumpet horns plus two traditional bells—one mounted on the foredeck and one on the flybridge—while marine brass clocks and barometers are elegantly placed at the helm and across the decks; visibility aids include three pilothouse windshield wipers with washers, two on the flybridge, and a spotlight that is currently not operational.

Exclusions

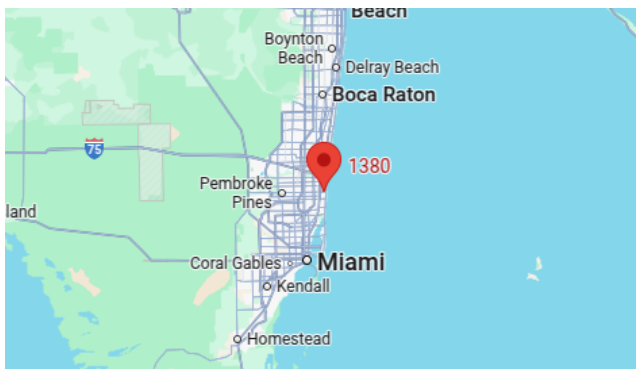
