OVERVIEW

Chanson is a majestic 120' tri-deck motor yacht, built to ABS class by Christensen in 1995, whose generous proportions and broad beam create remarkably open lounges on both the main and bridge decks and are complemented by full walk-around side decks for effortless circulation. The interior offers a four-stateroom layout, distinguished by an on-deck VIP and a full-beam owner's suite below, while a capacious salon and formal dining room unfold aft to a semi-enclosed deck with seating that looks over the cockpit. On the bridge deck a Captain's cabin occupies the space aft of the pilothouse, accompanied by a refined skylounge and a fully appointed wet bar adjacent to the boat deck, and the sun deck crowns the yacht with additional seating and a large spa hot tub.

DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Overview

Chanson is a large volume 120' tri deck motor yacht built to ABS standards by Christensen Shipyard in 1995, her generous beam delivering expansive living areas on the main and upper decks and true walk around side decks for effortless circulation. The accommodation plan centers on a versatile four stateroom layout crowned by an on deck VIP guest suite and complemented by a full beam master stateroom on the lower level, plus additional queen and twin guest cabins to welcome up to nine guests in refined comfort. Aft of the generous salon and formal dining area, the semi enclosed aft deck overlooks the cockpit and adapts for all weather enjoyment with an adjustable three sided enclosure and options for chilled air or heating. Above, the upper deck locates a captain's suite just aft of the pilothouse and presents a skylounge with a full wet bar forward of the boat deck; the top deck completes the profile with open seating and a large hot tub. Entering the main deck foyer from starboard, custom inlaid marble with a teak border ushers you aft to a bright salon framed by light maple joinery and panoramic windows, where formal dining leads the eye forward and an inviting, elegant mood prevails. Outdoors, Chanson's entertaining capabilities extend to an oversized lower aft deck, a spacious boat deck and a flybridge appointed with a large Jacuzzi, bar and generous sun lounges; indoors, the skylounge provides a serene retreat with plush seating and a complete wet bar equipped with refrigerator, icemaker and dedicated wine storage.

Salon

The main salon exudes comfortably elegant ease, its large windows, light wood tones and tasteful furnishings amplifying the sense of space while open

sightlines carry seamlessly into the dining area. Clear maple joinery with birds eye door frames, refinished in 2022, sets a luminous backdrop for a new custom upholstered L shaped sectional sofa installed in December 2025, paired with two oversized upholstered chairs. At the heart of the seating arrangement stands a large mahogany cocktail table with four pull out ottomans, complemented by a mahogany console cabinet aft, a mahogany end table and two decorative table lamps. Built in buffets to port and starboard feature onyx surfaces and custom lofted storage, mirrored by a centerline buffet with lofted storage, while a mahogany oval dining table on a double pedestal base is surrounded by ten mahogany framed dining chairs with custom upholstery. Overhead, custom paneling with double light fixtures and a refreshed headliner throughout in 2023 blend with oversized windows framed by raised panels, Custom Hunter Douglas blinds, and a Lit Touch low voltage system with LED lighting throughout. Entertainment is anchored by a Samsung Smart 55" OLED Frame TV and Denon receiver, while climate comfort is assured by three custom air handlers and new custom carpeting throughout added in 2025. Entered from starboard, the foyer presents inlaid marble flooring with a teak border and a graceful spiral staircase both to the skylounge and to the lower deck, along with a refined day head featuring a marble floor, onyx vanity top, sink, custom wallcovering and mirror.

Galley

Purpose designed for serious culinary service, the galley features a Sub Zero refrigerator/freezer paired with a Beverage Air three compartment refrigerator and an additional Sub Zero undercounter refrigerator for seamless provisioning. Cooking prowess comes from a Bosch five burner induction ceramic cooktop installed in 2018, a Bosch double oven replaced in 2023, a Gaggenau four burner cooktop with grill, an Amena oven and a Magic Chef microwave, all under an efficient extractor hood. A center island with

overhead storage and granite countertops provides generous work surfaces, while a dedicated galley air handler installed in 2018 keeps the space perfectly tempered. Cleaning is effortless with a Kenmore dishwasher, ensuring the galley performs as beautifully as it presents.

