OVERVIEW

Delivered at the end of 2023, OSCAR is the newest Numarine 37XP to enter the brokerage market and represents the most comprehensively specified example to date within the much-celebrated 37XP explorer line. She has been purposefully configured for family cruising, offering accommodation for 12 guests spread across 6 cabins, with an upper-level private owner's deck in place of a conventional sky lounge. Forward on the main deck, where a VIP or master suite would typically be found, the yacht boasts a thoughtfully designed children's playroom and cinema complete with a full bathroom that can be converted into a seventh stateroom for youngsters or extra guests.

Her interior, crafted by Hot Lab, is richly appointed and enhanced by hand-painted De Gournay wall coverings, delivering an atmosphere of refined individuality whose design motifs continue seamlessly through to the beach club, as reflected in the interior photography and the yacht's fine finishing touches. Externally, OSCAR is finished in a mirror gloss gunmetal grey across hull and superstructure, extended cleanly up to the domes to create a bold, unified silhouette. A 3 ton boat-deck davit provides the capability to launch and stow an extensive selection of tenders and toys, all of which are included with the expedition motor yacht package as delivered.

Built to EURO specification and fitted with Atlas shore-power converters, she is equipped to plug in effortlessly around the world and operate as a true global-cruising superyacht. Constructed on a steel hull with a composite superstructure, she features upgraded IMO Tier III propulsion and offers a passagemaking range in excess of 4,500 nm at standard speeds.

Accommodation for 8 crew is arranged in 5 cabins, including a captain's cabin on the upper deck, supported by a generous crew mess and an oversized laundry facility fitted with six full-size washers and dryers; this utility area also provides an additional crew berth with ensuite, serving as the fifth crew cabin.

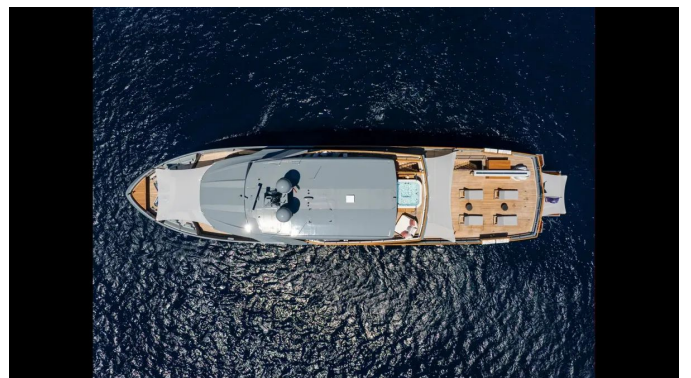

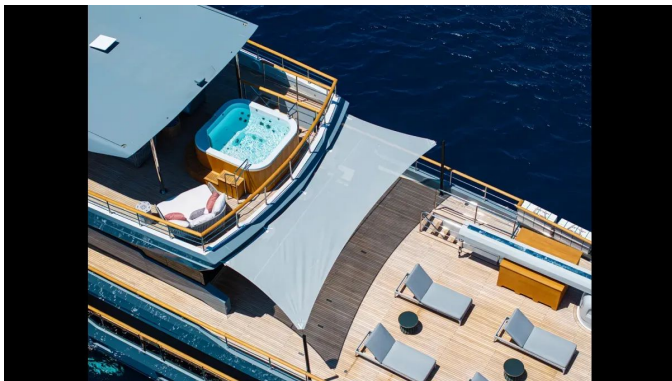

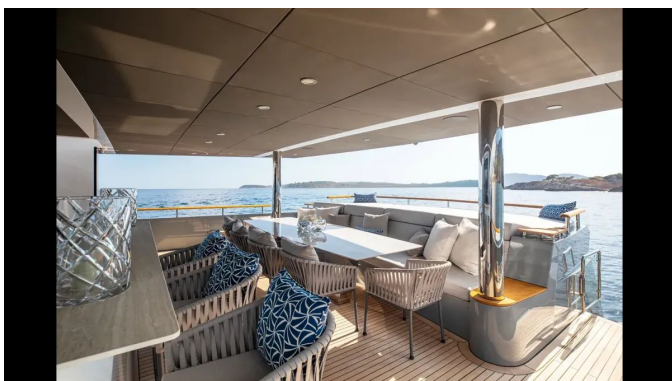

DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Upgrade list

A thoughtfully appointed collection of upgrades raises both the performance and the onboard experience of this yacht, beginning with IMO Tier III engines paired with an Atlas shorepower converter to assure global emissions compliance and harmonized power management. Entertainment and connectivity have been refined with a Bang & Olufsen sound system, Control 4 integration, TV SAT Kns 80 satellite television and uninterrupted internet via Starlink, while galley ambitions are met by Miele professional appliances. Practical and technical refinements include dedicated air conditioning for the engine room and a fully extended hard top that provides generous protection and shaded outdoor living.

Navigation is delivered through advanced Raymarine instrumentation alongside Time Zero systems, and water quality is secured by a Puro Water softening system together with an Octo Marine drinking water installation. The interior atmosphere is the work of Hot Lab, furnished inside with pieces from Minotti and Giorgetti and complemented outside with Kettal and Dedon collections. Accommodation and flow have been carefully considered with five guest cabins and a lower-deck laundry, a dedicated playroom on the middle deck and a private owner's cabin on the upper deck. Wellness and safety are prioritized with a gym outfitted with a Peloton bike and a Technogym weight box, and the vessel carries an MSOS near ocean medical kit for extended-voyage preparedness.

