

DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Salon

The 112 Westport boasts a full beam salon, ingeniously designed to maximize interior space, creating a vast and opulent setting. The salon is embellished with full-length tinted glass windows, adorned with custom treatments, offering breathtaking views of the surrounding vistas. At the heart of this sophisticated area lies a formal dining space, complete with a bespoke table and chairs that comfortably accommodate eight guests, all under a lighted tray ceiling that exudes elegance. Strategically positioned raised buffets with cabinet storage on both port and starboard sides provide both utility and style. As you move towards the aft, you encounter a welcoming seating area featuring a plush full-size sofa, a love seat, an armchair, a coffee table, and matching end tables, crafting a perfect spot for relaxation. To starboard, a distinct area with two high-back chairs and a game table offers a cozy nook for leisure activities. Just to the port of the double glass sliding door, a granite-topped wet bar with a mirrored backsplash and a built-in compact 25-bottle wine chiller stands ready, ideal for hosting guests. Ample outboard storage cabinets ensure everything is neatly organized, preserving the salon's elegant and uncluttered look.

The digital entertainment center received a significant upgrade in 2023, now featuring a new 60" Samsung flat-screen HDTV, a Samsung Blu-ray player, a DirecTV box, and a Marantz AV system. These are effortlessly managed by a 10" iPad equipped with the Crestron app, ensuring entertainment is always within reach. This salon epitomizes luxury and modern convenience, delivering an unmatched experience on the water.

Galley

AMICO features an expansive "country kitchen" style galley, meticulously crafted with storage cabinets both above and below, offering abundant space for all your culinary essentials. The custom granite countertops and backsplash provide ample room for preparing gourmet meals. Ingeniously designed, a deep slide-out pantry has been incorporated into the space in front of the large double door Sub-Zero refrigerator/freezer, ensuring optimal use of every inch. For added privacy, a door can be closed to separate the formal area aft from the galley.

The galley flows effortlessly into the adjoining dining area, divided by a granite-topped bar with two high-back padded chairs, ideal for casual dining or entertaining guests. The settee includes a U-shaped leather-upholstered seating area with a granite tabletop, creating a warm and inviting atmosphere for dining.

In 2023, the digital entertainment system was enhanced with a new 60" Samsung HDTV, Apple TV, a Marantz AV system, and a 10" iPad with the Crestron app, ensuring entertainment is always within reach.

The galley is outfitted with premium appliances to satisfy all your cooking needs. These include a Scotsman under-counter ice maker, a Bosch under-counter dishwasher, a Wolf convection oven, a JennAire induction cooktop, and an LG microwave above the cooktop. This elegantly equipped galley is designed to fulfill every culinary wish, making it a true highlight of the yacht.

Port and starboard foyers

The starboard foyer exemplifies elegance, boasting stunning marble inlaid floors that establish a luxurious ambiance. A marble console paired with a matching shelf offers both utility and sophistication, while a bronzed wall

mirror and an overhead mirror amplify the sense of space and brightness. This foyer also features a sliding side door, granting easy access to the foredeck and seamlessly merging indoor and outdoor spaces.

On the port side, the foyer maintains the theme of refinement with its marble flooring. This section is equipped with a guest laundry, complete with premium Miele appliances, including a washer and dryer, ensuring all laundry tasks are handled effortlessly. A sliding side door also leads to the foredeck, while a stairwell provides access to three staterooms, facilitating a smooth transition between various areas of the yacht. These foyers are crafted to blend practicality with luxury, enhancing the overall onboard experience.

Stew pantry and dog house

Positioned forward and to starboard of the salon, the entry to the stew pantry and dog house is both practical and unobtrusive. The stew pantry is meticulously arranged with generous cabinet storage, ensuring all essentials are well-organized and readily accessible. It includes a JennAir double drawer refrigerator, offering effective cooling solutions for your culinary requirements. Furthermore, the pantry houses a breaker panel, allowing for easy access to all electrical systems for swift adjustments. A pocket door opens to the interior dog house, seamlessly incorporating these functional areas into the yacht's overall design. This space is crafted to elevate the onboard experience by merging functionality with thoughtful design.