Master stateroom

Forward on the lower level, the opulent full beam master stateroom indulges with a king size berth fitted with a Sealy mattress and storage below, layered with custom linens and grounded by new carpet installed in November 2025. Upholstered bulkhead panels with two reading lights and glass shelving frame the berth to port and starboard, accompanied by built in nightstands on both sides, built in dresser drawers and a starboard built in upholstered settee. Entertainment is discreetly integrated via a Samsung 40" LED TV, DVD player and Yamaha receiver, while cedar lined walk in closets with automatic lights and overhead recessed lighting complete the serene ambiance. The ensuite His and Her baths to port and starboard feature onyx vanity tops; to port, an onyx/marble shower with a jetted bathtub; custom Phylrich faucets and fixtures throughout; two Kohler heads to port and starboard; an overhead smoke detector; and marble flooring that underscores the suite's lavish finish.

Vip guest stateroom - on deck

Forward along the starboard side of the main deck, the VIP guest stateroom offers near parity with the master, centered on a king berth with a Sealy mattress and storage below, dressed in custom linens and set upon new carpet laid in November 2025. An upholstered headboard is flanked by two built in nightstands with onyx surfaces, with built in dresser drawers and a vanity to port and a built in upholstered settee to starboard. Entertainment includes a Samsung 55" TV, Samsung DVD and a Yamaha receiver. Fresh

wallcoverings added in 2021 complement a cedar lined closet with automatic light, portlights to port and starboard, and overhead recessed lighting. The private bath features a marble onyx vanity with Phylrich faucets, a full shower with tub, new wallcoverings and marble flooring for a thoroughly indulgent experience.

Queen and twin guest stateroom

This flexible guest retreat combines a queen berth and a twin berth, both dressed in custom linens and set on new carpet installed in November 2025. Between them sits a centerline nightstand with two drawers, supported by built in dresser drawers and a cedar lined closet with automatic light. New custom wallcoverings added in 2021 pair with a bespoke window treatment featuring a Roman pleated shade. The private bath is refined with an onyx vanity top, a Phylrich faucet, a full shower with a glass enclosure, a Kohler head and marble flooring.

Twin guest stateroom

Perfect for families or friends, the twin guest stateroom features twin berths with custom linens over new carpet fitted in November 2025, abundant drawer storage and a centerline nightstand with a drawer. A cedar lined closet with automatic light, neutral wallcoverings, a Samsung TV, a smoke detector and a custom window treatment with a Roman pleated shade complete the cabin. The private bath elevates the experience with dual onyx vanities, sconce lighting, a frameless glass shower enclosure, a Jacuzzi tub, a Kohler toilet and marble flooring.

Skylounge

The skylounge is a chic sanctuary anchored by a new walk up bar added in 2022, its marble top and sink paired with three leather bar stools, new stone flooring and a matching stone bar top, plus an Avanti undercounter refrigerator, a Max Ice icemaker and a new wine cooler from the same year. Lounging flows across an L shaped upholstered sectional with storage below, a swivel chair with ottoman and a large leather ottoman/table with tray, all set on new carpet laid in November 2025. Entertainment is delivered via a Samsung 46" Smart OLED TV, DVD player and Yamaha receiver, while a convenient day head stands ready for guests. Floor to ceiling glass opens to the upper boat deck through a dedicated door, and new headliner and wallcoverings, both installed in 2022, complete the refined ambiance.

Pilothouse

The pilothouse is command ready with three Stidd adjustable helm chairs and a protective windscreen cover, supported by seven full size chart drawers for serious passage planning. Just off the pilothouse, an oversized captain's cabin offers a double berth and head for quick turn rest. A teak and holly sole grounds the space, while side entry doors to port and starboard and wing stations with controls both sides enable confident docking and maneuvering.

