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OVERVIEW

This luxury superyacht is laid out with five staterooms, including an on-deck Owner's suite, and is arranged to comfortably accommodate 12 guests with refined ease. A transferable engine warranty remains valid through 8/31/2028, and more than \$1,000,000 has been invested in bespoke interior design and high-end upgrades that elevate every living space. As a flybridge motor yacht, she offers an expansive upper deck with sweeping views where one may choose full sun or retreat beneath an air conditioned cover, while forward a bow Jacuzzi set among generous sun pads — with optional shading — provides a resort-style lounging experience. At the stern an extended beach-club swim platform with ladder and a dedicated tender/toy garage supports every watersport, making this bluewater motor yacht especially well suited to charter minded cruising.

DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Mystere, 2023 Mangusta Gransport 33m

MYSTERE is a 2023 Mangusta GranSport 33 meter that elevates the modern sport yacht to a realm of effortless luxury and poised performance, where every detail has been refined to offer a seamless blend of speed, comfort, and bespoke style. Her five stateroom arrangement, crowned by an on deck master suite, accommodates up to twelve guests in pristine comfort while dedicated crew quarters for up to five professionals ensure discreet, attentive service. A transferable engine warranty in place through 8/31/2028 adds tangible reassurance, and more than \$1,000,000 invested in interior upgrades and custom finishes infuses the living spaces with tailored elegance and contemporary refinement. On deck the lifestyle is choreographed for enjoyment and privacy: an expansive flybridge provides sunlit lounging or shaded retreat with air conditioning, the bow hosts a Jacuzzi pool flanked by sunbeds with optional shade, and an extended swim platform with ladder flows directly into a tender and toy garage ready for every watersport pursuit. Measuring 109 feet 3 inches overall (33.3 m) with a length at waterline of 88 feet 7 inches (27 m), MYSTERE pairs generous volume with access thanks to a beam of 24 feet 3 inches (7.4 m) and a shallow draft of 6 feet 3 inches (1.9 m). Her naval architecture by Alberto Mancini/Overmarine and interior design by FM/Overmarine are realized in single skin construction using vinylester resin reinforced with E glass and polyurethane, producing a lightweight yet robust hull that supports 247 gross tons and 74 net tons. Built in 2023 by Mangusta and classed RINA while flying the Marshall Islands flag, she presents a contemporary sport yacht profile that reflects pedigree and purposeful design. Underway, MYSTERE is propelled by four Volvo Penta D13 1000 IB diesel engines, each rated at 735 kW (~1000 HP) at 2400 rpm, driving four Volvo

Penta IPS 1350 units with integrated shafts and dual Volvo Penta duoprop contra rotating propellers per engine for crisp acceleration and efficient cruising. She comfortably cruises at 21 knots, reaches a maximum speed of 25 knots, and offers a range of approximately 330 nautical miles at 21 knots, with reassuringly low engine hours recorded as Port 237; Port Inboard 236; Starboard Inboard 234; Starboard 236. Electrical generation is supplied by two Kohler generators — a 35 kW unit, 400 VAC, 50 Hz, three phase (380 hours), and a 50 kW unit (750 hours) — feeding a main 400 VAC, 50 Hz, three phase, four wire system with neutral ground, with secondary 230 VAC single phase and 24 V DC supplies; shore power connectivity is 400 VAC, 50 Hz, three phase, and battery systems include a three unit 8D house bank plus isolated 12 V and 24 V starting circuits.

Tankage and systems are designed for independent cruising, with fuel capacity of 2,774 gallons (10,500 litres), freshwater of 528 gallons (2,000 litres), and black water of 660 gallons (2,500 litres). An Idromar watermaker produces 110 gallons per hour, and comprehensive climate control maintains serene interior and shaded exterior living spaces in all conditions. Mechanical and safety systems are integrated for precision and reliability: steering and rudder angle indication operate through the IPS system, Waveless stabilizers deliver onboard comfort, and a 28 kW thruster paired with dual counter rotating four blade Kaplan propellers provides a predicted 450 kg of thrust for effortless low speed handling. The bilge arrangement features a control panel with six DC pumps offering automatic and manual modes, high water alarms, electric remote operated valves, bilge level alarms, and vacuum and pressure gauges; Gianneschi pumps include a 400 VAC/three phase/50 Hz unit, a 400 VAC/three phase/50–60 Hz unit, and an emergency Gianneschi P&B MBMA 50 160B diesel pump located outside the engine room. Firefighting is supported by dedicated Gianneschi fire pumps in parallel with the same emergency diesel unit, all monitored by vacuum and pressure gauges for clear diagnostics.

Bridge and navigation systems are comprehensively specified to match the yacht's performance: three Speich windshield wipers maintain visibility, a JDTRON loud hailer aids communications, Furuno FM 8900S VHF radiotelephones are fitted in duplicate, and search lights are handheld for flexible deployment. Integrated GARMIN/Volvo Penta autopilot technology is paired with a GARMIN GSD 25 sounder featuring FrontVü and LiveVü, GARMIN Phantom 54 radar, chartplotting via two GARMIN GPSMAP 8617 and two GARMIN GPSMAP 8624 displays, GPS via GARMIN GPS 24xd, GARMIN wind instruments, GARMIN AIS 800, and a Garmin compass, while satellite television and connectivity are enabled through OmniAccess, Plexus, Seatel, and Starlink. Safety and situational awareness are further enhanced by an AXIS camera system and a FLIR camera, extending observation day and night.

Deck equipment and lifestyle amenities underline MYSTERE's versatility and entertaining pedigree: two vertical anchor windlasses rated at 4 kW (400 VAC/three phase/50 Hz) handle twin galvanized high tensile anchors of 40 kg each, each deployed on 123.75 metre lengths of 14 mm galvanized studless chain, while a Sanguineti beam crane operates from a 400 VAC hydraulic power pack and a stern passerelle simplifies boarding. The foredeck Jacuzzi with sunbeds and optional shade, the airy flybridge offering full sun or cooled shelter, and a generous beach club with extended swim platform, ladder and garage for tender and toys together create a fluid connection between onboard living and the sea.

Entertainment and domestic systems are discreetly integrated to preserve comfort and privacy: built in Sonance audio serves the main salon, owner's cabin, guest cabins and bridge deck, the captain's cabin includes a TV while crew cabins are intentionally left without dedicated A/V to prioritize guest bandwidth and quiet, and the main galley and laundry are outfitted with Miele appliances and Miele Professional equipment to ensure swift, silent provisioning and housekeeping that keep the yacht guest ready at every turn.

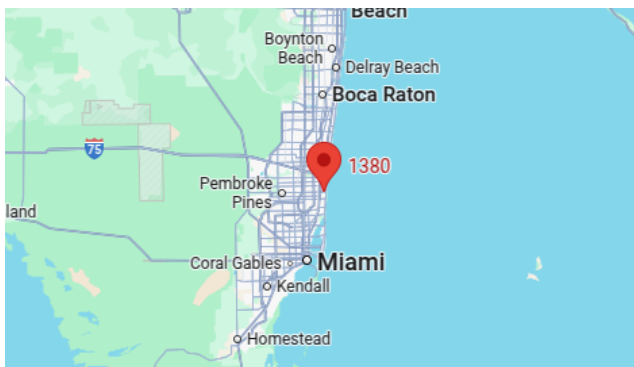
