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OVERVIEW

MY SERENDIPITY stands out as one of the most striking Azimut 116 superyachts. Designed by Stefano Righini and launched in 2008 by the renowned Italian yard in Viareggio, she began life as a private day boat in Indonesia before being purchased by a seasoned yachtsman who, having previously owned an Azimut 116, was determined to return to this celebrated platform. Between October 2022 and April 2024 she underwent an extensive refit at Seven Stars in Pisa that restored her to an almost new condition. The interior was fully reimagined and repainted under the direction of Margherita Casprini, and over an 18 month, €1,950,000 program the hull, superstructure and accommodation areas received a complete repaint. New teak was installed across the sundeck, aft deck, bow and swim platform while the remaining decks were carefully recaulked; all exterior furniture, cushions and upholstery were replaced and every item on the worklist was addressed to exacting Italian yard standards, respecting both cosmetic refinement and structural soundness. The interior palette was lightened throughout from headliner to sole, creating a contemporary, airy ambience enhanced by brand new chic furnishings and a warm, relaxed elegance.

With an interior volume of 260 GT, MY SERENDIPITY accommodates up to 14 guests across six luxurious cabins. The lower deck houses a full beam owner's suite with private access, two VIP staterooms and two twin cabins, each fitted with an additional Pullman berth; all guest cabins are located on the lower deck except for the sixth cabin, situated forward on the main deck and currently arranged as a TV lounge/office, complete with a large sofa bed and Pullman that offer flexible family use and multi purpose living.

This high performance Azimut 116 flybridge motor yacht is designed for effortless entertaining and comfortable extended cruising. The sundeck is appointed with expansive sunpads and a fully equipped bar, while a generous

dining table for 12 sits beneath a wide hardtop with an electrically opening skylight for seamless alfresco dining. A full size garage door integrated into the stern converts into an inviting beach door. She has just completed her RINA classification survey and is registered under the Cook Islands flag. Twin MTU 16V 2000 M93 diesel engines, each producing 2,400 hp, propel her to a top speed of 28 knots while delivering exceptional comfort and stability both underway and at anchor, aided by two hydraulic, digital ABT TRAC fins (zero speed). Both main engines display very low hours and have recently benefited from full MTU servicing; the two generators were rebuilt to as new condition and the entire air conditioning system has been replaced. MY SERENDIPITY is operated by up to six crew accommodated in three dedicated lower deck crew cabins with separate access, ensuring discreet and professional service.

DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Upgrades during the 2022/2024 refit

A comprehensive refit carried out between 2022 and 2024 brought a meticulous aesthetic renewal, beginning with a full repaint of the hull and exterior surfaces and the fitting of new teak on the flybridge, stern and bow, while targeted repairs were completed on the main deck. The interior was modernised with all crew bedding replaced to match the updated décor, new cushion covers and complete exterior reupholstery were commissioned, and interior soft furnishings, carpets and decorative elements were fully renewed. The flybridge now offers a dedicated bar and a new kitchenette corner, and the crew benefit from entirely new, purpose-refitted quarters.

Significant engineering and systems work enhanced reliability and performance, including installation of a seawater AC pump, two new generators, new propellers and a new shaft line, together with comprehensive electrical works and a full engine overhaul. Onboard systems were upgraded across the board: the Swift board was replaced, a Starlink internet link was fitted and new antennas, audio and video systems were added, while navigation and communication equipment received new installations. Anchor chains and mark shackles were renewed and the tank was water blasted. Additional enhancements include new boilers, a new watermaker, a new television and a Sonar system. In the wheelhouse four new screens were installed, software was updated, a MaxSea plotter integrated, new antennas fitted, and a general systems update completed the transformation.

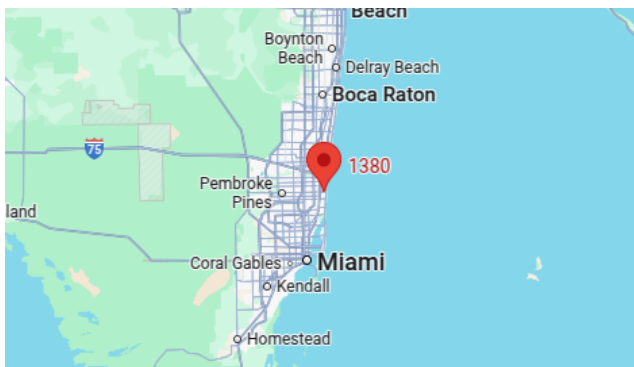
