OVERVIEW

A beautifully proportioned 112 foot motor yacht, built in 2012 and currently lying in the United States, she marries commanding presence with refined comfort. Her 23 foot beam and robust fiberglass composite hull with matching fiberglass decks give the yacht a solid, reassuring stance while preserving a hushed, graceful motion underway. Twin MTU inboard diesel engines deliver a relaxed 18 knot cruise and spirited bursts to 25 knots, combining long-range efficiency with sport yacht responsiveness. A draft of approximately 18 feet speaks to serious seakeeping and composure in open water, and with 5,500 gallons of fuel and 1,000 gallons of fresh water aboard, the yacht supports extended passages, weekend getaways, and multi week adventures without frequent refueling.

Boarding reveals how the generous beam translates into expansive, flowing living areas perfect for both elegant entertaining and leisurely family time. Broad exterior decks invite alfresco dining, sun lounging, and convivial evenings, while the main salon provides a luminous, versatile space for panoramic views, conversation, and bespoke furnishings. The layout encourages effortless movement between interior and exterior, so every gathering—whether a formal reception or a quiet sunset aperitif—feels naturally elevated.

Practicality and refinement are woven together: low maintenance fiberglass decks, efficient diesel propulsion, and carefully engineered systems that simplify operations for owner operators and professional crews alike. From tranquil morning departures to brisk hops between anchorages, she is poised, responsive, and reassuringly steady at the helm. This 2012 build retains timeless lines and character, offering a compelling platform for coastal cruising, island hopping, and upscale entertaining in U.S. waters and beyond.

For owners seeking a significant step up in size, stability, and refinement without sacrificing speed or style, this 112 foot yacht stands ready to exceed expectations.

DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Introduction

SIMPLICITY stands as a textbook example of a two owner yacht that has been impeccably cared for, used strictly privately, and attended by a full time professional crew. Delivered new in 2012, this Westport 112 belongs to a proven series that has enjoyed steady demand among discerning buyers. She welcomes up to eight guests in four beautifully appointed, all en suite cabins, including a full beam owner's suite with a king size bed, a walk in wardrobe, and his and her bathrooms. Below deck, a forward VIP suite with a private entrance is complemented by two additional guest cabins, one double and one twin. In the engine room, twin MTU 16V2000 engines deliver up to 25 knots, with an estimated cruising speed of 18 knots; under current ownership she has often served as a mothership, running comfortably at 12 knots while the tender sprints ahead to adventure. Mechanically and cosmetically, SIMPLICITY is in superb condition and genuinely turnkey for her next owner. Owner will consider trades.

Electrical equipment

Electrical power is anchored by two Northern Lights 65 kW generators, while shoreside connectivity is handled by two ASEA shore power converters for seamless, reliable service at the dock.

Electronics

The helm and entertainment suite is comprehensively outfitted with a Simrad AP50 autopilot, a Ritchie six inch compass, a Furuno FCV 1200L depth sounder, dual Furuno GP 150 GPS units, a log speedometer, a dedicated

navigation center with plotter and computer, a radar detector, and twin Furuno X Band radars. Communications are assured by two ICOM VHF sets, while wind speed and direction instrumentation and data repeaters enhance situational awareness. On the entertainment side, a TV set, DVD player, CD player, VCR, cockpit speakers, and a radio round out a well balanced onboard media experience.

Inside equipment

Comfort and convenience are elevated by a Marine Air air conditioning system, heating and hot water, and a full suite of domestic appliances including a Bosch dishwasher, a GE microwave, a Dacor induction cooktop paired with a Dacor oven, a Sub Zero refrigerator, and two Miele washing machines. Practical systems include an electric bilge pump, a seawater pump, a fresh water maker, and a bow thruster for precise handling.

Outside equipment

On deck, a Nautical Structures davit pairs with a Nautical Structures hydraulic gangway and a traditional gangway to simplify tender handling and boarding, while safety is strengthened by two Zodiac eight person liferafts.

Additional information

Further highlights include two Northern Lights 65 kW generators, rebuilt; a Headhunter Tidal Wave HMX sewage treatment system; Zero Speed stabilizers; and extra large backing plates added to the stern cleats to support towing a Valhalla 41.
