## OVERVIEW

PROBABILITY is a distinguished rendition of the celebrated Delta Marine 122' lineage, long esteemed as one of the most reliable, thoughtfully engineered, and ocean-capable American-built tri-deck motor yachts in her class. What elevates PROBABILITY is an impeccable pedigree and a service history documented with complete technical records and survey reports, a provenance that speaks as loudly as her lines. Professionally maintained from delivery, she has benefited from continuous mechanical attention, scheduled systems upgrades, rigorous engineering oversight, and a level of long-term stewardship rarely encountered in today's market, resulting in machinery spaces that are orderly, immaculate, and meticulously serviced. The interiors mirror that exacting care, every system aboard reflecting ownership that demands uncompromising standards.

Propulsion and systems are arranged for genuine passage-making, with twin MTU 16V2000 main engines driving her reliably across bluewater, supported by dual 65 kW Phasor generators and Atlas Marine shore power conversion for flexible, shore-friendly electrical management. Quantum zero-speed stabilizers ensure comfort at anchor, while a thoughtfully executed AC/DC distribution architecture orchestrates power throughout the vessel with clarity and resilience. Her tri-deck superyacht configuration yields expansive guest accommodations, generous crew quarters, and multiple alfresco lounging and dining areas, perfectly suited to extended cruising or indulgent weekend escapes. For connoisseurs who prize pedigree, dependability, and enduring value, PROBABILITY stands as one of the most compelling offerings in the 120'-130' American superyacht, luxury motor yacht, and tri-deck yacht category.





# DETAILED DESCRIPTION

---

## Probability - 122' Delta - walkthrough

---

From the first glance, PROBABILITY radiates the pedigree of an American superyacht icon, crafted by Delta Marine and upheld by an ownership ethos that values engineering excellence and meticulous care; her provenance is backed by extensive technical reports and survey materials, and her mechanical heart offers equal reassurance: twin MTU 16V2000 main engines with 2400 hours since major overhaul presenting in excellent condition, supported by dual 65 kW Phasor generators for true redundancy, an Atlas Marine shore power converter for global compatibility, Zero Speed Quantum stabilizers for absolute comfort at anchor, and an intelligently designed AC/DC distribution system that speaks to Delta's thoughtful approach to reliability. A robust mechanical platform with generous tankage and hydraulic redundancy underpins proven long-range cruising, while the tri-deck layout orchestrates expansive interior and exterior living suited to extended passages or indulgent weekends, and the galley is equipped to professional standards with premium Gaggenau, Miele, and Sub-Zero appliances. Accommodations provide four guest staterooms—including a forward main deck VIP and a full-beam Owner's suite—plus excellent crew quarters with a dedicated mess and direct service access, ensuring both privacy and efficient operation.

Beyond specification, PROBABILITY's condition is the defining story: professionally maintained since launch, she has benefited from continuous mechanical care, consistent system upgrades, and disciplined engineering oversight, resulting in an engine room that is clean, organized, and serviced to schedule and interiors that reflect pride of ownership at every turn; the yacht's quiet operation, refined comfort, and the confidence she inspires make her a remarkably strong opportunity for buyers seeking pedigree, reliability, and

longevity in the one-hundred-twenty to one-hundred-thirty foot U.S.-built category.

Inside, craftsmanship takes center stage in salons and owner's areas where anigre and maple burl are elevated with chevron motifs, fine beveling, and deep chamfers to create a refined architectural presence, while guest staterooms pair maple with Birdseye maple to evoke warmth and understated luxury; contemporary art has been curated to complement the woodwork, and the precision of detailing reveals a sophisticated owner's vision aimed at a timeless, contemporary American aesthetic.

The main salon and dining area occupy a generous sweep of the main deck, surrounded by broad fixed house-side windows with electric shades that bathe the room in natural light, and aft stainless-steel-framed dual electric sliding doors with sidelights open to the aft deck to ease the transition between indoors and out; full walkarounds to port and starboard enhance circulation and preserve privacy. The formal dining area is subtly defined forward by a built-in console framed with twin decorative columns that incorporates storage and conceals the main salon television on an electric lift; a finely finished dining table seats eight, while varnished wood consoles beneath the windows store china, crystal, and silverware. To port, a dedicated entry foyer with marble tile soles links to the exterior via a large dogged and gasketed door, enriched by a mirrored art niche and drawer storage opposite to heighten the sense of arrival.

