Configured as a coveted trideck motor yacht and presented in a pristine white gelcoat, she invites open-air living with teak-clad sundeck spaces, multiple carbon-pole shade systems, a fully equipped beach club with shower, and dramatic Aqualuma underwater illumination.

Driven by upgraded twin 2,400 HP engines featuring SCR emissions technology, she delivers compelling performance, while enlarged 2 sqm fin stabilizers provide superior poise both underway and at anchor. RINA Pleasure Class notation, uprated 80kW generators with automatic paralleling, an ASEA frequency converter, Alfa Laval systems, and comprehensive insulation throughout underscore a formidable technical platform.

Inside, curated under Salvagni's original essence palette, you'll find extensive marble accents, bespoke furnishings from celebrated European houses, and custom textiles throughout. Versatile guest accommodations, professional-grade laundry enhancements, expanded refrigeration with dedicated wine storage, and a Platinum navigation and A/V suite with Smart Boat integration ensure seamless, effortless luxury living afloat.

Highly individualized, impeccably finished, and genuinely turnkey, this Azimut 36M luxury motor yacht represents a standout opportunity in today's superyacht market.

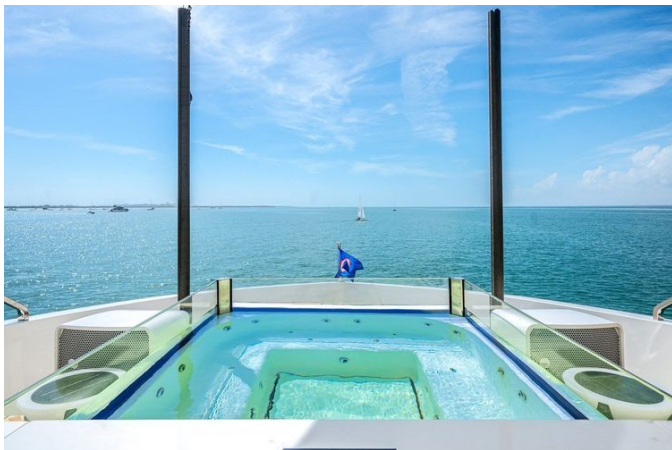








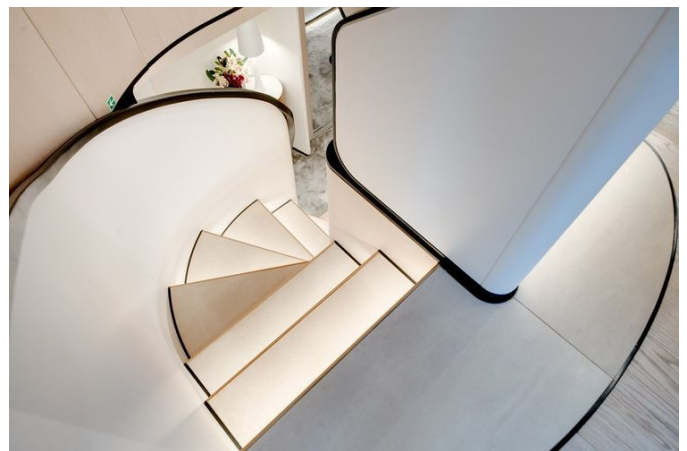








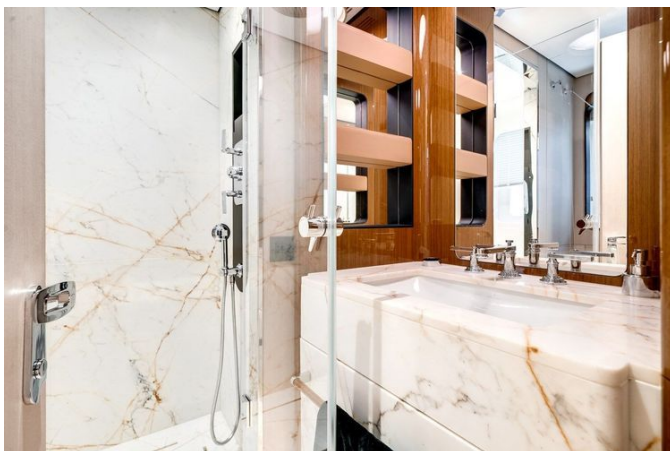






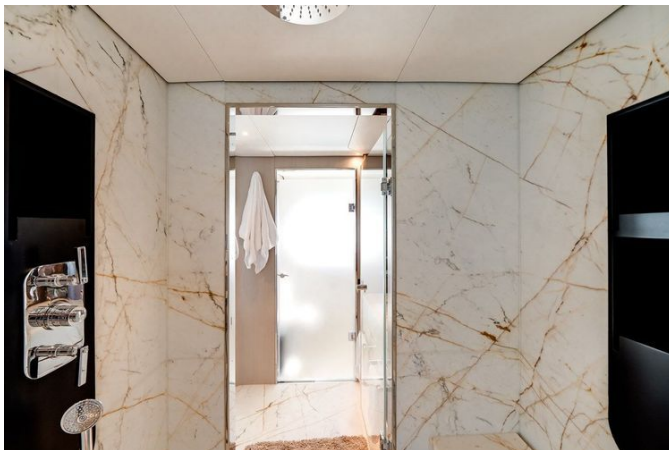




















DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Azimut 36M

Presenting a highly specified 2024 Azimut 36M Trideck—an extraordinary expression of flagship innovation, elevated by thoughtful upgrades and refined customization throughout. Built in the sought-after Trideck configuration, she delivers remarkable volume across three expansive exterior decks, with full teak underfoot on the sundeck and a seamless indoor–outdoor flow. A white gelcoat hull emphasizes her clean, contemporary profile, while telescopic gangway stanchions, wing stations, and an electric stern thruster ensure confident maneuverability in any setting.

Performance is commanding, with twin 2,400 HP engine upgrades featuring SCR technology paired to upgraded two-square-meter fin stabilizers and additional stabilizer insulation for smooth, quiet cruising both underway and at anchor. RINA Pleasure Class certification, the USA Package, an ASEA frequency converter with touchscreen control, upgraded 80kW generators with automatic parallel capability, Alfa Laval systems, an air-conditioned engine room, and enhanced insulation throughout the engine room and master suite underscore her technical pedigree.