Master stateroom

The full beam master stateroom is a haven of opulence and relaxation, entered through graceful double doors. At its center lies a California king-sized walk-around bed, equipped with two drawers beneath for additional storage. The mirrored headboard, ceiling treatment, and recessed lighting cultivate an

atmosphere of elegance and peace. To port, a 14-drawer dresser offers generous space for personal attire, keeping everything neatly arranged. On the starboard side of the bed, a built-in desk with a slide-out seat provides a practical workspace or vanity.

The stateroom also includes a spacious cedar-lined walk-in closet, offering ample room to easily accommodate a couple's wardrobe. Forward, separate doors lead to the "his and hers" bathroom, ensuring privacy and convenience for both users. A 55" curved Samsung HDTV is mounted on the wall, providing optimal viewing from any angle in the room. In 2023, the digital entertainment system was enhanced with Apple TV, a Marantz AV system, a DirecTV box, and a 10" iPad with the Crestron control app, delivering cutting-edge entertainment and control at your fingertips. This master stateroom is crafted to be a private sanctuary, blending elegance with modern conveniences.

Master head

The master head on this vessel is a lavish "His and Hers" bathroom, artfully crafted to ensure both privacy and shared comfort. The two distinct bathrooms are seamlessly connected by a glass stall shower and a Jacuzzi tub, delivering a spa-like retreat on the water. Each bathroom, accessible from either port or starboard, includes a mirrored vanity with custom granite-topped counters, sinks, cabinets, and drawers, all enhanced by Royal Flush toilets for an added touch of elegance.

The Jacuzzi tub stands out as a centerpiece, featuring a Grohe waterfall-style faucet and featuring multiple water jets for a soothing soak. The stall shower is equally remarkable, with six horizontal adjustable wall-mounted heads that offer full-body simultaneous coverage, providing a refreshing and invigorating experience. This master head is designed to deliver the pinnacle of luxury and convenience, making it a standout feature of the yacht.

Guest stateroom port

The port guest stateroom is a sanctuary of elegance and comfort, featuring a walk-around queen bed with an innerspring mattress that ensures peaceful nights. The bed is enhanced by an upholstered headboard and custom recessed LED lighting, creating a cozy and welcoming ambiance. Underneath the bed, four drawers offer practical storage solutions. A cedar-lined wardrobe with an interior light provides generous space for hanging clothes, allowing guests to keep their belongings tidy and easily accessible.

On the outboard side, a six-drawer dresser is situated just behind the entertainment center, enhancing the room's functionality. In 2023, the digital entertainment system was upgraded to include a 27" LG TV, Apple TV, a Marantz AV system, a 10" iPad with the Crestron control app, and a Blu-Ray player, ensuring guests have access to premium entertainment options. This guest stateroom is crafted to provide a luxurious and comfortable retreat, making it a standout feature of the yacht.

Guest head port

The en-suite guest head port is an exquisitely designed area that marries elegance with practicality. It boasts custom granite-topped counters that infuse a sense of luxury, while the mirrored vanity amplifies the feeling of space and brightness. The marble floor lays a classic and refined foundation, enhancing the overall aesthetic. A Kohler sink combines style with durability, perfectly matched with Grohe fixtures to ensure a premium experience.

The custom molded fiberglass stall shower is crafted for comfort and convenience, offering a refreshing escape within the stateroom. Completing this elegant setup is a Royal Flush toilet, adding a final touch of sophistication to this well-appointed bathroom. This guest head is crafted to provide a luxurious and comfortable experience, making it a standout feature of the

yacht.

Guest stateroom starboard

The guest stateroom starboard is meticulously crafted to offer both comfort and convenience, featuring twin beds side by side with innerspring mattresses that promise a peaceful night's rest. Each bed is adorned with an upholstered headboard and custom recessed LED lighting, creating a warm and welcoming ambiance. Underneath the beds, two drawers provide practical storage for personal items.

A full-sized hanging locker is included, offering generous space for formal wear and ensuring guests can keep their clothing neat and wrinkle-free. In 2023, the digital entertainment system was enhanced to include a 32" LG TV, Apple TV, a Marantz AV system, a 10" iPad with the Crestron control app, and a Blu-Ray player, providing a broad array of entertainment options to enrich the onboard experience. This guest stateroom is designed to be a comfortable and stylish haven, making it a standout feature of the yacht.

