OVERVIEW

TRUE NORTH is a timeless 118' Broward luxury motor yacht, beautifully refreshed with a comprehensive 2019 refit including a full repaint. This American-built superyacht welcomes up to 8 guests in 4 staterooms. The full-beam master features a king berth and his-and-hers baths with a shared shower. Two VIP suites offer queen berths and ensuite baths, while the fourth cabin provides twin beds with its own ensuite.

The main salon feels bright and open, framed by expansive picture windows that showcase the scenery. A plush sectional, coffee table, games table, and a well-appointed wet bar set the stage for movie nights, casual lounging, or elegant entertaining. Forward, a separate formal dining room creates an intimate setting for refined meals. Aft on the main deck, comfortable outdoor seating invites relaxed conversation in the breeze.

Above, the expansive flybridge is the social heart of this flybridge motor yacht, complete with alfresco dining and a second wet bar—perfect for sunset cocktails. For quiet moments, a cozy foredeck seating area offers a private retreat.

Powered by Caterpillar 3412s with a major overhaul in 2021. Equipment highlights include Northern Lights generators, Naiad stabilizers, bow thruster, watermakers, Garmin electronics, and Yamaha WaveRunners—ideal for a versatile cruising yacht, family yacht, or charter yacht experience.

DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Accommodations

TRUE NORTH is a classic 118' Broward luxury motor yacht, comprehensively refreshed in 2019 with a complete repaint. She welcomes eight guests in four staterooms: a full-beam master with a king berth and his-and-hers heads connected by a shared shower; two VIP suites with queen berths and ensuite baths; and a fourth cabin with twin beds and its own ensuite. The main salon feels bright and open thanks to large picture windows, while a plush sectional, coffee table, games table, and a wet bar create a relaxed setting for movie nights, casual gatherings, or polished entertaining. Forward, a separate formal dining room provides an intimate setting, and the aft main deck offers comfortable outdoor seating. Above, the expansive flybridge of this flybridge motor yacht is designed for al fresco living with dining and a second wet bar, while the foredeck lounge offers a private retreat. Power comes from Caterpillar 3412s with a major overhaul in 2021, supported by Northern Lights generators, Naiad stabilizers, an American bow thruster, watermakers, Garmin electronics, and Yamaha WaveRunners—an accomplished superyacht, family cruising yacht, and charter yacht in one compelling package.

Main salon

A bespoke interior refit by Architectural Interiors in 2013 introduced new carpet, headliner, furnishings, window treatments, and soft goods, setting a refined tone for this luxury motor yacht. Mahogany joinery flows throughout, with built-in mahogany cabinetry and buffets to port and starboard. A convivial walk-up bar with leather-upholstered bolsters is fitted with a Sub-Zero wine refrigerator, U-Line icemaker, sink, and three upholstered bar stools. Seating includes a custom upholstered L-shaped sectional, a cocktail table, a sofa

table, and two end tables, complemented by two custom high-back chairs with an ottoman and a dedicated game table with four upholstered club chairs. Layered lighting comes from decorative table lamps, custom wall sconces, and an overhead soffit with inlay and integrated lighting. Custom window treatments feature two-inch wood blinds and tie-back draperies, with mahogany valances concealing the A/C. Forward, built-in cabinetry discreetly houses a 60-inch TV, the RTI streaming A/V system, storage, and mirrored panels—an inviting social hub aboard a superyacht.

Formal dining salon

Forward of the salon, a circular formal dining room centers on a round mahogany table with six upholstered dining chairs beneath a custom oval overhead soffit with a decorative fixture. Storage shelves with glass doors keep serveware close at hand, while double French glass doors to the starboard-side galley streamline service. Custom mahogany panels with chair railing and marble flooring with a bespoke inlay elevate the setting—ideal for refined dinners aboard this superyacht.

Galley equipment

The galley is designed for efficient service, featuring a Sub-Zero refrigerator/freezer (9/25), a KitchenAid double convection oven, a Miele five-burner stovetop, a Miele Futura dishwasher, and an Emerson microwave. A U-Line fifty-bottle wine cooler manages vintages, while an L-shaped leather dinette with a granite-topped table forms an inviting breakfast nook. Granite countertops, custom two-inch wooden blinds, and a Samsung 32-inch TV complete a practical workspace suited to a cruising motor yacht.

