Indulge in the refined grace of the 2012 Sanlorenzo 104, an Italian-born superyacht that marries timeless style with sea-going capability. At 104 feet long with a 23-foot beam, this vessel unfolds generous, airy volumes that invite both grand entertaining and quiet repose. The hull—crafted in fiberglass and plastic to Sanlorenzo's exacting lines—presents a sleek profile that promises handsome aesthetics alongside dependable seakeeping.

Step inside and the signature vision of Francesco Paszkowski greets you: a salon bathed in daylight through broad windows, appointed with tasteful furnishings that create an elegant yet welcoming salon. The yacht sleeps up to six guests across three meticulously finished cabins, each conceived as a tranquil refuge after a day on the water. Service is discreetly accommodated by dedicated crew quarters, ensuring attentive care while preserving guest privacy.

Underway the Sanlorenzo 104 is propelled by two MTU diesel engines, delivering a comfortable cruise at 25 knots and a top speed of 29 knots, a performance that suits everything from spirited coastal passages to relaxed island hopping. Long legs are within reach thanks to a fuel capacity in excess of 3,300 gallons, while close-to-home comforts are assured by nearly 740 gallons of freshwater capacity.

Outdoor living is equally considered: an expansive GRP deck provides broad opportunities for sunbathing, alfresco dining, and convivial gatherings, with layout and finish chosen for both comfort and durability. Below, a well-equipped galley supports fine dining at sea, and a capacious dining area sets the scene for memorable meals beneath starry skies.

Located in Italy, this 2012 Sanlorenzo 104 represents a harmonious balance of luxury, thoughtful design, and purposeful engineering. Every specification—from the hull construction and designer pedigree to the twin

MTU diesels, speed figures, tankage numbers, and crew accommodations—is woven into a single vessel crafted for owners who value both form and function. Consider this yacht for an ownership experience that promises refined living and exceptional performance on the water.

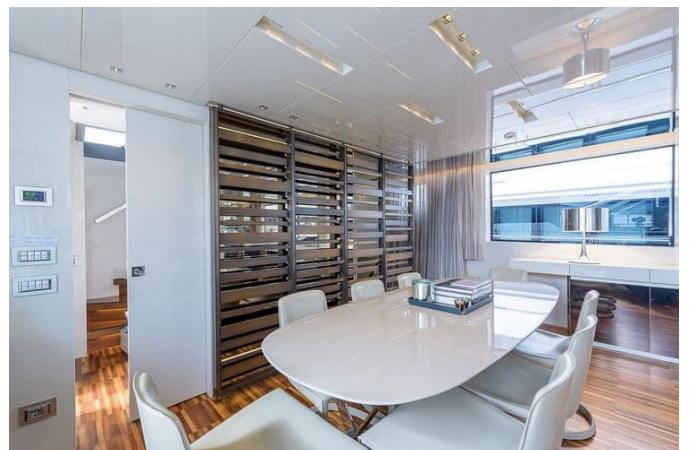

# DETAILED DESCRIPTION

---

## Section name

This exquisite motor yacht, built by the renowned Sanlorenzo, is a masterpiece of nautical engineering and design, the SL 104 model with hull number 579 presenting an elegant synthesis of form and function conceived by Francesco Paszkowski. Launched in 2012 and meticulously refitted in 2020, she is classed by RINA with a comprehensive five-year survey and renewal of class completed during that refit, and her GRP hull and superstructure with teak decks combine durability with timeless style. Flying the Maltese flag, the yacht is propelled by two MTU 16V 2000 M 93 engines, each delivering 1,812 kW (2,430 Hp), which provide a maximum speed of 29 knots, a comfortable cruising speed of 25 knots and an economical ten-knot pace that extends her range to 1,400 nautical miles while consuming approximately 80 litres per hour. Her dimensions are commanding, with a length overall of 31.70 meters (104 feet), a beam of 7.05 meters (23 feet 2 inches) and a maximum draft of 2.15 meters (7 feet 1 inch), ensuring generous volume and sea-keeping. Accommodations are appointed for eight guests across four cabins, including a main-deck master with walk-in wardrobe and expansive bathroom, while the lower deck offers a large VIP cabin and two double cabins with queen-size beds and en-suite facilities, and crew accommodation for up to six in three cabins with a well-equipped galley and mess. The flybridge, accessed from both the aft deck and the wheelhouse, is a standout social space featuring a large Boffi kitchen top and exclusive contemporary Paola Lenti furnishings, while mechanical and comfort systems include two Kohler generators, CMC Marine stabilisers and a Condaria air conditioning system. Navigation and deck equipment are comprehensive, from a Raymarine Platinum electronics suite with autopilot, GPS, chart plotter, radar and wind instruments to anchors, windlasses,

capstans, a hydraulic passerelle and extensive electro-hydraulic systems for gangway steps, swim ladder, concealed shower, garage hatch and tender and jet ski launch and retrieval, complemented by a 4.45-meter Williams Jet Tender. The 2020 refit and ongoing maintenance, supported by inspections and work from Atlante Marine Solutions, Nautica Sardacantieri and RINA, have left the yacht in immaculate condition; key selling points include VAT-paid status, pristine upkeep, private ownership with excellent charter potential and a comprehensive interior refit and mechanical upgrade completed in 2020, making this SL 104 a pinnacle of luxury and performance on the water.