VIP stateroom forward

The VIP stateroom forward, nestled in the bow, is reached via a private stairway located ahead of the galley, ensuring both seclusion and exclusivity. This refined stateroom showcases a walk-around queen berth with an innerspring mattress, delivering outstanding comfort for peaceful nights. The bed is enhanced by an upholstered headboard and custom recessed LED lighting, fostering a tranquil and welcoming ambiance. Underneath the bed, four drawers provide practical storage, while an additional four drawers beneath the entertainment center optimize space utilization.

As guests enter the stateroom, they are welcomed by a cozy couch, offering a quiet nook perfect for enjoying a favorite book. The stateroom also features a

spacious cedar-lined walk-in closet, offering generous space for wardrobe storage and ensuring clothing stays fresh and organized.

In 2023, the digital entertainment system was upgraded to include a 27" LG TV, Apple TV, a Marantz AV system, and a 10" iPad with the Crestron control app, providing a broad selection of entertainment options to enrich the onboard experience. This VIP stateroom is crafted to deliver luxury and comfort, making it a standout feature of the yacht.

Day head

Positioned just forward and to port of the salon, the day head is an exquisitely designed area that blends elegance with practicality. It showcases a custom marble vanity that infuses a sense of luxury, while the marble flooring lays a classic and refined foundation. Gold-accented fixtures enhance the lavish ambiance, perfectly paired with custom LED lighting that creates a warm and welcoming atmosphere. A mirrored ceiling adds to the sense of openness and brightness, making the room feel spacious and airy. Completing this elegant space is a Royal Flush toilet, adding a final touch of sophistication. The day head is crafted to provide both style and convenience, making it a standout feature of the yacht.

Pilothouse

AMICO boasts an enclosed raised pilothouse, crafted to deliver both practicality and comfort. A generous seating area aft, featuring a high gloss wood tabletop, offers owners and guests a breathtaking 270-degree view of the surroundings, all while enjoying the comfort of air conditioning. The pilothouse includes a captain's desk with a floating stool and bookshelf, enabling the crew to carefully plan long-distance voyages. The single centerline adjustable captain's chair provides the operator with an excellent view of the

environment and monitoring equipment, ensuring precise navigation.

To port and forward, a chart table and jump seat are strategically positioned for convenience. The helm electronics received significant upgrades in 2022/2023, now featuring a Garmin 8622 multi-function display, Garmin AIS800, Furuno CV-588 depth sounder, Airmar DST810 transducer, Airmar DST800-L-235-N2 transducer, and a MarineNav computer with TimeZero software. The navigation system is further enhanced by a 7610 Garmin, dual Furuno radar systems, Furuno AIS, dual VHF radio systems, and a 4-view CCTV camera system.

In 2022, a custom Allen Bradley 3 console Panelview touchscreen vessel interface and monitoring system, with custom modified Westport VIC software by Rexel, was installed. The pilothouse contains the main 15" touchscreen display, while two 10" remote touch displays are located on the main deck level and in the crew area. For quick access to the flybridge, a lockable glass sliding door is conveniently placed. This pilothouse exemplifies advanced technology and thoughtful design, ensuring an exceptional yachting experience.

Flybridge

The flybridge of AMICO is a masterpiece of space and utility, crafted to elevate the yachting experience with its well-thought-out design and opulent features. The upper level showcases a beautiful teak deck, creating a warm and welcoming ambiance. Forward wind protection is provided by a clear hard acrylic 270-degree enclosure with fold-up wings, offering uninterrupted views while ensuring comfort.

To starboard, a spacious L-shaped settee with a HI/LOW high gloss teak table creates the perfect setting for alfresco dining. On the port side, an island wet bar is fitted with four swivel top stools, a Fire Magic propane BBQ grill, an under-counter ice maker, and a separate fridge, making it ideal for entertaining. Above, an electronically actuated fold-down 60" Samsung HDTV is

paired with a new DirecTV box, Apple TV, a Marantz AV system, and a 10" iPad with the Crestron control app, delivering exceptional entertainment. The audio experience is further enhanced by a separate Fusion Apollo head unit, JL amplifier, and JL speakers.

The center-lined helm, featuring three captain's chairs, is equipped with 2023 upgraded electronics, including the Garmin 8617 multifunction display and Icom M605 VHF with AIS. Additionally, a networked Garmin 7610 to port and a Garmin repeater screen offer comprehensive navigation capabilities. Port and starboard wing stations provide the captain with superior views during docking.

