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## OVERVIEW

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A superyacht-style tri-deck motor yacht features an enclosed skylounge with dayhead, a pilothouse with settee, chart desk, and a main-deck owner's suite plus four ensuite guest cabins below. Three crew cabins forward. Main salon and formal dining sit by a galley with screens and doors. Bespoke interior elevates every space. A bow lounge with sunpads and Jacuzzi joins a large beach club, utility room, and hydraulic swim platform aft.

# DETAILED DESCRIPTION

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## Structure

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Finished in a pristine white gel coat, the yacht's one-piece hull and superstructure are crafted using the licensed SCRIMP™ process enhanced by Horizon's patented 6D infusion, delivering improved strength with reduced weight and integrating longitudinal and transverse stringers for exceptional rigidity. The hybrid hull bottom blends sandwich construction with solid fiberglass, while high-density Divinycell or equivalent foam cores reinforce the hull sides, decks, superstructure, and stringers. Every interior structural component is meticulously bonded to the hull, and a strong collision bulkhead adds an extra margin of safety.

Below the waterline, international anti-fouling bottom paint with anti-osmosis treatment protects the structure, complemented by PropSpeed/PropGold metal coatings on all underwater appendages. Tunnels reduce draft for greater efficiency, and the High Performance Piercing Bow (HPPB) is safeguarded by stainless steel protection plates.

Topside, the upper deck features a refined bump-out design to both port and starboard, and an asymmetrical skylounge broadens the beam to starboard for enhanced interior volume. The build is validated by BV Certificates for stability and structure, and safety at sea is further assured with two ten-person life rafts.

## Forward & aft decks

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An expansive teak aft deck sets the stage for alfresco living, where fixed seating frames a round dining table with seating for ten and a side entrance leads directly to the beach club. For precise handling at the stern, two Maxwell

VC3500 electric rope capstans stand ready, complemented by two bulwark side doors positioned near the aft deck for effortless boarding and wind and weather doors on each side that lead forward to the side decks. Boarding versatility is assured by a MarQuipt eight-step carbon-fiber side-boarding sea stair with teak-planked steps and two removable handrails, as well as a hydraulic Besenzoni PI883 gangway measuring 6.33 m.

Forward, access is via a starboard staircase and the walkaround on the main deck. The foredeck invites relaxation with U-shaped seating served by sliding tables, a Jacuzzi crowned by a sun pad with drink holders and storage, and sunshades for the bow seating as per layout. Anchoring systems are comprehensive, featuring two Studlink 12.5 mm anchor chains of 165 m each, two 130 kg stainless-steel anchors, and two Maxwell VWC 6000 windlasses with band brakes, all supported by a freshwater and seawater anchor chain washdown system and monitored by two chain counters in the pilothouse. Sightlines and protection are enhanced by frameless windows, with slightly tinted, tempered, laminated Low-E glass for the windshield and tinted, tempered, laminated glass for the side windows.

## Skylounge and pilothouse

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The enclosed skylounge sets a refined tone with an L-shaped sofa and coffee table, a convenient dayhead, and a round table for four beside a fully appointed wet bar with wine cooler, refrigerator/freezer, and sink. Forward, the enclosed pilothouse features two helm chairs, a leaning post, a sofa, and deck, all centered around a custom-designed helm equipped with a full set of engine gauges, a comprehensive monitoring system for important equipment, dedicated fuel and water gauges, and a Ritchie magnetic compass, complemented by a surveillance camera system, bilge pump panel, and navigational lights. A hi-lo glass screen and a pocket door allow the skylounge and pilothouse to be separated as desired, while the walk-around bridge

design carries along the port side bridge forward to the bow deck, and electric Roman blinds provide effortless light control and privacy.

## Boat deck

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The nonskid boat deck is engineered for both effortless entertaining and serious utility, anchored by a hydraulic Steelhead CT3000 davit rated for 3,000 pounds with reinforcement to handle tender operations with confidence. Illumination is commanding and versatile, thanks to four floodlights serving the mast and boat deck complemented by two Tokai Sanshin LED searchlights, while oversize drains with strainers at each corner and internal overboard routing keep the area clean and dry. A thoughtfully appointed wet bar with refrigerator, ice maker, and four barstools invites lively gatherings beside a large U-shaped sofa with ottoman, with a hi-lo 43-inch TV positioned on the starboard side for open-air viewing. Culinary moments are elevated by a hi-lo 24-inch propane BBQ housed within a durable FRP cabinet, and provisions are effortlessly stowed in a 48-inch FRIGID-RIGID freezer with FRP storage. Safety and practicality are further underscored by two Zodiac ten-person life rafts on a custom-made bracket and removable stainless-steel rails encircling the boat deck.