Forward on the starboard side, the private guest entry foyer serves as a discreet portal to the accommodations with built-in cabinetry and a marble countertop buffet below the windows; the main deck VIP lies full forward, its centerline berth arranged fore and aft against the forward bulkhead flanked by nightstands and storage integrated beneath the berth, and large fixed hull-side windows with electric shades frame ocean views. The VIP's en-suite features a marble countertop vanity, undermount sink, mirrored medicine cabinet, head,

and a fully enclosed shower with bench seating and a frameless glass door finished with marble tile soles, while entertainment is handled by a Samsung 26" LED TV with DIRECTV, a Blu-ray DVD player, and Apple TV with music server integration.

Descending the curved staircase from the starboard main deck entry, the guest foyer becomes an elegant hub for the lower accommodations with entrances forward to the port and starboard guest staterooms and aft to the full-beam owner's stateroom; storage closets and utility spaces are sensibly arranged, with an electrical panel in the forward closet and a washer and dryer in the aft closet, while a convenient linen closet supports discreet service. The full-beam master aft on the lower deck feels serene and substantial, featuring a centerline king-size berth with integrated storage, polished stainless-steel dogged and gasketed portholes with deadlights and electric shades, matching built-in dressers, an office desk to port and vanity to starboard, and spacious his-and-hers bathrooms with granite-top vanities, undermount sinks, mirrored medicine cabinets, and polished marble and granite surfaces; entertainment includes a 40" Samsung LED TV, DIRECTV satellite, a Blu-ray player, and Apple TV with server integration.

Guest cabins forward include a starboard cabin with a full-size athwartships berth, twin nightstands, polished stainless-steel dogged and gasketed opening portholes with deadlights and interior shades, and an en-suite bathroom with Corian countertop vanity and glass-enclosed shower, plus integrated entertainment via a Samsung 26" LED TV, CCC Control Mini iPad touchscreen interface tied to DIRECTV, a Blu-ray DVD player, and Apple TV with server capability. To port forward, a guest stateroom offers two single athwartships berths, desk space, cedar-lined hanging lockers, and matching entertainment systems to ensure each guest enjoys comfort and functionality.

The crew area, all the way forward on the lower deck and accessed via a curved stairway from the galley, is arranged for professional operation and

crew comfort: a lounge with L-shaped settee and Corian-topped table sets a welcoming tone, the crew galley is appointed with Corian countertops, stainless-steel undermount sink, filtered and Insta Hot taps, and organized cabinetry, while a stacked LG Think Q washer and dryer create a dedicated laundry center; an HP Monitor 24" displays the CCTV camera system, entertainment is provided by an iPad and flatscreen TVs, and the captain's cabin and two crew cabins forward—with double bunks, en-suite bathrooms, and portholes—ensure a capable team remains rested and efficient.

The sky lounge aft on the upper deck is one of the yacht's most alluring retreats, filled with light through large fixed windows and configured for sunset cocktails, movie nights on a 65" Samsung flatscreen TV, or quiet mornings; a day head with granite vanity and refinished teak-and-holly soles serves guests, and the starboard aft bar with granite countertop, stainless-steel drink refrigeration, Scotsman ice machine, and custom cabinetry anchors evening gatherings. Forward on the upper deck the wheelhouse commands approximately 270 degrees of visibility through a five-paneled raked windshield with wipers and wash, three adjustable helm chairs provide long-watch comfort, and a port office supports the captain's workflow, with all navigational electronics fully updated and modernized to complement the yacht's enduring mechanical integrity.

Outside, PROBABILITY's exterior layout reveals a yacht designed for elegant movement and effortless enjoyment, from gleaming paint and polished stainless detailing to seamless boarding from port and starboard and wide full walkaround side decks that preserve privacy; the aft deck's centerline pedestal-mounted varnished teak table seats eight and anchors al fresco dining, the swim platform offers expansive access with teak overlay decks and removable stainless-steel hoop-style handrails, and the boat deck with painted non-skid and boxed bulwark provides lounge seating, a banquette dining area, automatic doors to the interior lounge, and twin remote-davit systems that simplify tender handling. Above, the flybridge and sun deck present an

elevated sanctuary with a hot tub, a fully instrumented centerline helm with polished stainless-steel fittings, Stidd upholstered helm chairs on adjustable pedestals, cushioned seating with storage, marine stereo, soft overhead lighting, and a removable stainless-steel ladder to the arch, while forward on the bow a thoughtfully arranged seating area completes a deck plan that invites owners and guests to voyage farther, stay longer, and savor every nautical mile.
