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OVERVIEW

Sleek both in silhouette and in interior finish, this 34m motor yacht commands attention with understated elegance, an interior fashioned for effortless entertaining and guest comfort, an expansive sun deck, and a well-established luxury charter yacht pedigree. The color scheme marries creamy neutrals with deep, sumptuous accents to create a contemporary, welcoming environment, and Soulmate remains immaculate following a comprehensive refresh of upholstery and soft furnishings by Sabrina Monte Carlo alongside meticulous winter maintenance.

Richly appointed and feature-filled, she presents a fold-down balcony off the main-salon dining area, sweeping vistas from the full-beam owner's suite, a private foredeck lounge reserved for the master, a sundeck jacuzzi for relaxed afternoons, an illuminated onyx feature wall, and intricate hand-crafted mosaic detailing that punctuates the living spaces.

Deck by deck the arrangement flows naturally: from the aft main-deck alfresco dining one steps into the open-plan salon linked to the interior dining, then forward to the galley, lobby, day head, and the master suite. The owner's stateroom boasts a walk-in dressing room, a generous en suite with a large shower and double basins, and a full-beam bedroom with forward views plus private access to a secluded sunbathing terrace.

Below, the lower deck accommodates four guest staterooms — two VIP doubles, one additional double and one fixed twin — each with its own en suite. Above, the flybridge and sundeck are superbly arranged with a full dining table, bar, jacuzzi, extensive sunpads and direct bridge access, forming an ideal layout for a modern superyacht, flybridge yacht and family-friendly charter vessel.

DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Accommodations

Stylish inside and out, this 34m yacht packs a serious punch with sophisticated interior design, an optimised layout for socialising and guest comfort, a spacious sundeck and a proven, successful charter history. The interior is composed in elegant tones of cream with dark accents, creating a contemporary, warm and welcoming ambience, while Soulmate remains immaculately fresh thanks to an extensive upholstery and soft furnishing update by Sabrina Monte Carlo and meticulous winter maintenance each season. Filled with thoughtful features—including a fold down balcony serving the main salon dining area, panoramic views from the master cabin, a private forward lounging area ahead of the master, a jacuzzi on the sundeck, a back lit onyx wall and handcrafted mosaics—she balances glamour with true liveability. Deck by deck, the flow is effortless: from the main deck aft exterior dining room you step directly into the main salon, which opens to the interior dining, and then move forward to the galley, lobby and day head, before arriving at the full beam Master suite. The Master comprises a walk in dressing room and an ensuite with a large shower and double sink, while the bedroom stretches full beam with panoramic views forward to a secluded sunbathing area accessed directly from the suite. On the lower deck there are four guest staterooms—two VIP doubles, one double and one fixed twin—each with its own ensuite. Above, the upper deck unfolds as a superb sundeck, complete with a full dining table, bar, jacuzzi, sunbathing area, and convenient flybridge and bridge access.

Audio & visual equipment

In the main saloon, entertainment revolves around Apple TV feeding a 46"

Bang & Olufsen TV, paired with a Bang & Olufsen HI FI/DVD/TV system, a universal receiver for SAT TV and a B&O BeoSound 5, all set against dimmer light regulation to tailor the mood. The seating aft deck features a 32' HI FI/TV with an electric opening system complemented by dimmer light regulation, while the sundeck mirrors this with a 32' HI FI/TV and an electrical opening system for open air cinema nights. The owner's stateroom enjoys Videoworks integration alongside a Bang & Olufsen HI FI/DVD/TV system, a 46' B&O TV, a universal receiver for SAT TV, a B&O BeoSound 5 and dimmer light regulation. The VIP cabin follows suit with Videoworks, a Bang & Olufsen HI FI/DVD/TV system, a 40' B&O TV, a universal receiver for SAT TV and dimmer light regulation, as do the guest cabins with Videoworks, a Bang & Olufsen HI FI/DVD/TV system, a 40' B&O TV and a universal receiver for SAT TV, again under dimmer light regulation. Crew areas are not forgotten, equipped with a universal receiver for SAT TV, dimmer light regulation and a Radio/CD/DVD/TV with a 22' LED screen, while the flybridge also offers a 32' HI FI/TV on an electric opening system for versatile outdoor viewing.