Descending three steps leads you to the flybridge aft deck, which can be tailored to personal preferences. The built-in Jacuzzi hot tub, accommodating six people, can be transformed into a sun pad with its custom folding top and cushions. Opposite, another L-shaped seating area with a high gloss teak tabletop offers additional relaxation space. Both areas can be shaded from the sun with a custom removable three-tier sun shade. A custom JL sound system sets the ideal musical atmosphere.

Currently, AMICO includes two 2017 Yamaha Wave Runner EX Jet Skis, mounted on custom cradles, which are part of the sale. A Nautical Structures CEZ2000-EX crane provides the lifting power to launch the skis and is large enough to handle a tender if desired.

Finally, a molded spiral staircase with a sliding door provides outdoor access to the cockpit below, seamlessly linking the flybridge with the rest of the yacht.

Swim platform

The teak swim platform on AMICO is a multifunctional and well-appointed space crafted to elevate your aquatic adventures. It includes removable stainless steel railings, offering both security and adaptability. Built into the

deck are ports for whips, crucial for docking the Yamaha Wave Runners included with the yacht, ensuring secure and easy mooring.

A strategically placed 100 US gallon deck fueling station with a pump provides gasoline, keeping the jet skis or tender fueled and ready for exploration. The platform also features stern cleats and dual Maxwell 2500# 24vDC capstans, delivering strong mooring capabilities. On the starboard side, a 100A cord storage ensures power needs are met, while on the port side, a concealed hot/cold deck shower outlet offers a refreshing rinse after swimming.

A watertight door in the transom provides access to the crew area, ensuring the swim platform serves not only as a leisure space but also as a functional component of the yacht's operations. This swim platform is designed to blend luxury with practicality, making it an essential feature of the yacht.

Side deck and foredeck

Entry to the side decks of AMICO is easily accessed through sliding doors situated in the midship foyers. The design incorporates bulwark gates that swing outward and can be fitted with boarding stairs, enhancing both ease of access and safety. On the starboard side deck, a mount is provided for the MarQuipt 6' Sea Steps boarding stairs, facilitating smooth boarding and disembarkation.

As you proceed forward, you'll encounter a molded U-shaped settee with plush cushions, offering an ideal spot for relaxation while taking in the views. The audio experience in this area is elevated by a Fusion head unit, JL amplifier, and JL speakers, delivering superior sound quality for entertainment. Just behind the settee, a spacious Bosun's locker provides generous storage for equipment and supplies.

On the foredeck, dual Maxwell 4500 hydraulic anchor windlass systems are installed, ensuring efficient and dependable anchoring. Additionally, the deck

is equipped with a chain locker and foredeck cleats, enhancing the yacht's strong mooring capabilities. This side deck and foredeck area is thoughtfully crafted to blend luxury with functionality, making it a vital component of the yacht's overall design.

Crew area

The crew quarters on AMICO are meticulously crafted to ensure both comfort and efficiency for the crew. Situated aft, they can be accessed from the main deck via a spiral staircase or through a watertight door in the transom. Inside, the common area provides a welcoming environment with a settee, sink, storage drawers, and cabinets, along with a microwave and a fridge/freezer combo. Entertainment is catered for with a 27" TV featuring a DirecTV system and a Fusion Apollo head unit with speakers, allowing the crew to unwind during their leisure time.

Conveniently positioned below the main breaker panel, the crew's washer and dryer make efficient use of the available space. At the back of the crew area, additional storage is provided, including dual under-counter freezers, cabinets, and overhead storage.

The crew accommodations consist of three cabins that can accommodate a total of four crew members. The captain's quarters are furnished with a full-size innerspring mattress, a desk with a chair, a spacious hanging locker, a multi-drawer dresser, and a 32" Samsung HDTV with DirecTV. The captain also benefits from a private head with a stall shower and a mirrored vanity. The aft crew berth includes a single bunk, a hanging locker, a TV, and a shared head with a stall shower. The starboard crew berth features an over/under two-bunk configuration, a hanging locker, a TV, and a shared head with a stall shower. Access to the engine room is located forward through the crew area, separated by a double dogged airtight door, ensuring safety and operational efficiency. This crew area is designed to provide a comfortable and practical living

environment, making it a vital component of the yacht's operations.

