OVERVIEW

The 2011 Sunseeker 34M is an arresting 33.91-metre tri-deck motor yacht that marries classic British yachtbuilding with assured performance and composed onboard living. Constructed in GRP and built to RINA classification, she presents a robust, enduring silhouette that sits prominently within the flybridge motor yacht segment.

Her accommodation for up to 10 guests is arranged over five elegantly appointed cabins, anchored by a full-beam owner's suite on the main deck and complemented by a VIP, a double and two twin staterooms. Satin-finished oak joinery imparts a warm, contemporary ambiance throughout, while every cabin is equipped with entertainment systems and en-suite bathrooms to ensure comfort during extended passages.

At the time of build the original owner commissioned a notable layout refinement to maximize privacy and volume in the master suite; by relocating crew quarters aft the master gained an enlarged bathroom and a significantly more generous footprint than the standard arrangement, creating a more secluded and spacious owner's domain than typically found in this class.

She has never been chartered, a distinction that reflects careful ownership and contributes to her excellent overall condition. Propulsion comes from twin MTU 16V2000-CR engines, delivering a top speed of around 25 knots and a comfortable cruise of approximately 18 knots. ABT-TRAC bow and stern thrusters and the TRAC stabilizer system enhance close-quarters handling and onboard comfort both underway and at anchor.

The bridge is thoughtfully equipped with Furuno GPS, Simrad autopilot and depth instruments, plus TracVision satellite capability. The galley is fitted with premium Miele appliances and Sub-Zero refrigeration; Dometic air conditioning, a Bose entertainment suite and a Besenzoni passerelle further enrich life aboard. Currently lying in Turkey, this 2011 Sunseeker 34M

represents a compelling option for private ownership, balancing speed, interior volume, brand prestige and condition within the 30–35m luxury motor yacht category.



DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Navigation & communication equipment

An advanced Furuno GPS anchors the navigation suite, complemented by a TracVision satellite system for offshore reception, while Simrad VHF, a Simrad autopilot, a Simrad depth gauge, and a Simrad compass provide confident control and complete situational awareness at any speed. Precision docking is effortless with ABT Trac bow and stern thrusters, ride comfort is assured by Trac stabilizers, and a robust Newmar inverter delivers clean, efficient onboard power. Seamless connectivity is enabled via Turkcell WiFi to keep guests connected underway and in port.

Galley and laundry equipment

The gourmet galley is outfitted with a Miele dishwasher, Miele oven, and Miele microwave; cold storage is abundant with two Sub Zero refrigerators and two Sub Zero freezers, while two Vitrifrigo ice makers keep entertaining effortless. For extended cruising, the utility space features two Miele washing machines and two Miele dryers to handle laundry with ease and reliability.

Other machinery & systems

An ASEA Power shore power converter delivers seamless, worldwide electrical compatibility, while Dometic air conditioning and Dometic heating maintain the perfect onboard climate. A Bose entertainment system immerses the interior in rich, detailed sound, the Besenzoni passerelle streamlines boarding, and an Idromar fresh water maker provides long range autonomy.