Deck equipment

Purposeful hardware underscores effortless outdoor living: double windlass vertical Ercole units by Lofrans handle anchoring with assurance, supported by double aft warping capstans—cockpit winches, also by Lofrans—while two anchors deploy on chains measuring 2x 120m. A hydraulic tender and jetski garage by Sanguinetti integrates a lifting crane with 1,200kg lifting capacity, complemented by an extra wide Besenzoni hydraulic passerelle, a custom made Besenzoni hydraulic side boarding ladder and a side hydraulic gangway dedicated to tender boarding. Relaxation is elevated by a custom made glass whirlpool, and the teak clad custom made extendable hydraulic swim platform adds water level versatility. Practical touches include a cockpit canvas full enclosure for all weather comfort, a Besenzoni hydraulic

bathing ladder measuring 160cm wide and 200cm long with 800kg lifting capacity, and underwater hull lighting with a stern side underwater camera, enhanced by special effect LED lighting that weaves outside and inside.

Auxiliary machinery & electrical system

Power is delivered by 2x 1,920Hp MTU 12V 2000 M94 engines, with engine hours recorded as Port 2,798h (09/07/2025) and Stb 2,812h (09/07/2025). Ship's power is supported by 2x Kohler generators—1x 70kW and 1x 53kW, 230/400 V 50Hz—with generator hours at 6,400h (09/07/2025) and 4,948h (09/07/2025), plus 1x Fischer Panda 36kW Night for silent running. Propulsion and handling are refined by 2x Rolla Propeller 5 blades, a CMC Marine Bow Thruster Electric and a CMC Marine Stern Thruster Hydraulic. Comfort at sea and at anchor is assured with CMC Zero Speed Stabilisers, active both underway and at anchor. Hotel systems are equally robust: air conditioning is by Condaria 240.000BTU with air treatment, fresh water autonomy is secured by 2x Idromar water makers, black and grey water are processed via a Hamann purification plant, fuel quality is safeguarded by an Alpha Laval fuel cleaner and 2x Double Racor fuel filters. Electrical resilience comes from a battery system dedicated to service, engine and start circuits, using maintenance free gel type batteries.

Communication & navigation

Seamless global connectivity is delivered by SATCOM via a Sea Tel 3004 100cm TV SAT Antenna with automatic digital control and a Sea Tel 3001 100cm V SAT Antenna dedicated to data and voice communication, while VHF capability comprises 2x VHF units including 1 Sailor DSC and long range coverage is ensured by 1x SSB Sailor. Navigation intelligence centers on I Bridge® Single Touch by Team Italia, a customized monitoring system

comprised of 5x touch screens displaying tank levels, lights, AC, engine data, doors and hatches and technical data. Situational awareness is sharpened by 2x Furuno Navnet 3 radars, positioning by 1x GPS Furuno, and voyage planning through 2x plotters via Furuno Navnet 3.

Galley

The galley is appointed for professional grade service, with a Miele Ceran cooking plate, Miele microwave, Miele dishwasher, Miele oven and a Miele coffee machine, all supported by a wine cooler and three zone stainless steel fridges, while the domestic domain extends to the crew quarters with a dedicated refrigerator and a washing machine/dryer to keep operations running smoothly.

Toys & tenders

Adventure is always at hand with a 5.5m WILLIAMS 505 Diesel Jet Tender, a one person JOBE towable ring, two JOBE inflatable paddle boards, a JOBE wakeboard, a waterski set (2023), a two seater SEADOO Spark Jet Ski (2024 Model) and two Seabobs F5 Sport (2024 Model), ensuring every day on the water can be as spirited or as serene as you wish.