## Open flybridge (tri-deck)

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The open flybridge invites relaxed cruising and effortless entertaining, with a non-skid deck underfoot and a graceful radar arch fitted with an integrated antenna bracket. A protective windshield, secured by a stainless steel frame and complemented by stainless steel rails, enhances comfort underway, while a dedicated staircase from the boat deck to the flybridge ensures easy movement between levels. Practicality meets polish with a handheld remote plug-in receptacle positioned per the layout, as well as generous lounging that

begins with a forward extra-large sunpad, continues with a large L-shaped sofa paired with a coffee table, and culminates aft in a sunbed featuring upright cushion backs and convenient side tables. Service is seamless at the wet bar, complete with a sink, refrigerator, ice maker, and ample storage.

## Beach club

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At the water's edge, the teak beach club unfolds onto a teak swim platform, with matching teak steps guiding you seamlessly up to the boat deck and back down to the water. A hydraulic transom door, featuring a centrally positioned pantograph door, opens to reveal the space and integrates a rain shower discreetly on the underside. The Hydraulic Hi-Lo swim platform (1,360 kg/3,000 lbs lifting capacity) with two removable corner rails makes launching, bathing, and boarding effortless. Thoughtfully arranged L-shaped seating and a custom bar with three stools, a conventional microwave, refrigerator/freezer, burner, sink, and a 32-inch TV create an inviting, amenity-rich waterfront lounge. Completing the experience, a utility room offers a dayhead, wet locker, wet storage room, dedicated diving tank storage, and a washer/dryer combo to keep every adventure perfectly organized.

## Engine and propulsion details

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Power comes from twin CAT C32B engines rated at 2,400 hp, delivering authoritative thrust through high-performance S-class five-blade propellers. Stability and maneuverability are assured by NAIAD zero-speed stabilizers, model 525, and NAIAD hydraulic bow and stern thrusters, models 16LHT at 710 kg and 16SHT at 580 kg, while a Humphree Interceptor system with two HE1150 and two HE1100 units optimizes running attitude. Command is precise with Jastram digital electric control, backed by an emergency manual hydraulic steering system, and further enhanced by a tethered engine remote handheld

controller with plug-in points on the tri-deck, boat deck, aft deck, and pilothouse.

Engineering fundamentals include engine loads distributed through flexible mountings on a stainless-steel engine bed bonded to the FRP hull girder and an engine alarm system installed as per engine standard. Drive components are specified for durability with bronze struts with backing plates, shaft and rudder packing glands fitted with Tides Marine dripless seals, and an underwater exhaust system for the engines with bypass mufflers and anti-noise treatment to the exhaust system. The engine room is designed with a lightweight honeycomb floor for a clean, accessible workspace, accessed through a heavy-duty insulated engine room door, and fitted with stainless-steel overhead grab rails on each side of the engines, Delta-T engine room demisters, and an air compressor.

## Mechanical systems

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Designed for long-range confidence and quiet onboard comfort, the yacht's mechanical suite begins with 5,500 US gallons (20,800 liters) of fuel capacity carried in tanks fitted with sight and electrical gauges, protected by two Racor 500 MA fuel filters—one on each generator—and supported by two electric fuel transfer pumps and one fuel polishing system rated at 210 GPH.

Freshwater autonomy is assured by an 800 US gallon (3,025 liters) freshwater tank feeding three 40 US gallon water heaters, a high-volume AC freshwater pressure pump with a backup DC pump, and a hot water circulation pump. The watermaker system comprises the Spot Zero SeaXchange XTC II 1800 and the Spot Zero ZTC II 2000, while charcoal filters are plumbed into the freshwater line at the shore water inlet and in the galley for pristine taste. Climate control is delivered by a Marine Air chilled-water air-conditioning system with VFD, complemented by a Honeywell DR65A3000 dehumidification system with five units to maintain ideal humidity throughout. Essential amenities include a

Headhunter toilet system working in concert with a Headhunter sanitary treatment system (TW-HMX 6001LP), a dive compressor (Bauer Junior II) for underwater pursuits, and pre-wiring for ElectroSea (CL-2000-X2.0) to future-proof the seawater management suite.

