OVERVIEW

The 2024 Azimut Grande 36M represents the pinnacle of modern Italian shipbuilding, its sculpted silhouette concealing an unusually generous interior and a suite of cutting edge systems. Laid out in the coveted Trideck arrangement and finished in a brilliant white gelcoat, the yacht celebrates al fresco life with a teak decked sundeck, multiple carbon pole shade systems, a fully equipped beach club complete with shower, and dramatic Aqualuma underwater illumination that gives the vessel a superyacht presence by day and night.

Beneath this elegant skin, upgraded twin 2,400 HP engines with SCR technology provide assured performance, while enlarged 2 sqm fin stabilizers dramatically improve comfort both underway and at anchor. RINA Pleasure Class certification attests to her pedigree, and a formidable technical package — upgraded 80 kW generators with automatic paralleling, an ASEA frequency converter for worldwide shore power compatibility, Alfa Laval fuel treatment, and comprehensive acoustic and thermal insulation — confirms her status as a blue water capable trideck flybridge yacht.

Interiors retain Salvagni's original essence palette, softened by abundant marble, custom furnishings from leading European ateliers and refined tailored textiles. Flexible guest accommodation is complemented by professional grade laundry upgrades, expanded refrigeration with dedicated wine storage, and a Platinum navigation and A/V suite with Smart Boat integration, delivering turnkey, highly customized luxury ideal for private ownership or polished motor yacht cruising.

DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Azimut 36M

Presenting a highly specified 2024 Azimut 36M Trideck—an extraordinary expression of the brand's flagship innovation, elevated by thoughtful upgrades and refined customization from bow to beach club. Built in the sought-after Trideck configuration, she offers remarkable volume across three expansive exterior decks, with full teak underfoot on the sundeck and a seamless indoor-outdoor flow that makes every social moment effortless. A white gelcoat hull draws a crisp, contemporary profile, while telescopic gangway stanchions, wing stations, and an electric stern thruster deliver poised, confident maneuverability in any marina or anchorage. Performance is commanding and composed: twin 2,400 HP engine upgrades with SCR technology are paired to upgraded two square meter fin stabilizers and additional stabilizer insulation, ensuring smooth, quiet comfort both underway and at anchor. Her technical pedigree is underscored by RINA Pleasure Class certification, a comprehensive USA Package, an ASEA frequency converter with touchscreen control, upgraded 80 kW generators with automatic parallel capability, Alfa Laval systems, an air-conditioned engine room, and enhanced insulation throughout the engine room and the master suite. Exterior entertaining is exceptional, with multiple carbon-pole sunshade systems shading the forward deck, aft sundeck, upper deck cockpit, and beach area; the beach club is fully appointed with loose furniture per renderings, a dedicated shower, pop-up lighting, and eight Aqualuma underwater lights that create a dramatic nighttime presence. Across exterior tables and bar cabinets, synthetic stone tabletops replace teak, complemented by white lacquered accents and custom furnishings including Paola Lenti sunbeds and tables, Tribù Modi dining chairs, and a Kenyon BBQ on the upper deck. Inside, the

yacht reflects a curated Salvagni essence selection with extensive marble detailing gracing the master head, guest heads, foyer, staircases, galley, pantry, and dining areas; custom marble shower benches and floors, marble inserts in the living and dining spaces, and a marble-topped dining table elevate the ambiance. Bespoke furnishings include Minotti, Baxter, and Porada pieces, along with custom armchairs, enhanced backrests, custom coffee tables, additional rugs, and tailored fabrics for carpets, upholstery, and exterior cushions, while roller blinds replace standard Venetian treatments in guest and VIP cabins for a softer, more modern finish. Accommodation flexibility is assured with a folding berth in the port guest cabin and convertible arrangements that transform twin berths into a double in two guest cabins; a safe is fitted in the captain's cabin, while practical luxuries abound with upgraded professional washer and dryer units plus an additional professional set, added refrigeration in the master cabin and lower lobby, dual wine coolers, bow refrigerators, a Miele domestic oven, a crew mess microwave, and a macerator system. Technology is comprehensive and seamlessly integrated: the Platinum Navigation Package with AIS Class B, Platinum A/V package, and Smart Boat integration meet the demands of modern cruising, supported by an HD11 Sat TV antenna with predisposition and empty dome, a full video camera package with iPad control capability, and a 43" TV mounted aft on the upper deck; additional sockets in both the main-deck and sundeck bars add welcome convenience for service and hosting. Safety and presence are equally considered with a Kahlenberg D-330 horn, a fog alarm, and an ACR RCL-100 LED searchlight, alongside refined finishing touches such as dome decal removal and bronze-finished bed niches. Altogether, this 2024 Azimut 36M is a masterfully equipped, custom-appointed tri-deck motor yacht, blending performance, technology, and elevated design into a turnkey opportunity for the most discerning owner.