Master stateroom

The full-beam master stateroom presents a king berth with a custom silk spread and shams against an upholstered headboard, flanked by two built-in nightstands and two decorative sconces. Storage includes a built-in dresser to port and a desk/vanity with chair to starboard, complemented by walk-in cedar-lined closets. Portlights to port and starboard, custom window treatments with draperies, and a Samsung 32-inch HDTV with DirecTV, Apple TV, and an RTI streaming system enhance comfort, while a safe is fitted in the master closet. The his-and-hers bath features marble vanities to port and starboard, decorative sinks with custom fixtures, a large centerline marble shower with full glass doors and custom hardware, marble flooring, custom wallcoverings with mirrored panels, and two Headhunter toilets—an elegant retreat befitting a luxury superyacht.

VIP queen stateroom

Each VIP queen stateroom offers a queen berth with a custom spread and shams and a custom upholstered headboard, styled with custom wallcoverings and a roman pleated shade. Storage includes two built-in three-drawer dressers to port and starboard and a built-in vanity/desk with chair. Entertainment is provided by a Visio Smart 30-inch TV with DirecTV and stereo, while a mirrored panel on the aft bulkhead brightens the room. The private bath features a marble vanity with mirror and a glass-enclosed shower—refined accommodations for a charter-ready motor yacht.

Queen guest stateroom, port

To port, the queen guest stateroom features a queen berth with spread and shams and storage drawers below, paired with a custom upholstered

headboard. Two built-in three-drawer dressers sit to port and starboard with hanging lockers and two port lights. Finishes include a custom pleated Roman shade and custom wallcoverings. Entertainment comes via a Visio Smart 32-inch TV and a Sony AM/FM stereo with CD player. The private bath offers a marble vanity with mirror, coordinated wallcoverings, and a glass-enclosed shower—quiet comfort for extended cruising.

Electronics & navigational equipment

In the pilothouse, navigation centers on a Garmin MFD 8600 GPS/Radar, an Anshutz gyro compass, an Anshutz Pilotstar D autopilot, a Garmin GPSMAP 4210, a Nobeltec plotter, and Garmin speed/wind/distance monitoring with a Ray Marine ST 60+ wind display. Redundancy is ensured by three Garmin GPS plotters and three Garmin 8600 multi touchscreens. Control systems comprise an American bow thruster jog lever, Naiad stabilizer control, Jastram steering, and an Insignia computer flatscreen. On the flybridge, equipment includes a Furuno FCV582 color video sounder, Garmin 4208 and Garmin 7608 GPS plotters, a Nobeltec computer plotter, and an Anshutz autopilot, with duplicated Furuno and Garmin units for backup. Bow thruster and Naiad stabilizer controls are repeated, while Glendenning marine throttles and a wing station with Jastram steering control, bow thruster, Autohelm multi view control pad, Glendenning throttles, and CAT engine displays ease close-quarters handling. Communications, Wi-Fi, and security are covered by Icom VHF M604 and Icom ICM302 VHF sets, Seahail and Furuno hailers, a Furuno NavTex NX500 receiver, an Insignia flatscreen with security/tow camera system, and Starlink/Pepwave with shipwide Wi-Fi—an electronics suite worthy of a world-cruising superyacht.

Pilothouse equipment

The raised pilothouse features a full helm station with a leather-upholstered helm chair and an upholstered settee for guests, set beneath custom overhead upholstered panels, with a convenient stairway to the flybridge—functional, comfortable, and ideal for a long-range motor yacht.

Flybridge equipment

The flybridge sits beneath a Pipewelders custom hardtop and carries a full port-side helm station with bench seating plus a starboard wing station for close-quarters work. Entertaining flows around a teak-topped bar with three bar stools, a JennAir grill, Sub-Zero refrigerator, and Scotsman icemaker, complemented by a large L-shaped bench, a dinette with a Corian table, and an RTI streaming system with outdoor speakers. Teak decks, a safety door to the bridge deck, and two 2021 Yamaha WaveRunners underscore the outdoor lifestyle of this flybridge motor yacht.

Aft deck equipment

Aft, a built-in settee with bench seating wraps a high-gloss teak table, joined by five woven rattan dining chairs with cushions and a matching lounge chair with ottoman. A wet bar with sink, gooseneck faucet, icemaker, and storage serves the space, complemented by a Samsung 34-inch DTV with an RTI streaming system, overhead lighting, and stereo speakers. A spiral staircase leads to the flybridge, while teak decks, dual port and starboard stairs to the teak swim platform with stainless-steel railings, and direct access to the lazarette and engine room complete this versatile area—equally at home on a family yacht or charter yacht.

