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OVERVIEW

Constructed in fiberglass (GRP) by Italian builder Tecnomarine, LET IT BE first entered the water in 1998 and has undergone comprehensive refits in 2016, 2023, 2024 and 2025 to keep her specifications and finishes contemporary. A perennial favorite on the Mediterranean charter circuit, this superyacht accommodates up to 10 guests across five elegantly appointed staterooms, offering the privacy and comfort expected of a luxury motor yacht.

The principal suite occupies the main deck, affording an elevated sense of seclusion, while the lower deck houses two double cabins and two twin cabins, each served by its own en suite bathroom. The main-deck salon is a study in contrast, where high-gloss dark timber is balanced by crisp white textiles; a sociable bar is positioned aft of the salon with a formal dining area to the forward end, creating distinct zones for relaxation and entertaining. The aft deck is designed for effortless al fresco living, fitted with a generous dining table, plentiful seating and full amenities to host elegant meals or casual gatherings under the sky.

On the upper level a second salon opens seamlessly onto a broad outdoor deck, which is dominated by a large dining table and provides an ideal setting for open-air receptions, lingering midday lunches and evening cocktails at sunset. Propelled by twin 2,252 hp MTU engines, LET IT BE attains a top speed of 24 knots, combining assured performance with a relaxed ride for cruising the Mediterranean's storied coastlines and picturesque islands.

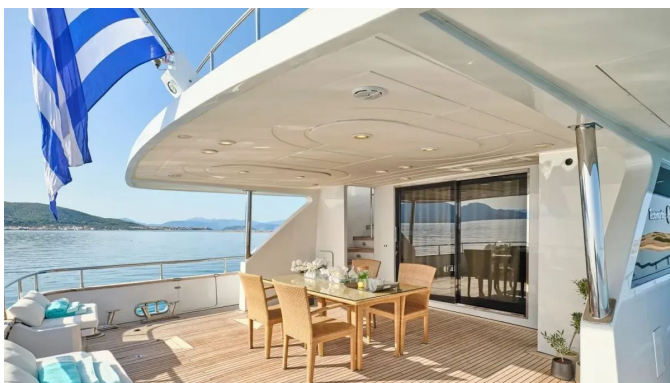

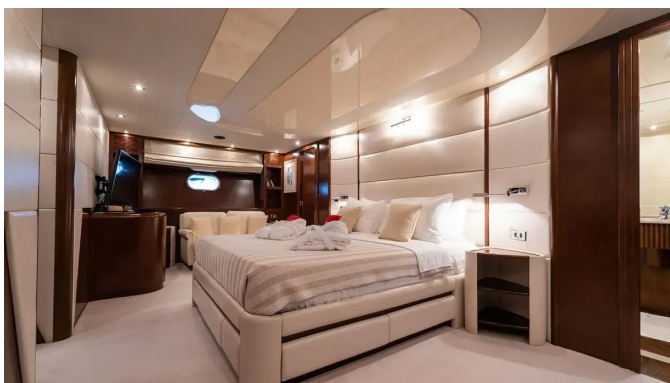

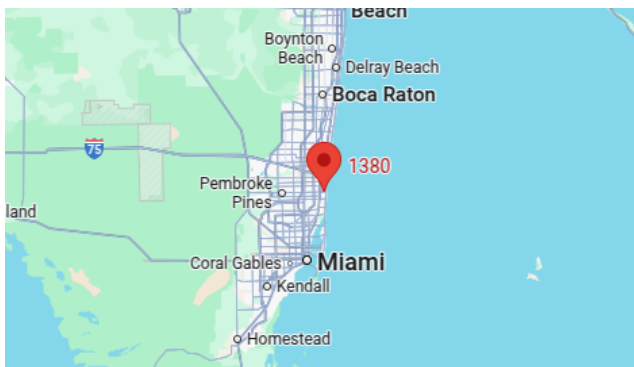