Exterior entertaining is exceptional. Multiple carbon pole sunshade systems span the forward deck, aft sundeck, upper deck cockpit, and beach area. The beach club is fully appointed with loose furniture per renderings, a dedicated shower, pop up lighting, and eight Aqualuma underwater lights that create a dramatic nighttime presence. Synthetic stone tabletops replace teak across exterior tables and bar cabinets, complemented by white lacquered accents and custom furnishings including Paola Lenti sunbeds and tables, Tribù Modi dining chairs, and a Kenyon BBQ on the upper deck.

Inside, a curated Salvagni essence selection sets the tone, with extensive

marble detailing across the master head, guest heads, foyer, staircases, galley, pantry, and dining areas. Custom marble shower benches and floors, marble inserts in the living and dining spaces, and a marble topped dining table elevate the ambiance. Bespoke furnishings include Minotti, Baxter, and Porada pieces, custom armchairs, enhanced backrests, custom coffee tables, additional rugs, and tailored fabrics for carpets, upholstery, and exterior cushions. Roller blinds replace standard Venetians in guest and VIP cabins for a softer, more modern finish.

Accommodation flexibility is enhanced with a folding berth in the port guest cabin and convertible twin to double arrangements in two guest cabins. A safe is fitted in the captain's cabin, while practical luxuries include upgraded professional washer and dryer units plus an additional professional set, added refrigeration in the master cabin and lower lobby, dual wine coolers, bow refrigerators, a Miele domestic oven, a crew mess microwave, and a macerator system.

Technology is comprehensive, integrating the Platinum Navigation Package with AIS Class B, the Platinum A/V package, Smart Boat integration, an HD11 Sat TV antenna with predisposition and empty dome, a full video camera package with iPad control capability, and a 43" TV mounted aft on the upper deck. Additional sockets in both main and sundeck bars add convenient power for service and hosting.

Safety and presence are equally considered, with a Kahlenberg D 330 horn, a fog alarm, an ACR RCL 100 LED searchlight, and refined details such as dome decal removal and bronze finished bed niches. Altogether, this 2024 Azimut 36M is a masterfully equipped, custom appointed tri deck motor yacht that blends performance, technology, and elevated design into a turnkey opportunity for the most discerning owner.

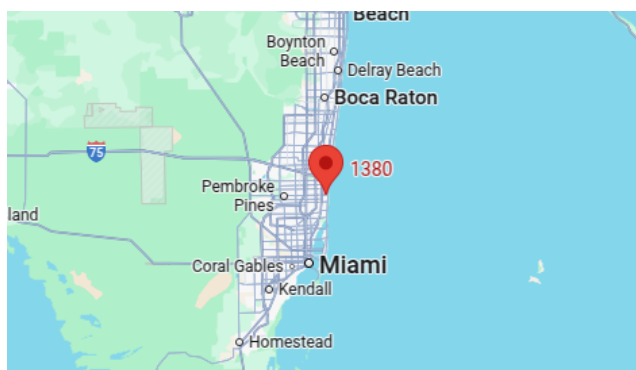