Walkthrough

OSCAR greets the eye with a lustrous gunmetal-gray lacquer and an interior

narrative woven by De Gournay wallpapers that run from the guest suites all the way to the beach club. Conceived with family life at its core, the yacht locates a dedicated children's room forward on the main deck; this carefully rounded, corner-free prime space—normally reserved for an on-deck master or VIP—has been transformed into an expansive playroom and private cinema, furnished with oversized sofas, a large-screen television, intimate seating niches, plentiful storage for toys and equipment, and a full bathroom, allowing seamless conversion into a seventh cabin when required. The result is a warm, convivial area destined to be a favorite for both adults and youngsters.

Every guest suite enjoys its own De Gournay motif, lending distinct personality to each cabin, while the beach club carries the theme forward with a lively accent wall that ties the yacht's decor from bow to stern. Commissioned by an owner with deep yachting experience and overseen through build by a longtime captain, OSCAR displays meticulous execution throughout. The extended hardtop houses integrated Starlink, and the galley is laid out for practical service with a dumbwaiter, twin ovens and Miele professional appliances. The bespoke sundeck arrangement features a jacuzzi, a full upper helm, a centerline dining table that seats all twelve guests, an expansive lounging precinct and a folding, swiveling television to ensure ideal sightlines from every seat.

The boat deck is equipped with a sturdy three-ton davit and stowage capacity for a Salpa Soleil 26 RIB powered by a 300 hp Yamaha outboard, a jet ski, and a secondary RIB with a 60 hp Yamaha outboard, plus room for inflatables and toys. Carbon-fiber poles and sunshades extend effortless shelter across nearly every exterior space, including the aft transom door area, bow seating and the boat deck. Interior design by Hot Lab blends family-friendly durability with elevated refinement, from the sumptuous textiles to the stonework, floor finishes, wall coverings and overhead treatments. Practicality is taken further in the laundry, which houses six full-size washers and dryers and includes an additional crew berth with a full head—perfect for accommodating an eighth

crew member during peak charters.

The wheelhouse is fitted as a professional command center with four Raymarine glass-panel displays and two more screens at the upper helm, forward-raked glazing for enhanced visibility, garnet-leather captain's chairs and a dedicated portside captain's cabin. Directly aft, the owner's private deck presents a tranquil sanctuary centered on a king berth, with a custom vanity and desk. The owner's bathroom is generous and sculptural, featuring a bespoke soaking tub, a rain shower, dual basins, and a toilet with bidet, all set against dramatic book-matched stone veined in black, gold and white—truly the most memorable outlook aboard for a nightcap or a sunrise.

Below, five guest cabins on the lower deck each showcase their own De Gournay story—flamingos, monkeys, florals and even a Christian Dior-inspired suite—while the lower corridor encourages a sense of discovery; each guest stateroom benefits from a generously proportioned en suite. A bright, glass-lined gym provides essential fitness equipment, including free weights and a Peloton, for on-demand workouts at sea.

The main salon flows effortlessly into the formal dining area, with the galley positioned just forward to port to support fine dining and silver service when desired. An ample built-in settee with two large armchairs accommodates twelve or more guests comfortably, and the room naturally divides into intimate conversation pockets. Rich herringbone wood flooring unifies the spaces, and the nearby day head in the guest foyer—adjacent to the gym—features swimming-fish De Gournay wallpaper paired with complementary stonework. The beach club completes the onboard experience as an air-conditioned lounge anchored by an L-shaped settee, vivid coral-sea and jellyfish wallpaper, a sink, refrigerator and ice maker, a convenient half bath so wet guests need not traverse the salon, and tailored storage for snorkel sets, life jackets and dive equipment.

Built for global cruising, OSCAR combines a full-displacement steel hull with a

composite superstructure to optimize comfort while minimizing weight, and she is fitted with zero-speed stabilizers for superior onboard comfort at anchor. Upgraded IMO Tier III engines deliver a range in excess of 4,500 nautical miles at cruising speed, extendable to 6,000 nautical miles at eight knots, and shore-power converters enable straightforward shore connections worldwide. Proportioned to access both major marinas and remote anchorages, OSCAR draws attention with her striking finish and possesses the seaworthiness and systems to cross oceans with confidence. This is a thoroughly appointed yacht—polished for family life and engineered for long-range exploration.

Tenders & toys

A carefully selected fleet ensures both effortless transfers and unforgettable play: a 26 ft Salpa tender and a Gala 420 tender provide swift, comfortable coastal cruising, while a Yamaha ES Deluxe Jet Ski 1049CC supplies adrenaline-fueled excursions. For underwater exploration, two Seabob F5 units offer smooth, intuitive propulsion, and a Flite board introduces the refined thrill of foiling across calm bays. When at anchor, the yacht transforms into a private resort with a Superyacht inflatable slide and a 5m slide (grey/white), turning every swim stop into a luxurious playground.

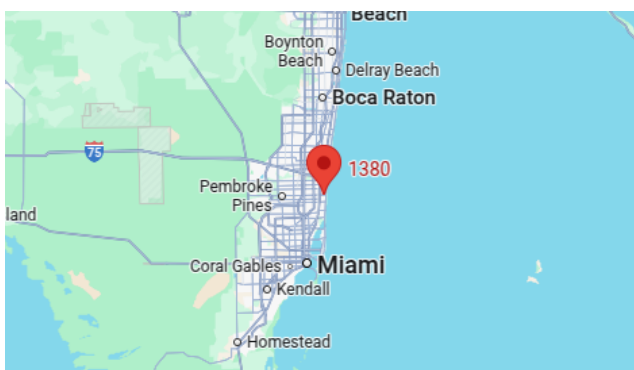