Safety & security

Peace of mind comes as standard, with 2x safes for valuables, 4x inflatable life rafts for 8 persons each, an emergency switch board in the pilothouse, and a CCTV control system with 6 cameras covering the deck, fly, cockpit and engine room. Fire protection is comprehensive, thanks to an automatic antifire system with fire/smoke warning for all cabins and the engine room.

Refit log

Winter 2024–2025 saw the yacht meticulously refreshed: the hull and superstructure received full polishing with touch ups; new carpet was laid in the main salon and all cabins; marble was polished; exterior cushion covers were renewed; a new dishwasher was installed on the sun deck; a new harmonic filter was fitted; the crane underwent an overhaul with Sanguinetti; the swim platform was overhauled; the tender was overhauled; all sea water pumps and valves were serviced and replaced as needed; the toilet system was overhauled with pipe cleaning; the Stability booklet was renewed; the flag was changed to Marshall Islands Commercial, requiring additional safety equipment and new immersion suits; and routine main engine and generator maintenance was carried out based on running hours. During Winter 2022–2023, service covered main engines and generators, pumps for fresh water, grey water and black water, as well as AC; the refrigerator pump was serviced with pipeline cleaning; the diesel free pump was serviced; new marble was installed on the floor in the master shower; the swimming ladder was overhauled; all five sliding doors were overhauled; the hard top was overhauled; the water maker was serviced; the AC circulation pump and sea pump were overhauled; the crane and passerelle were serviced; and the laundry machine, dryer and dishwasher were serviced. Winter 2021–2022 focused on reliability, with battery replacement for service, radio and emergency circuits; replacement of marble in the main deck corridor; installation of a fan coil unit in the battery room to cool the batteries; overhaul of all fan coils; cleaning of all ducts; complete overhaul of the water maker; overhaul of fire/bilge pumps; installation of a new carbon shower at the stern; sanitization and cleaning of fresh water pipelines; overhaul of 2x bow winches Lofrans, vertical model Ercole; and new memory foam mattresses for the crew. In Winter 2020–2021 the yacht completed the 5 year RINA Special Survey; underwent major service of all pumps; full service of both generators;

full service of both main engines and gearboxes; installation of a new compressor for the galley fridges; and new starting batteries for main engines and generators. The comprehensive Winter 2019–2020 program replaced and serviced the fuel pump, water pump and coolant on the portside main engine, fully serviced the starboard main engine, replaced the exhaust elbow and part of the exhaust piping on Generator 1, replaced the A/C sea water pump and piping with the circulating pump overhauled, rinsed the A/C system and replaced glycol in the system, carried out a major service on the stern hydraulic platform with stainless steel supports repaired and reinforced and hydraulic leaks contained, replaced membranes on the Idromar water maker with the system serviced, replaced elements and anodes on the boilers, replaced the hot water circulating pump, replaced the macerating pump and dosing pump motor on the Hamann sewage treatment, replaced one water pump, the piping and the compressor starter in the fridge system and overhauled two further water pumps, carried out a Megger test, replaced the Central UPS 10KV, fully serviced and repaired the Williams tender and Seadoo Jet Ski, replaced swivel links (RINA certified) on both anchor chains, undertook the annual RINA survey and completed all works to make SOULMATE comply with RINA Commercial on the Maltese flag.

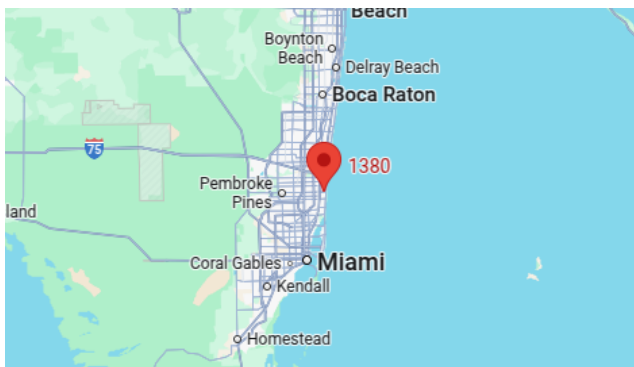
