OVERVIEW

AMAZONE is the last remaining pre-war pedigree motor yacht of her dimensions still suitable for restoration, a vessel of rare provenance delivered in August 1936 and constructed to exacting standards by John I Thornycroft & Co. in Southampton. She offers abundant interior volume, sweeping deck areas and a graceful, seaworthy displacement hull that embodies the spirit of a gentleman's yacht and the presence demanded of a heritage superyacht.

Now lying in Falmouth, the yacht has undergone significant preparatory works: the later superstructure has been removed and the hull restored to its original fabric, presenting an outstanding classic yacht restoration opportunity in the luxury motor yacht sector.





DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Detailed description

AMAZONE stands as the last pre-war pedigree motor yacht of her size available for restoration, a full displacement classic of rare stature and promise. Built to a very high standard by John I. Thornycroft with exterior design by Thornycroft & Sons / John I. Thornycroft, she was launched in August 1936 and received a refit in 2005. Her steel hull and superstructure are crowned by teak decks, and her fine seagoing hull form delivers the composed, all-weather capability that has long defined this distinguished lineage. At 38.10 m LOA (125'0") with a 35.40 m LWL (116'2"), a 6.40 m beam (21'0"), and a 2.70 m maximum draft (8'10"), AMAZONE balances elegant proportions with generous interior volumes and significant deck spaces. Her gross tonnage of 230 confirms the substance behind her grace, offering remarkable scope for a considered restoration that honors her heritage while embracing contemporary comfort. Under power, twin Cummins diesel engines—one to port and one to starboard—each rated at 522 kW (700 Hp), deliver a maximum speed of 12.00 knots and an economical cruising speed of 11.00 knots. With fuel capacity of 18,000 litres (4,755 US gallons), she is engineered for purposeful passages in classic displacement style. Her accommodation plan provides for up to 12 guests, supported by a professional crew complement of up to eight, ensuring the right balance of hospitality and service for extended cruising once restored. Now in Falmouth, significant preparatory works have already been undertaken. The modern superstructure has been removed, and the hull has been carefully stripped back to its original elements—precisely the blank canvas a connoisseur seeks for an authentic, exacting restoration. With her pedigree, proportions, and potential all aligned, AMAZONE invites a new custodian to shape the next chapter of a 1936 classic built to endure.