Deck equipment

On deck, ground tackle comprises two Poole N 105 KG anchors served by two Maxwell 4500 anchor windlasses. A Nautical Structures EZ 2500 boat crane handles tenders and toys, while a Marquipt seven-step boarding ladder and a Marquipt five-step vertical ladder simplify boarding—smart, seaworthy details for a capable cruising yacht.

Electrical equipment

Electrical power is provided by Northern Lights 50 kW generators with sound shields, overhauled in 2021, showing approximately 3,684 hours port and 8,828 hours starboard. Shore power arrives via two 100-amp single-phase connections. Charging is handled by Sentry 12-volt, 40-amp and Sentry 24-volt, 30-amp systems. Monitoring and security include an Elbex eight-zone monitoring system with remote and an HAI two-zone security alarm system—robust support for bluewater cruising.

Engine room & mechanical equipment

Twin Caterpillar 3412s received a major overhaul in September 2021, with approximately 1,082 hours SMOH on the port engine and 1,077 hours SMOH on the starboard. Comfort and control are enhanced by a Naiad 853 stabilizer system with hydraulic pumps and an American bow thruster. Fuel handling benefits from double Racor fuel filters and AC/DC fuel transfer pumps. Climate control is delivered by three Aqua Air five-ton A/C chillers. Freshwater and purity are supported by a Spot Zero 80 GPH watermaker with tank filler and a Spot Zero RO system. In 2024, a new Metcalf exhaust system with new risers, mufflers, and mixers was installed. Running gear includes Nibrall five-bladed propellers, stainless-steel prop shafts of 4.25-inch diameter, ZF transmissions,

Jastram hydraulic steering with dual rams, and spade-type rudders measuring 42 inches by 17 inches. Additional systems include a fiberglass exhaust system, an ElectroSea growth-prevention system, and two Headhunter Jet Pac freshwater systems—mechanical pedigree suited to a long-range motor yacht.

Crew quarters, forward

Forward of the galley below deck, the crew area comprises a captain's cabin with a double berth, 32-inch TV, safe, and head, plus two crew cabins with twin berths, 32-inch TVs, and heads. Laundry is handled by an LG washer and a Hamilton Beach dryer—private, practical accommodations for a professional crew.

Twin guest stateroom, stbd

To starboard, the twin guest stateroom offers twin berths with custom spreads and shams and storage drawers below, upholstered headboards, two decorative lights, custom wallcoverings, a portlight, and a hanging locker. Entertainment includes a Visio Smart 27-inch TV with a Sony stereo and CD player, while the private bath features a marble vanity with mirror and a glass-enclosed shower. In the lower companionway, a laundry center with a Bosch washer and dryer sits opposite a Whirlpool refrigerator, with ample linen storage—ideal for family cruising or charter service.

Lazarette / dive room

The lazarette doubles as a dive room with a Brownies dive compressor and four-station tank fill, a Kenmore refrigerator/freezer, a Frigidaire stand-up freezer, a Hoshizaki 150 lb PD icemaker, a Kenmore bait freezer, and a head with shower—well suited to watersports and long stays at anchor.

Exclusions

Exclusions include all owner's and crew personal items, all artwork in the formal dining area, the sailboat artworks in the upper companionway, and the DVD collection.

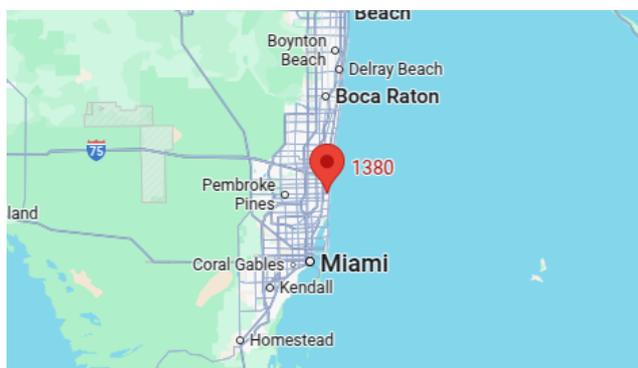