Practicality meets preparedness with a 200 US gallon holding tank and deck fitting for dockside pump-out, plus a 200 US gallon sump tank with a dedicated pump for each shower and water drainage area; electric level indicators monitor both holding and sump tanks at a glance. Safety and shipkeeping are further enhanced by an electric Rule bilge pump, high water level bilge alarm, and bilge exhaust ventilation fans, while the engine room benefits from fire insulation and fire-resistant treatment at all pipe penetrations. Fire protection includes an automatic fire damper system and eight portable fire extinguishers, monitored by an integrated fire alarm system in the pilothouse with a heat or smoke detector in each cabin. The specification also details an auto shutdown system and an additional automatic fire damper system, alongside five portable fire extinguishers and an integrated fire alarm in the pilothouse with heat and smoke detectors in each cabin, with a dedicated fire pump supplying outlets and hydrants to complete this comprehensive safety architecture.

## Electrical systems

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Engineered for confidence and convenience, the yacht's electrical architecture delivers robust safety, seamless power management, and refined ambience. GFI protection safeguards all AC outlets across the exterior areas, heads, galley, and engine room, while an electrolysis bonding system and cathodic protection with zinc anodes defend shafts, struts, and associated underwater gear. Illumination is both efficient and dramatic, with an LED lighting system throughout the interior and exterior, six underwater lights that enrich the night-time profile, and two LED search lights for precise visibility,

complemented by pre-wiring for an LED boat name on the stern and on the port and starboard flybridge sides. Power generation and conversion are expertly handled by two Kohler generators rated at 55 kW and 60 Hz with sound shields, a Magnus air-cooled frequency convertor (model SP150 80kVA), and comprehensive shore power solutions that include two Glendinning shore power Cablemasters—each 100Amp with a 75' power cable—and a shore power connection with two 100Amp ISO boost transformers wired as polarization transformers. Command and oversight are intuitive and reliable via a Yacht controller (Supremo with speed button and joystick) and a Maretron monitoring and control system, while entertainment is elevated by a Sonos stereo system integrated with a Control4 system.

## Interior décor and equipment

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Guest accommodations include an on-deck master, a mirrored VIP, a starboard midship VIP, and a port guest stateroom, each ensuite, creating a harmonious balance of privacy and comfort. Practical luxury continues with a dedicated laundry room equipped with a washer and dryer, a linen locker, storage, an ironing board, and a sink. The forward crew area features three ensuite crew cabins and a well-appointed crew mess with direct access to the starboard-side galley, ensuring effortless service. A customized interior package refines the décor and lighting throughout, enhancing ambiance by day and night. Dining is elevated by a full Wedgwood (GIO) tableware service for ten, including a dish holder, pot/pan, dishes, plates, knives, forks, glasses, etc. For extended cruising, an extra set of bed sheets is provided for all guest cabins, including the crew.

## Salon

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Enter through a locally crafted stainless-steel electric sliding entrance door into

a refined salon where comfort and sophistication converge. A convenient dayhead is thoughtfully positioned nearby, while the main lounge is anchored by a U-shaped sofa with a coffee table atop a custom area rug for a tailored, inviting ambiance. To starboard, a coffee table is paired with two swivel chairs, creating an intimate conversation nook, and to port a buffet cabinet sits neatly behind the sofa to keep the space uncluttered and elegant. A custom formal dining table provides seating for ten, ideal for celebratory dinners, and a seamlessly integrated 65-inch TV completes the setting with cinematic entertainment.

## Galley

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An enclosed galley design with a hi-lo privacy screen and pocket and hinged doors creates a dedicated culinary domain, while the professional setup centers on an island equipped with a trash compactor, microwave, instant hot, and a cleverly hidden chair. Cold storage is abundant, featuring a full-height refrigerator and freezer complemented by an additional under-counter refrigerator and freezer, and service is elevated by a Scotsman ice maker, a wine cooler, and a coffee maker. Fresh sea air and natural light are welcomed through one opening porthole, ensuring the space feels both refined and refreshingly practical.

## Master stateroom

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A serene retreat centered on a king bed with drawers beneath, flanked by nightstands and secured by a built-in safe. To starboard, a plush loveseat invites relaxation, while to port a vanity desk provides a refined workspace, with hanging lockers to both port and starboard. The ensuite includes a head with sink and a rain shower, along with a his-and-hers head with sink, toilet, and thoughtfully arranged storage. Comfort and technology come together

with electric blinds, four opening portholes to welcome sea breezes, a 55-inch TV paired with a home entertainment system, an escape hatch in the master with ladder, and extra wireless chargers for effortless convenience.