Electronics

In 2023, AMICO received a thorough overhaul of its electronic systems, integrating cutting-edge technology and ensuring seamless connectivity throughout the vessel. The entertainment setup now includes eight Crestron MC4-R media room controllers and eight Marantz SR7015 8k receivers, paired with eight Apple TV units, delivering unmatched audio-visual experiences in every cabin. The visual experience is further enhanced by a selection of high-definition televisions, including a Samsung 65" LED HDTV, a Samsung 60" LED HDTV, two LG 27" LED HDTVs, and an LG 32" LED HDTV.

For satellite TV, the yacht is outfitted with KVH HD11 TracVision and KVH TV3 TracVision Hub, along with the KVH Ultra Compact TracPhone for dependable communication. The network infrastructure is robust, featuring Cisco SG350 and RV345 routers, complemented by a Ruckus Zoneflex 610 WiFi access point and a ZD1205 zone director, ensuring strong and reliable internet connectivity. The PrepWave vessel WiFi cellular data system further boosts connectivity, while 10" iPads are provided for managing the Crestron AV system, offering intuitive and convenient control of the yacht's entertainment and communication systems.

The navigation and communication systems have also been upgraded with the latest technology. This includes the Garmin 8622 and Garmin AIS800 for navigation, the Furuno CV-588 depth sounder, and Airmar DST810 and DST800-L-235-N2 transducers for precise marine data. Additionally, the Garmin 8617 and Icom M605 VHF with AIS ensure comprehensive communication and navigation capabilities. These upgrades position AMICO as a leader in marine electronics, offering both luxury and functionality for an exceptional yachting experience.

Other electronics include

The yacht is outfitted with a suite of sophisticated electronics that significantly enhance navigation and vessel management. In 2022, a custom Allen Bradley touch panel system with three screens was installed, featuring a 15" display and two 10" displays. This interface and monitoring system is powered by customized Westport VIC software developed by Rexel, offering comprehensive control and oversight of the yacht's operations.

Additionally, the yacht is equipped with a MarineNav DC computer, also installed in 2022, which operates Time Zero software and digital charts, ensuring precise and dependable navigation. The navigation capabilities are further bolstered by two Furuno radar systems, each with 20" displays, providing exceptional situational awareness and safety at sea.

For communication, the yacht is equipped with an Icom SSB and both Icom and Standard Horizon VHF radios, ensuring robust and versatile communication capabilities. The Simrad AP20 autopilot offers reliable and precise course management, while the Furuno Weather Fax and Furuno AIS systems provide essential weather and vessel tracking information. These electronics are integral to the yacht's functionality, ensuring a safe and efficient yachting experience.

Electrical system

The electrical system on AMICO is meticulously crafted to ensure reliable and efficient power distribution throughout the yacht. The vessel is fitted with a 100A 240V single-phase 60Hz shore power cord at the aft, and a midships starboard 100A 240V single-phase 60Hz shore power cord equipped with a Cablemaster for easy management. In 2023, two new shore power boost transformers with WiFi monitoring were added, enhancing the system's power management capabilities.

In 2023, the yacht's power system received further upgrades with new 12V starting batteries for the generator and 24V starting batteries for the main engine, ensuring reliable engine starts. Additionally, both 12V and 24V house batteries were replaced, providing robust power storage for onboard systems. New battery chargers were installed, including a 12V 100A charger and a 24V 60A charger, ensuring efficient charging of the yacht's battery banks. For improved visibility and safety, an ACR RCL-100 searchlight with dual controls is installed, along with 13 underwater lights facing aft and out of the port and starboard sides, creating a stunning visual display.

The yacht is equipped with a 120-gallon hot water heater, ensuring a plentiful supply of hot water for all onboard needs. Additionally, a towing light with a separate breaker is included, providing added safety and functionality. This comprehensive electrical system is designed to seamlessly support the yacht's operations, ensuring a comfortable and enjoyable experience on the water.

Mechanical equipment

The mechanical systems on AMICO are meticulously cared for and include a variety of high-performance components designed to ensure smooth and efficient operation. In 2023, the Michigan 48x49 5-blade propellers were refurbished, boosting propulsion efficiency. The yacht is fitted with two Sea Recovery 1200 water makers and boost pumps, ensuring a dependable supply of fresh water during long journeys.

The climate control system is robust, featuring three 5-ton chillers, frequency drives, and pump relays that were replaced in 2018, guaranteeing optimal temperature regulation. In 2023, all 13 air handlers were upgraded to Aqua Air units, further enhancing onboard comfort.