Electronics and navigation equipment

Navigation and communication are comprehensively specified with a Simrad AP50 autopilot paired with J50 and RF300S and a fluxgate compass; a Furuno 1954 CBB NavNet VX2 black box radar/chartplotter GPS with Furuno BBW GPS; a Furuno WAAS/GPS receiver antenna; and a Furuno FCV585 depth sounder/fish finder with an 8.5" color LCD. Redundant routing is ensured by

two Nobeltech Time Zero chart systems displayed across three Acer 21" monitors. Handling and comfort are enhanced by Naiad stabilizer controls and bow thruster controls. Entertainment and connectivity aloft are delivered through KVH HD11 TracVision Satellite TV and KVH VSAT mini broadband. VHF and onboard comms include two Icom DSC VHF's and eight Icom M88 radios. For situational awareness, an Elbex CCTV monitoring system with four cameras keeps vigilant watch.

Flybridge

The flybridge is a sun splashed haven with a bimini top and an overhead sunshade on stainless steel supports, anchored by a custom oversized Spa Crest six person Jacuzzi with two steps up and stainless steel handrails. Entertaining revolves around a custom built in bar adjacent to the Jacuzzi with a Corian top and three swivel bar stools, while two large forward sunlounges with cushions and covers to port and starboard invite indulgent relaxation. A Venturi windshield, a radar arch with four overhead light fixtures, a Fusion stereo with outdoor speakers, teak decks and steps down to the boat deck complete the open air brief, with safety underscored by two Viking twenty man life rafts. Flybridge electronics were modernized and include a Garmin Radar installed in 2021, a Garmin 8600 24" GPS/plotter installed in 2021, a Garmin 8600 16" GPS/plotter installed in 2021, a Garmin 8400 10" GPS/plotter installed in 2021, a Garmin wind gauge and display, two Garmin VHF radios, a Simrad 50 autopilot, analog main engine gauges and a dual SIM Wi Fi system.

Upper boat deck

The upper boat deck is arranged for effortless gatherings with four woven wicker chairs with cushions and three woven wicker tables with glass tops, all

set on teak decks with stainless steel safety rails. Movement is intuitive via a stairwell down to the lower deck and steps up to the flybridge, while full walk around decks lead forward to the Portuguese bridge. A new sunshade with stainless stanchions provides cool refuge when desired.

Watersports

For on the water thrills, the yacht carries two Yamaha Wave Runners, ready to launch at a moment's notice.

Deck equipment

Deck gear is robust and expedition ready, featuring two Muir V5000 hydraulic windlass systems and two CMYC 40 lb anchors with 5/8" chain. Tender handling is effortless with a Christensen hydraulic boat crane/davit, complemented by a Marquipt hydraulic passarelle and Marquipt eight step sea stairs. Safety and readiness are reinforced by two Viking twenty man life rafts. Full walk around decks lead to a Portuguese bridge deck with steps to the bow, bordered by stainless steel handrails and guard rails, while built in bow deck seating with cushions invites sunset moments. New exterior lighting was updated in 2023 to enhance both ambiance and security.

Aft deck

The aft deck is a true alfresco dining room with teak decking and an oval teak dining table on a double stainless steel pedestal, surrounded by eight woven wicker dining chairs with cushioned seats. A wet bar with a granite top, Scotsman refrigerator, icemaker and storage anchors service, joined by beverage refrigerators and storage to port and starboard and convenient overhead storage. Six Bose outdoor speakers set the soundtrack, while a

three sided enclosure and full air conditioning ensure comfort in any weather beneath hard overhead shades spanning the entire aft deck, all illuminated by fourteen overhead recessed lights.

Crew quarters

Thoughtfully arranged for professional service, crew accommodations include a captain's cabin just aft of the pilothouse with a full double berth, a Samsung 44" LED TV and a private bath, plus three crew cabins forward on the lower deck offering six upper and lower berths. Built in cabinetry and storage beneath berths are provided in all cabins, with hanging lockers throughout. Two crew heads feature a shower, vanity, mirror and Moen fixtures. The crew lounge is designed for efficient downtime with an L shaped settee/dinette, a full size refrigerator/freezer, a Samsung 24" TV, a GE microwave, an oversized stainless steel sink, InstaHot water, overhead lighting, ventilating port lights and two front load washers and dryers.