## Mirrored queen staterooms (two)

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The mirrored queen staterooms are thoughtfully appointed with queen beds framed by storage drawers and a nightstand, complemented by large hanging lockers for generous wardrobe space. Each offers a private ensuite head with a sink, mirrored cabinetry, a shower with a rain shower head, and a toilet, while prewired provisions for electric Roman shades allow effortless control of light and privacy. Entertainment is seamlessly integrated with a 43-inch LED TV and a home entertainment system, and for added safety and convenience the port stateroom includes a dedicated escape hatch.

## Midship guest stateroom

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Positioned amidships for superior comfort and tranquility, the guest stateroom presents a restful queen bed complemented by a nightstand and ample storage drawers, with hanging lockers to keep wardrobes impeccably organized. Entertainment is at the ready with a 43-inch LED TV paired to a home entertainment system, while the space is prewired for electric Roman shades to tailor light and privacy with ease. The ensuite head is thoughtfully appointed with a sink, mirror cabinets, a shower featuring a rain shower head, and a toilet, delivering complete convenience and refined comfort.

## Twin port guest stateroom

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This inviting retreat features twin beds with one sliding bed to tailor the sleeping arrangement to your guests' needs, complemented by a generous

hanging locker for refined stowage. An ensuite head provides a sink, mirror cabinet, rain shower head, and toilet for complete comfort and privacy. The ambiance is ready for customization with prewired electric Roman shades, while entertainment is assured by a 32-inch LED TV paired with an integrated home entertainment system.

## Crew quarters forward

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Designed for comfort and efficiency, the forward crew area centers on a well-appointed captain's cabin with two hanging lockers, a 32-inch LED TV, and a private ensuite head. Two additional crew bunk cabins, each with a hanging locker and ensuite head, ensure every member enjoys personal space and proper stowage. A welcoming crew mess brings the team together with a 32-inch TV, dining area, sink, convection microwave and cooktop, and a fridge/freezer, complemented by generous pantry storage. Practical touches include a washer/dryer and a dedicated crew staircase providing direct access into the galley, streamlining service and maintaining guest privacy.

## Electronics

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Connectivity and entertainment are anchored by a TV antenna mounted atop the radar arch, complemented by satellite TV via KVH TracVision UHD7 with a matching dummy dome and satellite phone pre-wire only. A 4G cellular routing system with Wi-Fi keeps you online, while the integrated Control4 system harmonizes onboard technologies. Communications are managed by five Panasonic PBX telephones with intercom feature, and an exterior connector provides convenient shore phone and cable TV access. Security and situational awareness are elevated by a surveillance camera system, a motion detecting light at the guest foyer close to the staircase, and prewiring for FLIR night vision.

## Pilothouse navigation

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Command the helm with a comprehensive Garmin navigation suite anchored by a Garmin GPS with satellite compass for precise positioning and heading. Long range awareness is delivered by two open array radars—one 48 inch 12 kW 96 nm array and one 72 inch 12 kW 96 nm array—feeding four Garmin GPSMAP 9224 24 inch multifunction displays for seamless, at a glance situational insight. An MBB300C interface streams Maretron data to the Garmin displays, while one new Garmin GRID 20 remote input device places effortless control at your fingertips. Performance intelligence is enriched by Garmin fishfinder, wind, speed, and temperature transducers, and confident passage making is assured with the SIMRAD AP70 MK2 autopilot system, Garmin AIS, and two Garmin VHF radios.

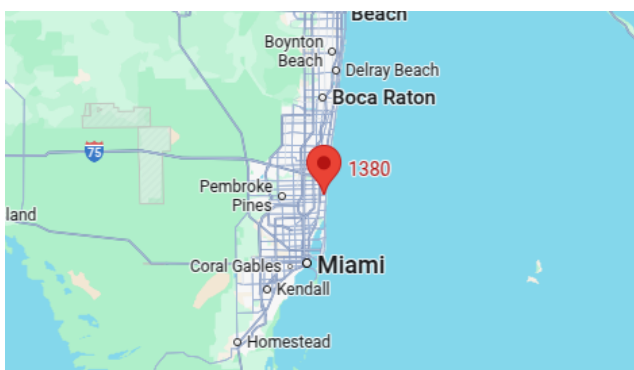
