This yacht epitomizes the excellence of British maritime craftsmanship and design. The Sunseeker 34m series, to which she belongs, is among the most sought-after in yacht sales. Constructed with a GRP hull and superstructure, FRIVOLOUS offers a substantial 225 GT, ensuring ample space for 10 guests across 5 luxurious staterooms. With a beam of 7.39 meters and a draft of 2.28 meters, she promises a roomy and stable voyage. Her twin MTU 16V 2000 M93 engines, each delivering 2,434 horsepower, propel her to a maximum speed of 24 knots and a comfortable cruising speed of 16 knots, with a range reaching up to 1,250 nautical miles. This blend of performance and sophisticated design, featuring a Master Cabin on the main deck and an expansive flybridge, makes FRIVOLOUS a standout choice in the 30-35m yacht category. The Sunseeker 34m model is highly coveted, often retained by owners well beyond the market norm. Sold to her current, highly knowledgeable owner in 2015, this is his 10th season at the helm. His meticulous care ensures that the next owner will inherit a yacht in pristine condition. The owner is eager to finalize the yacht sale before summer, so offers are welcome!
