OVERVIEW

Commanding in stature and refined in style, this 2019, 110-foot motor yacht is sculpted from advanced fiberglass composite to deliver strength, efficiency and a hushed, graceful passage through open water. Tender to both long-range adventure and discreet luxury, she is based in the United States and has been tended with meticulous care, offering bluewater assurance and the privacy owners expect of a true superyacht.

Beneath her elegant sheer, twin Caterpillar inboard diesels supply dependable, responsive propulsion, enabling a spirited top speed of up to 19 knots while the generous 5,550-gallon fuel capacity and 800-gallon freshwater reserve permit extended cruising without compromise. Her substantial draft contributes to offshore steadiness, and the clean, flowing profile is matched by broad fiberglass decks that invite leisurely mornings and languid evenings al fresco.

Life aboard unfolds in luminous, open-plan spaces where light and horizon become part of the décor. The salon, embraced by panoramic glazing, draws the outside in and flows effortlessly to an entertainer's aft deck ideal for dining either at anchor or making way. Above, an expansive flybridge with multiple seating areas invites sunning, convivial gatherings and sunset cocktails, while a foredeck offers an intimate retreat for quiet contemplation at sea. A raised pilothouse enhances command visibility and complements the yacht's layered outdoor living.

Interior appointments are serene and sophisticated, marrying classic finishes with contemporary conveniences. A welcoming dining salon pairs with a well-equipped galley, equally suited for casual family repasts or catered soirées. Accommodation is arranged for privacy and adaptability, with five beautifully finished heads providing a boutique-hotel standard of comfort. Climate control, premium sound systems and comprehensive ship's systems

ensure effortless operation, while ample storage and dedicated service spaces keep the vessel orderly for extended passages.

Whether underway or at rest, she delivers the composed rhythm and reassuring motion of a luxury cruiser—smooth, confident and unmistakably capable. Perfect as a private family sanctuary, an elegant venue for entertaining, or a high-end charter platform, she stands ready to surpass expectations with the performance, autonomy and comfort that define contemporary superyacht living.





























DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Overview

This custom-built, single-owner 2019 Horizon RP110, Wild Duck, is a must-see, marrying sleek exterior lines that turn heads from every angle with generous interior volume and effortlessly social spaces throughout. Step aboard to a welcoming aft deck anchored by a U-shaped settee and a full wet bar; through the curved salon door, the main salon unfolds with plentiful seating, a walkaround bar, and a custom-designed wine cabinet set into the forward bulkhead—an impressive overture to the yacht's refined interior. Forward to port, a fully equipped galley is paired to starboard with a day head and guest companionway access along the walkaround; a country kitchen-style dining area crowns the bow, offering private access to the forward VIP. Below, the full-beam master is a sanctuary framed by large windows and an aft his-and-her head, while two additional ensuite staterooms feature twin berths that slide together to form a single berth when desired. Above, the raised pilothouse commands superb visibility and state-of-the-art electronics, and stairs lead to the flybridge where a second full helm, expansive settees, comfortable barstools, and an extra-large walkaround bar invite open-air living; further aft, a 2,500 lb hydraulic davit stands ready for a tender or a pair of jet skis. The crew quarters accommodate five with a full mess and oversized storage lockers ideal for dive gear and water toys. In the engine room, Wild Duck is powered by CAT C-32A 1,900 hp engines and 55 kW Kohler generators, and is outfitted with 55 hp bow and stern thrusters and zero-speed ABT Hydraulic fin stabilizers for poise and comfort underway and at rest.

Aft deck

The aft deck invites effortless entertaining with a bar complete with sink, while

four Fusion speakers envelop the space in rich, outdoor-ready sound that carries from sundowner cocktails to late-night conversation.

Salon

The salon is a sophisticated haven for relaxation and entertainment, appointed with comfortable sofa chairs and anchored by a U-Line handleless refrigerator, a Raritan icemaker, and a Subzero wine cooler to keep refreshments perfectly chilled. A 55" Samsung TV pairs with a Yamaha AV receiver, speakers, and subwoofer, supported by a Samsung Blu-Ray disc player, Apple TV media player, and an Apple iPhone Lighting Dock to deliver seamless, cinema-quality viewing and intuitive streaming.

Dining

The country kitchen-style dining forward welcomes convivial meals and boardroom caliber briefings alike, with a generous table that comfortably seats eight to ten guests.

Galley

Thoughtfully equipped for gourmet ambitions, the galley features a Miele refrigerator and Subzero freezer, complemented by a suite of GE appliances including a dishwasher, cooktop, oven, microwave, and disposal. For casual viewing and culinary inspiration, a Samsung 32" LED TV stands ready, supported by a Fusion stereo with Yamaha speakers, a Samsung Blu-Ray disc player, and an Apple media player.

