OVERVIEW

Presented as an entirely bespoke 33.5-metre luxury superyacht project, the SUY 110 represents a rare opportunity to commission a tailor-made new build from a respected Italian shipyard, with two sisterships already sold and delivered in H1 2026. This is a fresh canvas for an owner seeking the assurance of a contemporary platform combined with the individuality of a custom design.

Spread across four decks and built with a steel hull and aluminium superstructure, the yacht pairs pragmatic seafaring capability with unmistakable Italian elegance. Fulvio De Simoni's exterior language relies on clean, taut lines and a contemporary silhouette that projects both authority and refinement.

Flexibility is central to the concept. A 45-square-metre aft hangar, functioning as a generous tender garage, easily stows a five-metre tender alongside a secondary tender, jet skis and additional equipment without impinging on guest spaces. Above this, a clever 60-square-metre raised deck flows into the main deck to form a versatile indoor-outdoor living area: a light-filled veranda for sunbathing, alfresco dining or quietly watching the horizon. That veranda can be specified with a Jacuzzi and configured to carry larger water toys, even a compact sailing boat for keen anglers.

The interior project, penned by the award-winning Hot Lab studio, is entirely open to bespoke specification. Accommodation for 10 guests is arranged across five staterooms, centred around a full-beam owner's suite on the main deck with further cabins below. With transatlantic range, at-anchor stabilisers and a suite of lifestyle amenities — including a Jacuzzi and a beach club — the SUY 110 delivers the long-range performance of a true cruiser while maintaining the comforts and style expected of a superyacht.

Offering the security of a brand-new build together with the freedom of a

custom vessel, the SUY 110 is tailored to owners who value substance, adaptability and Italian flair, equally at home on adventurous passagemaking, elegant family cruising or an expansive life at sea. Estimated delivery: 24 months from contract signature.

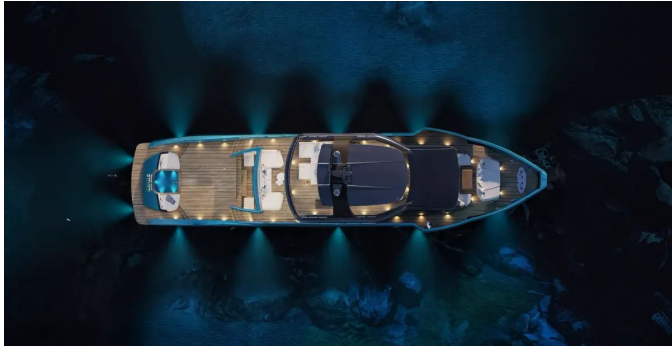

Full description

Offered as a brand-new custom project, the 33.5-metre SUY 110 represents a rare chance to commission a new build from a respected Italian shipyard; hull construction is already in progress with delivery scheduled for 2027. Built in steel over four decks, this motor yacht marries purposeful engineering with refined Italian styling. Fulvio de Simoni's exterior language is evident in the yacht's bold, linear profiles and contemporary silhouette, a composition that conveys both seaworthiness and understated elegance.

Practicality and flexibility define the onboard arrangements. A generous 45-square-metre aft hangar is designed to stow a five-metre tender alongside a secondary tender, jet skis and additional toys, all while preserving uninterrupted guest areas. Above it, a 60-square-metre raised deck links seamlessly to the main deck to form a flowing indoor-outdoor suite—an airy, sun-drenched veranda ideal for relaxed lounging, alfresco dining or simply savouring the view.

Internally, the award-winning studio Hot Lab leads a scheme that is fully open to owner customisation. The standard accommodation plan hosts ten guests in five staterooms, highlighted by a full-beam master suite on the main deck and further cabins arranged below. Equipped with trans-Atlantic range, at-anchor stabilisers and lifestyle features such as a Jacuzzi and beach club, the SUY 110 delivers long-range capability without sacrificing comfort or style.

Presented as a new-build with the creative freedom of a bespoke project, the SUY 110 will appeal to an owner who values substance, adaptability and personality—whether for bold cruising itineraries, elegant family retreats or simply an amplified way of life at sea.