A new Head Hunter black water tank monitor was installed in the crew area, providing precise oversight of waste management systems. The Jastram

hydraulic steering system, complete with selector switches, was rebuilt in 2023, ensuring precise and responsive handling.

The yacht is equipped with a Wesmar 16" 40HP hydraulic bow thruster, which received a new gear motor in 2020, improving maneuverability. For anchoring, there are two Maxwell hydraulic windlasses with band brakes and two Maxwell 2500 24vDC swim step capstans, offering robust mooring capabilities. An anchor chain wash down system ensures the cleanliness and maintenance of the anchoring equipment.

Additionally, the yacht features two Fortress stainless steel anchors with custom welded anchor stoppers, ensuring secure anchorage. This comprehensive suite of mechanical equipment is designed to provide reliability and performance, making AMICO a standout in its class.

Engine room

Upon entering the engine room of AMICO, you are immediately impressed by the spacious and thoughtfully organized layout, crafted to ensure easy movement and maintenance. At the core of this area are two MTU/DDEC 16V2000 engines, each producing 1800 horsepower, paired with Twin Disc gearboxes. These engines are celebrated for their robustness and longevity, having established themselves as dependable marine propulsion systems over time.

Located outboard in the engine room are dual Northern Lights generators, each housed in sound shields to minimize noise. On the starboard side, a 65KW model runs at 1800 rpm, while the port side features a quieter 50KW generator designed to operate at lower rpm, reducing noise without compromising output. This quieter option is perfect for nights at anchor or when extra dockside power is required without disturbing the neighbors. Both generators are fitted with hydraulic PTO systems and remote selector switches, supplying hydraulic pressure for various system operations.

Ahead of the generators, the Side Power Zero Speed stabilizers, upgraded in 2017, ensure a smooth and stable journey. Climate control is managed by three 5-ton chiller units situated on a raised shelf, maintaining the ideal interior temperature. The work area is well-equipped, featuring a large bench, a multi-drawer toolbox, overhead storage cabinets, a vise, a sink, and a hose spigot, providing all the necessary tools and facilities for maintenance tasks. Additional notable features include a 60-gallon lube oil tank with deck fill, fill spigot, and drain spigot, as well as a 50-gallon waste oil tank with a portable extraction pump and quick disconnects to fit all engines, generators, and gearboxes. The Cablemaster shore power cord storage and an air compressor further enhance the functionality of this space. Despite the extensive equipment, there is ample room to move around and work efficiently in the engine room of the 112.

Hull

The hull of the 112 Westport raised pilothouse is celebrated for its dependability and performance as a global voyager. Its timeless yacht lines and proven features set it apart from the "ultra-modern" cookie-cutter designs. AMICO showcases exterior upgrades not found on standard models, making it truly distinctive. The enhanced black painted hard top stanchions, satellite domes, mast, antennas, and accessories, along with the black wrap-backed name board areas on both port and starboard, create a striking accent that distinguishes it.

The yacht is further elevated by 13 underwater lights that encircle the sides and stern, creating a breathtaking nighttime spectacle. This feature not only enhances the yacht's aesthetic appeal but also improves visibility and safety. The hull underwent a haul-out with complete bottom paint and Prop Speed application, finalized on September 4, 2022, ensuring peak performance and protection. These features make AMICO a standout vessel, blending classic

elegance with modern enhancements for an extraordinary yachting experience.

Fire and safety equipment

AMICO is outfitted with an extensive range of fire and safety equipment, ensuring the utmost standards of safety and security on board. The vessel is under constant surveillance by four strategically placed CCTV cameras in the engine room, on the flybridge aft deck, and at the swim step, providing continuous monitoring and peace of mind.

The Allen Bradley touchscreen system provides advanced monitoring of fire, CO₂, heat, exterior doors, and bilge levels, ensuring any potential issues are swiftly identified and addressed. Both the engine room and electrical station are safeguarded by Halon automatic fire systems, which undergo annual inspections to ensure peak performance.

Each room on the yacht is fitted with smoke and CO₂ detectors, offering early warnings in case of fire or gas leaks. Handheld fire extinguishers are available in every zone and are inspected annually to ensure they are always ready for use. For emergencies, two 8-passenger life rafts are mounted in cradles on the flybridge aft deck, with current inspections confirming their readiness.

Additionally, two life rings are mounted on flybridge hangars for quick access.