Master stateroom

The full-beam master indulges with a Vitrifrigo refrigerator and a refined

entertainment suite comprising an AV receiver with speakers and subwoofer, a Blu-Ray disc player, a Samsung 50" LED 4K TV, a media player, and an Apple iPhone lighting dock with cable. Warm, brown leather-wrapped reading lights and the aft his-and-her head elevate the suite into a private retreat.

Vip stateroom

The forward VIP is serene and connected, with white leather-wrapped reading lights and an entertainment array including a Samsung 40" LED 4K TV, Apple media player, Yamaha soundbar, and a Samsung Blu-Ray disc player.

Guest cabin port

The port guest cabin provides thoughtful comforts with a reading lamp and a Samsung 32" LED TV, enhanced by a Fusion stereo with Yamaha speakers, plus a Samsung Blu-Ray disc player and an Apple media player for effortless entertainment.

Guest cabin starboard

Mirroring its counterpart, the starboard guest cabin features a reading lamp and a Samsung 32" LED TV, paired with a Fusion stereo and Yamaha speakers, plus a Samsung Blu-Ray disc player and an Apple media player.

Forward companionway

Practicality meets discretion in the forward companionway, where a GE washer/dryer keeps wardrobe rotations seamless during extended cruises.

Captains cabin

The captain enjoys a private head with sink and an in-cabin entertainment setup that includes a Fusion stereo with Yamaha speakers, a Blu-Ray disc player, an Apple media player, and a Samsung 32" LED TV, while a touch-switch reading light ensures clarity at all hours.

Crew quarters

Designed for efficiency and comfort, the crew area offers a dedicated head with sink and a fully equipped mess featuring a GE washer/dryer, Summit refrigerator and microwave, a Kenyon cooktop, a GE chest freezer, a disposal, and a practical trash bin. For downtime, a Samsung 32" LED TV teams with a Fusion stereo and Yamaha speakers, while reading lights with switches provide personalized illumination.

Pilothouse

The raised pilothouse centers on a commanding Stidd helm chair and integrates a Fusion stereo with two Yamaha speakers, while a touch-switch reading light and clean sightlines support confident navigation day and night.

Electronics and navigation

Comprehensive electronics inspire confidence offshore, including a KVH Trac Vision HD7 housed in a TV8 dome, a Glomex TV antenna, and a Shakespeare eight-foot antenna. Navigation and situational awareness are delivered by Garmin GPSMAP units, a Garmin radar with antenna, a Garmin fish finder, a Garmin weather receiver, a Garmin VHF, a Titchie compass, an AXIS CCD camera/monitor, a Buell airhorn, and a Garmin AIS 600 transceiver, all steadied

by a Simrad autopilot and informed by an Airmar Smart transducer and a wind gauge. Entertainment and communications are equally robust, with DirectTV satellite receivers, a Panasonic telephone system, an expansion card, three KX wireless phones, seven AT&T phones, and a WiFi extender/router to keep guests and crew connected.

Flybridge

The flybridge is a breezy oasis for open air living, complete with a bar featuring a sink and faucet, a Vitrifrigo refrigerator, a Raritan ice maker, and an Aritex BBQ grill. Entertainment flows with a Samsung 43" LED 4K TV, a Yamaha stereo amplifier, Fusion speakers with subwoofer, a Samsung Blu-Ray disc player, and an Apple TV 4K media player.

Hull and deck equipment

Precision handling and comfort are assured with ABT bow and stern thrusters and an ABT Trac stabilizer, while eight underwater lights transform evenings at anchor into a private light show.

Forward deck and bow

Forward, ground tackle is all business with two Maxwell windlasses paired to a chain counter, feeding an anchor chain of 300 ft to make setting and retrieving the hook smooth and sure.

Engine room equipment

Mechanical pedigree underpins Wild Duck's performance: twin Caterpillar C-32 Acert engines rated at 1900 bhp at 2300 rpm, V 12, four-stroke cycle, with hours run: port — 2144, starboard — 2145 (November 2025). Transmission —

ZF gears with Glendinning controls. Range is supported by two aluminum main fuel tanks of 1200 gallons each and one composite (stainless fiberglass) fuel tank of 3150 gallons; engine room ventilation — Delta T. Fresh water is stored in a composite tank of 800 gallons, and a Sea Recovery watermaker and Torrid water heater supply domestic needs. Bilge management is handled by Rule electric bilge pumps and manual pumps (Bosworth 15 gpm and Jabsco 22 gpm), plus a Rule high-level alarm; sewage is processed by a Headhunter system. Climate is controlled by Marine Air air conditioning, and pneumatic needs are supplied by a Swan compressor.

Electrical system

Reliable ship's power comes from two Kohler generators rated at 55 kW, 60 Hz, three phase, with hours recorded at: port 3468 and starboard 3474 (November 2025). Storage is entrusted to Lifeline batteries for durable, dependable reserves.

Fire and safety equipment

Safety is engineered in with a Seafire H-Series fire fighting system complemented by seven Kiddie multi purpose ABC dry chemical extinguishers, delivering layered protection and peace of mind.


