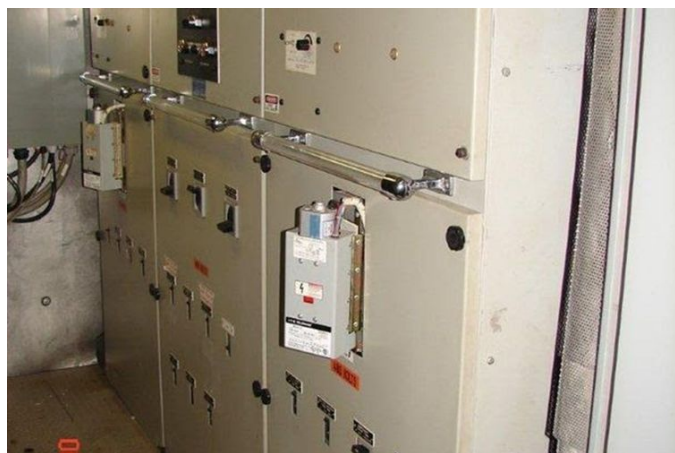

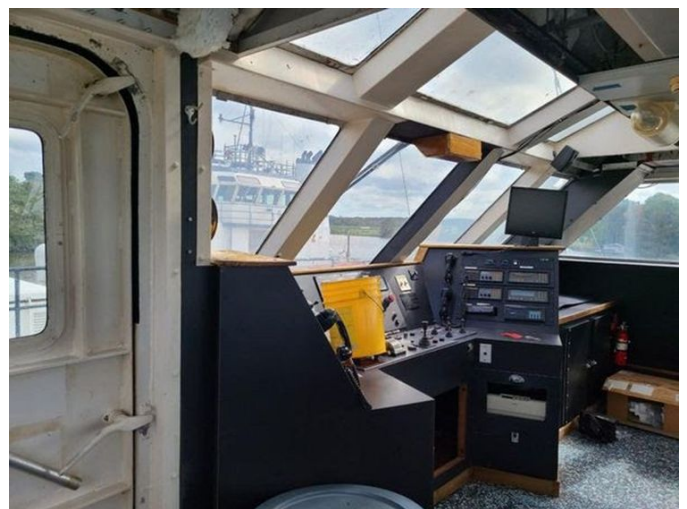

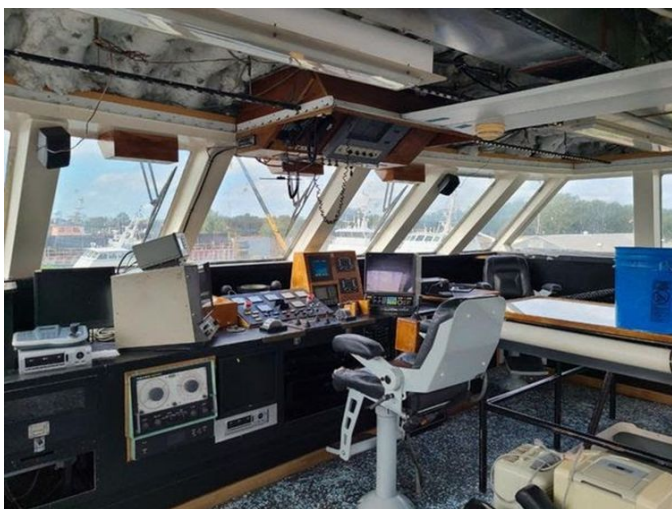

DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Overview

Powered by two Allison 501KF turbines with a combined 10,600 HP, this yacht surges to 30 knots while retaining precise control through a bow thruster and an advanced ride control suite featuring MDI-Active Fin stabilizers, complemented by an Inmarsat-C Mobile Earth Station (MES) for reliable global communications. Designed on the Small Waterplane Area Twin Hull principle—SWATH for short—it employs a twin-hull configuration that minimizes hull cross section at the sea's surface. By reducing the vessel's volume where wave energy is concentrated, it maximizes stability and lowers seasickness, even in high seas and at high speeds. The bulk of its displacement lies beneath the waves, where it is far less affected by surface motion; because wave excitation drops exponentially with depth, a submerged submarine is normally untouched by surface conditions. Placing the majority of the ship's displacement below the waterline is therefore akin to crafting a vessel that rides atop twin submarines, delivering remarkable poise and comfort underway.