All necessary personal flotation devices (PFDs) and safety equipment are on board, ensuring compliance with safety regulations. The vessel is also equipped with emergency automatic DC LED lighting throughout, providing illumination in the event of a power outage. This comprehensive fire and safety equipment package ensures that AMICO is prepared for any situation, prioritizing the safety and well-being of everyone on board.

Additional equipment

AMICO is outfitted with a variety of additional equipment designed to enhance both the yacht's functionality and comfort. Inside, the flooring is safeguarded by two sets of removable salon runners and a removable pilothouse runner, keeping it in immaculate condition while allowing for easy maintenance and cleaning.

For the exterior, protective covers are provided for all seating areas and tables, shielding them from the elements and maintaining the yacht's elegant appearance. The yacht also features dual Sea Recovery 1200 water makers and boost pumps, ensuring a dependable supply of fresh water during long voyages.

An inflatable jet ski dock is included, offering a convenient and secure platform for launching and retrieving jet skis, enhancing the overall water sports experience. This additional equipment is carefully chosen to complement the yacht's luxurious features, ensuring a seamless and enjoyable yachting experience.

Notable upgrades

AMICO has experienced a series of substantial enhancements over the years, boosting its performance, comfort, and technological prowess. In 2017, the yacht's stabilizers were upgraded to Side Power Zero Speed stabilizers, ensuring a smooth and stable journey in all conditions. The exterior was adorned with custom black Awlgrip accent paint on the hardtop stanchions, satellite domes, antennas, mast, and accessories, adding a unique flair. Custom fishing rod and reel racks were installed in the aft crew storage area and engine room, and a Clearmate dual pass water purification system was added.

In 2018, both Northern Lights generators underwent top-end rebuilds,

including cylinder heads, turbos, injectors, and injection pumps. The HVAC system saw the replacement of three chillers, frequency drives, and pump relays, while the galley settee was reupholstered in leather for added luxury. The year 2019 brought the overhaul of both port and starboard transmissions, servicing of the transmission coolers, and the installation of a new pinion for the port transmission. In 2020, a new hydraulic gear motor was installed for the bow thruster, along with a new 24v 60a battery charger and PSS shaft seals. The entire vessel was upgraded to low draw LED lighting, enhancing energy efficiency.

In 2021, the foredeck seating area received a new audio system with a Fusion stereo, JL amp, and speakers. A custom tri-shade was added to the flybridge aft deck, and a new security and monitoring camera system was installed. The MarineNav computer system with Time Zero software and all necessary charts was introduced, along with a new JennAir double drawer refrigerator in the stew pantry.

The upgrades continued in 2022 with new high output low draw LED lighting in the crew area, new main engine Groco through hulls, ball valves, and sea strainers. Six new MTU/Sturdy digital engine displays, interfaces, control console, ECM, and ASM modules were installed. The propellers were reconditioned, propeller shafts removed and balanced, new cutlass bearings installed, and shaft seal rotors resurfaced. Thirteen new Aqua Air air handlers and plumbing were added, along with a new custom Allen Bradley 3 screen touch panel vessel interface and monitoring system with customized Westport VIC software by Rex.

In 2023, navigation and electronics saw significant upgrades, including the pilothouse electronics with Garmin 8622 MFD, Garmin AIS800, Furuno CV-588 depth sounder, Airmar DST810 transducer, and Airmar DST800-L-235-N2 transducer. The flybridge electronics were upgraded with Garmin 8617MFD and Icom M605 VHF with AIS. Two shore power booster transformers with WiFi

monitoring were installed, and the Jastram multi-station steering system was rebuilt. Custom port and starboard Deangelo exhaust risers were added, and the owner/guest AV systems were upgraded with eight Crestron MC4-R media room controllers, eight Marantz SR7015 8k receivers, and eight Apple TV units. The yacht also features a 60" Samsung TV fitted in a water-resistant enclosure in the cockpit, new Side Power ECU, controller, and cables, and a Fusion Apollo head unit for the flybridge. The teak deck was restored, and a 12v 100A battery charger was installed. The house, engine, and generator batteries were replaced with ten 8D AGM batteries and a 24v 60amp charger. A Blackwater Tank Sentry was added, and the flybridge enclosure saw the replacement of the center panel, all zippers, and adjusted stitching. These upgrades ensure that AMICO remains at the forefront of luxury yachting, offering unparalleled performance and comfort.


