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OVERVIEW

Measuring 37.8 m (124 ft), COCOON is a Martinique-series luxury motor yacht delivered in 2023 by Moonen Yachts in the Netherlands. This acclaimed, best-selling model in the Moonen Caribbean line marries René van der Velden's refined exterior styling with naval architecture by Diana Yacht Design, while a calm, Scandinavian-inspired interior by Sweden's Andreas Martin Löff Arkitekter raises her firmly into superyacht calibre.

Elegant yet welcoming, COCOON functions as both an impressive platform for entertaining and a comfortable family sanctuary, accommodating up to 12 guests attended by a crew of 7. Her tri-deck arrangement is conceived for effortless indoor-outdoor living, with expansive lounge areas and alfresco dining spread across three generous decks; the main deck introduces a spacious salon that flows into a formal dining room, supported by a large, well-equipped galley and capped by a sumptuous full-beam owner's suite complete with his-and-hers bathrooms. A terrace-style cockpit aft provides an additional lounge area, with steps descending to the extended swim platform fitted with a custom Hydromar Seascape sea transformer for seamless water access.

A near-continuous sweep of panoramic glazing along the main and bridge decks floods the interiors with natural light, enhancing volume and producing an interior that feels notably larger than her length might imply, while expansive sliding glass doors link the winter garden and the bridge-deck aft to form a single, climate-controlled living expanse. The sun deck delivers unobstructed 360° vistas and is arranged for relaxed outdoor living with a comfortable lounge and a fully appointed bar with grill, creating a luminous, convivial space above deck.

Powered by twin Caterpillar engines producing a combined 4,000 horsepower, COCOON reaches a top speed of 16.5 knots and cruises comfortably at 14.5

knots, an elegant synthesis of Dutch build quality, performance and timeless design.

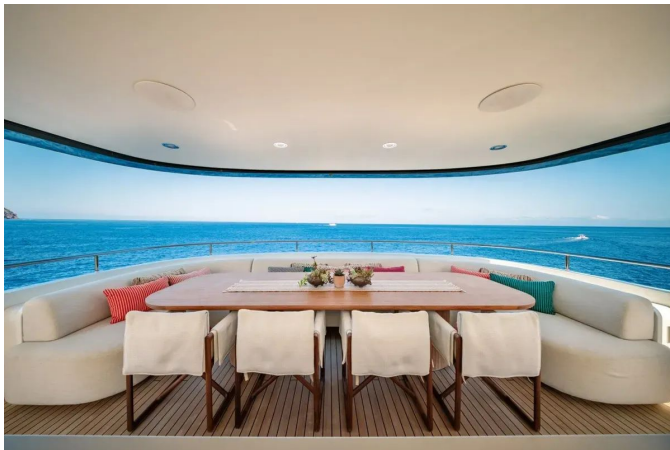


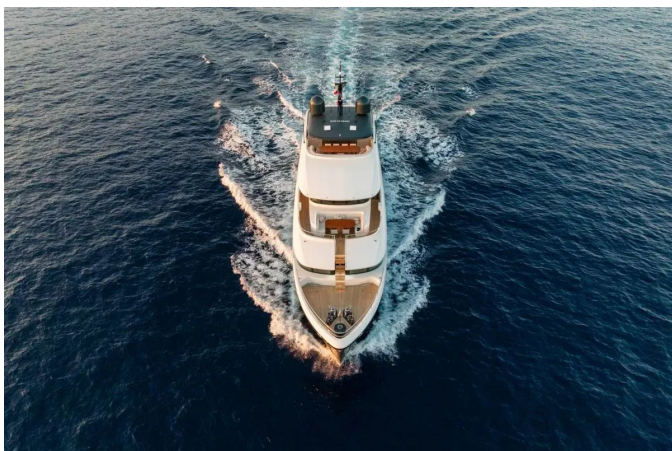














DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Detailed description

Launched in 2023, COCOON is a 37.8 m (124 ft) Martinique model from Moonen Yachts in the Netherlands, a consistently sought-after example within the Moonen Caribbean line. Her exterior profile was sculpted by René van der Velden with naval architecture by Diana Yacht Design, while Sweden's Andreas Martin-Löf Arkitekter has created a calm, Scandinavian-inflected interior that imparts a refined serenity to every salon and deck. Conceived as both an entertainer's platform and a peaceful family refuge, COCOON accommodates twelve guests and a crew of seven, her exterior architecture deliberately softening the transition between inside and out and providing generous seating and dining arrangements across three expansive decks.

The main deck is organized around a voluminous salon and an adjacent formal dining area, supported by a capacious galley and a master suite appointed with his-and-hers bathrooms. A relaxed aft lounge steps down to stairs leading to an extended swim platform, outfitted with a custom Hydromar Seascape sea transformer to simplify access to the water. Floor-to-ceiling sliding doors connect the winter garden with the aft bridge deck to create a single adaptable volume that responds to changing light and weather, while an expansive sun deck crowns the yacht with uninterrupted 360° views, a welcoming lounge and a bar-and-grill for elevated alfresco living. Nearly continuous panoramic glazing along the main and bridge decks bathes the interior in natural light and enhances the sense of volume, allowing COCOON's interiors to feel more generous than her length might suggest. Built in the Netherlands, she embodies Moonen's renowned craftsmanship and design pedigree.

Propulsion is provided by twin Caterpillar engines producing a combined 4,000 horsepower, delivering a top speed of 16.5 knots and an efficient cruising

speed of 14.5 knots. The result is a graceful synthesis of performance and poise, an elegant seagoing experience defined by expansive indoor-outdoor living, thoughtfully arranged social spaces and refined private accommodation.

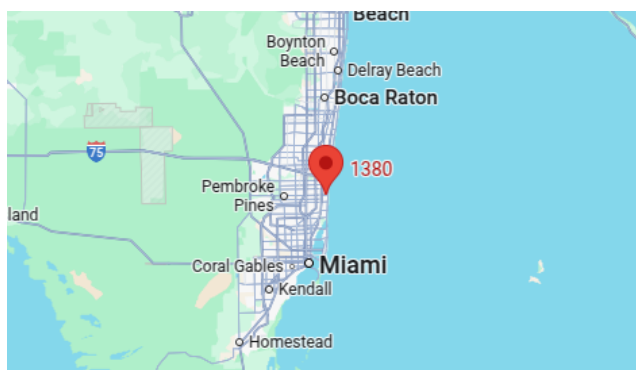
