DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Accommodation:

Designed for serene comfort, this yacht welcomes eight guests across four beautifully appointed staterooms, comprising a full-beam master suite, two VIP staterooms and one twin, ensuring privacy and effortless ease for families and friends; professional service is delivered by a dedicated crew of five to six accommodated in three crew cabins, with a captain's cabin and two twin cabins, enabling smooth, discreet operations around the clock.

Machinery:

Confident performance comes from twin DDEC MTU 12V4000M90 engines, each rated at 2,040 kW (2,735 hp), driving a robust diesel prop shaft propulsion for rewarding, reliable passage-making; command remains assured with an electro hydraulic power assisted steering system complemented by a fully independent hydraulic emergency steering system, while electrical autonomy is delivered by two 54 kW Kilo Pack generators operating on a 50 Hz system and climate comfort flows through a Cruisair tempered water air conditioning

system with all fan coils replaced in 2016 for efficient, quiet cooling; the yacht's electrical architecture is 50 Hz with both three phase and single phase voltages, managed by a Selco power management system for seamless generator to shore switchover, and supported by Asea 72 kW three phase shore power converters for dependable dockside compatibility.

Communications, navigation & entertainment equipment:

Navigation is orchestrated around an ECS (chart plotter) TRANSAS Navisailor 4000 running through Windows 7 with a dedicated printer, displayed on two 60 cm Eizo monitors and two 54 cm Eizo monitors for crisp situational awareness; a Furuno X Band Radar, a Sperry Marine Gyro, and a Navipilot 4000 autopilot work in concert with Rudder Order and Rudder Angle LEDs and a Ritchie 4 inch magnetic compass to deliver precise control, while the bridge suite is completed by a Raymarine log, anemometer and depth sounder, two Raymarine GMDSS VHF units, MX Marine GPS, a Saab AIS R5 Supreme, and Speich windscreen wipers, with Kahlenberg horns and controls ensuring your presence is known; safety and oversight are strengthened by a Night Watch yacht monitoring system with a class approved 42 cm touch screen monitor, CCTV covering the engine room with two forward and aft facing HD cameras, and a ship's PC installed new in 2015, and the yacht carries charts and publications for the western Med, stays connected via Fleet F55 satellite phone and fax, optimizes trim with Humphree trim tabs, and remains composed underway thanks to Quantum at speed stabilisers; entertainment flows through a custom Crestron system with UK Sky TV and Astra1 reception, anchored by one KVH G60 satellite dome, while audiovisual indulgence includes a 122 cm 4K HD LCD TV with Monitor Audio sound bar and directional speakers in the master stateroom, a 140 cm 4K HD LCD TV with Monitor Audio sound bar and directional speakers in the salon together with a Sony

PlayStation, a 122 cm 4K HD LCD TV and Sony PlayStation in the foyer/twin guest area, 72 cm 4K HD LCD TVs in the VIP staterooms, the crew mess, and the captain's cabin, plus a 6 ft × 3.75 ft projector screen on the fly deck paired with an Epson EHTW7200 HD 3D projector; each entertainment zone is elegantly specified with a Marantz NR0617 amplifier, a Shuttle PC media server, multiple speakers, Wi-Fi access, Apple AirPlay, a Blu-ray player, and an Apple iPad with a custom A/V controller app, ensuring intuitive, whole yacht control and immersive sound and vision.

Deck equipment:

Confident anchoring and seamless deck handling are assured by two anchors served by two 100 m lengths of 16 mm chain, powered through two hydraulic Maxwell VWC 6000 anchor windlasses, while two electric Maxwell VC 4000 capstans stand ready for precise mooring control; boarding is graciously managed by a Sanguinetti passarelle, completing a deck plan engineered for reliability and ease.
