Capable of 24 knots and with a 750 nm cruising range, her passages remain composed thanks to underway stabilizers, while the refreshed interior presents new Italian upholstered seating, crisp linens and towels, and Acqua dell'Elba bathroom amenities.

Entertainment aboard is effortless and cinematic: a 4K projector produces a three-metre outdoor cinema on the bridge, supported by Apple TV, Netflix, HBO and SkyShowtime, and smart TVs in every cabin. A standout Italian superyacht with genuine charter appeal, Let It Be balances timeless grace with modern comfort and convenience.

Twin MTU 12V 396 TE94 engines delivering a combined 4,570 HP propel her to exhilarating speeds of up to 26 knots, marrying performance with proven reliability, while a shallow 2.35 m draft unlocks exclusive anchorages beyond the reach of larger yachts to expand her cruising horizons. Built with a composite hull and aluminium superstructure, LET IT BE balances structural integrity with dynamic, agile handling, and a refit completed in 2025 further elevated her technical and operational standards.