Electrical equipment

Power and monitoring are engineered for reliability, with twin Northern Light 80 KW generators complemented by a Northern Light 40 KW generator and three custom Soundown exhaust systems serving all gensets. Two 24v DC AGM engine starting battery banks and two 24v DC Sentry battery chargers underpin dependable starts and charging. A Christensen ship's monitoring system provides oversight, while two 100 AMP electrical inlets with 100' shore power cords, plus comprehensive electrical controls and a distribution panel, ensure seamless shoreside connectivity and shipboard management.

Engine room and mechanical equipment

Mechanical systems are robust and meticulously maintained, powered by twin Caterpillar 3412 diesel engines rated at 1000 HP, turning through ZF gearboxes with 3.45:1 reduction. As of December 2025, engine hours stand at 8,000. A hydraulic ring main drives all hydraulics, with Jastram hydraulic steering for precise control. Range and self-sufficiency are supported by two Flow watermakers producing 1500 GPD, Naiad 404 stabilizers and an American bow thruster rated at 50 HP. Climate control is assured by three Aqua Air Conditioning 7.5-ton compressors, with new chillers in 2023 serving the galley and aft deck. Hot water is supplied by two Whirlpool 50-gallon heaters, while a Grundfos/Headhunter freshwater system, an Alfa Laval fuel centrifuge, an Orca II sewage treatment system and a Racor fuel purification system maintain shipwide services. Tides shaft seals protect driveline integrity. Safety is paramount with a main fire pump control system feeding six fire stations, backup fire system/bilge pumps and twenty-six fire extinguishers distributed throughout the vessel.

Lazarette

A pneumatic lazarette door opens to a utility hub equipped with a Manitowoc commercial icemaker and two Frigidaire stand-up freezers, supported by a CO2 fixed firefighting system and two air compressors, ensuring the yacht's hotel services remain as capable offshore as in port.

Recent upgrades (2021-2023)

Recent investments elevate CHANSON's readiness and polish. The bottom was painted in 2025, while headliner panels were replaced throughout in 2023, and new carpeting was laid in the salon and staterooms in 2025. Galley upgrades

include a Bosch oven replaced in 2023 and a suite of new appliances in 2021. Exterior lighting was updated in 2023, and a Starlink Wi-Fi system was installed the same year, alongside large capacity A/C air handlers added in the galley and aft deck. Bow thrusters were replaced and upgraded in 2021. Power redundancy was strengthened with twin Northern Lights 80 KW generators and a Northern Lights 40 KW unit. Watermaker membranes were replaced in 2022, A/C chiller number one was replaced in 2022, and chillers two and three were renewed in 2021. The flybridge electronics suite was comprehensively refreshed in 2021 with new Garmin monitors, radars, a depth sounder, VHF radios, stabilizer control, wind and weather station, remote monitoring and a camera system. Interior refinements include new wood panels in the salon in 2022, new carpeting and wallcoverings in the skylounge in 2025, a new salon sofa in 2025, new sofa upholstery in the skylounge in 2021 and new overhead headliners in guest staterooms and the skylounge in 2022. All exterior cushions were replaced in 2022, and the skylounge bar received new marble flooring and countertop in 2021. The hot tub was replaced in 2023 along with a new control system and pumps. Audio/visual systems inside and out were modernized in 2022 with new TVs, speakers, iPad charging stations and stereos. For watersports, a jet ski was replaced in 2021, and on the tender a Yamaha 90 HP outboard, controls, gauges, stereo and VHF were replaced in 2022.

Work completed (2022)

In 2022, the yacht underwent comprehensive mechanical and running gear service: all running gear was removed for inspection, propellers were reconditioned and all cutlass bearings were replaced. Tides seals were serviced, all interior air handlers were replaced and every hydraulic line was renewed. Vulkan couplings for the main engines were also replaced. Additionally, the yacht benefits from a complete new paint job performed in

2017, preserving her crisp, timeless profile.


