OVERVIEW

Delivering nearly 5,000 square feet of interior living space and roughly 320 gross tons of volume, the Hargrave 125' Raised Pilothouse MESMERIZE unfolds with an unexpected generosity for her length, offering an expansive 7'8" of headroom throughout the principal lounges that imparts the scale and comfort more commonly found aboard much larger superyachts. With six distinct gathering zones arranged to accommodate as many as 60 guests across the decks, she is equally suited to refined entertaining as she is to unhurried, long-range cruising.

That exceptional interior volume and generous clearances create an open, luminous atmosphere rarely seen on yachts of this size, giving MESMERIZE the presence and feel of a substantially larger motor yacht. Originally delivered as GIGI II, she has long been recognized within the Hargrave fleet for a capacious, sociable layout that sets her apart in the brand's portfolio.

Maintained with care by attentive owners and an experienced professional crew, MESMERIZE is presented as a compelling, turnkey purchase opportunity. Comprehensive specifications, systems overviews, and equipment inventories are available in the Other Details section of this listing, underscoring her readiness for immediate service.

Configured to satisfy both private ownership and charter ambitions, the arrangement balances relaxed living areas with inviting spaces for guests. The raised pilothouse lifts the helm over the main deck, preserving and expanding guest areas while contributing to the yacht's bright, airy ambience. Whether envisioned as an intimate family superyacht or as a flybridge motor yacht for upscale events, MESMERIZE provides a refined, contemporary platform for comfortable voyaging.

Recent stewardship has been deliberate and thorough. A Spot Zero watermaker and purification system enhances onboard autonomy; the

flybridge received new granite counters in 2020; exhaust risers and heat blankets were renewed port in 2021 and starboard in 2023; steering rams and hydraulic hoses were serviced in 2023; dripless shaft housings and seals were replaced the same year; new teak was installed on the swim platform and cockpit steps (2023); Release Marine aft deck tables were added in 2021; a 22-inch Garmin GPSMAP 8622 display modernizes the flybridge navigation suite; and the Naiad stabilizer fins were fully rebuilt in 2023 to ensure a smooth, confident passage.

A defining feature is the country-style forward galley, imagined as a lively social hub rather than a secluded crew workspace. Centered on a generous island with casual seating for six and an integrated television, it invites informal gatherings from morning coffee through evening cocktails in the manner of a cherished residential kitchen. This open-galley concept, long favored by American owners, fosters an effortless flow between meal preparation and daily living. Throughout the interior, the 7'8" headroom, broad passageways, and expansive windows amplify natural light and cultivate a calm, contemporary atmosphere whether underway or at anchor.

Accommodations are exceptional for this class. Guests enjoy cabins scaled for privacy and comfort, while the full-beam owner's suite takes advantage of the yacht's 25-foot beam to create a serene primary retreat. The principal suite features mirrored his-and-hers heads separated by a large walk-in shower, enhancing the feeling of private luxury. Crew accommodations are thoughtfully arranged as well, with each cabin benefiting from a private en-suite head—an uncommon amenity that significantly improves life aboard and service delivery.

Entertaining clearly informed the design: six separate social areas allow groups to remain connected without feeling crowded, spreading comfortably between interior salons and alfresco decks while sharing the same experience. Capable of hosting up to 60 guests in comfort when cruising or at anchor, MESMERIZE

excels as a platform for celebrations, corporate events, or relaxed family gatherings. The flybridge, complete with spa tub and bar, provides a memorable setting for sunset cocktails and starlit evenings.

True to Hargrave's legacy of custom construction, robust engineering, and enduring build quality, MESMERIZE has benefitted from long-term professional care that reflects the brand's reputation for reliability. Propelled by twin Caterpillar C32 engines, she cruises comfortably at approximately 12 knots, offering dependable performance and long-range capability for bluewater passages. Upgrades to stabilization and other systems further refine the onboard experience across a wide range of conditions.

Designed for effortless, comfortable voyaging, this raised pilothouse motor yacht marries Hargrave's proven engineering with extraordinary interior volume and intelligently arranged entertaining spaces. Meticulously maintained and presented in impressive condition, MESMERIZE is offered ready for her next owner's cruising program—equally compelling as a privately owned superyacht or as a charter-ready luxury vessel in the premium flybridge segment.




DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Design influences and color pallet

Conceived for both charter and private enjoyment, the interior pursues a contemporary equilibrium of clean, sophisticated cabinetry and enduring appeal. A curated interplay of contrasting surfaces—Gloss Walnut wood anchored by Espresso and Taupe Zebra veneer accents, sculptured glass, and Cream Kaduna Marble (Royal Oyster)—yields an abstract, sculptural impression that feels unmistakably fresh. Every guest and social space is generously scaled and impeccably appointed, delivering a harmonious aesthetic that is as polished as it is welcoming.

Salon

The Main Salon is a glamorous, contemporary sanctuary that is both inviting and visually refined. Cabinetry detailing is artfully echoed in the dramatic ceiling soffits, while bespoke upholstered pieces feel luxurious and plush yet impeccably clean-lined and chic. At the aft entrance, large slabs of Cream Kaduna marble establish a luminous threshold. Flanking the foyer, substantial squared corner cabinets define and strengthen the architecture: to starboard, a concealed bar integrates complete storage, ice, sink, and service elements, rendered entirely invisible when closed; to port, its counterpart discreetly masks the crew companionway. Each cabinet features a striking 44" mirrored recess with a marble shelf showcasing Hebi sculptures. Forward, toward the Dining Salon, a central cabinet conceals a 60" TV on a hi/lo mechanism, balanced by a console with an art glass panel. Throughout, Gloss Walnut wood pairs with Espresso and Taupe Zebra accents; two 10' sofas lend effortless grace; approximately 60 sq ft of Cream Kaduna marble underscores the entry. Custom-designed dining seating for eight frames a console crowned with art

glass, while dramatic corner soffits, a center-opening aft glass door, two 44"-high mirrored art niches, a perimeter Walnut crown with integrated AC grille, and etched-glass privacy doors port and starboard complete the composition. Fabrics and furnishings are curated with the same rigor: sofa upholstery by JF Fabrics (Champion), lounge chairs and ottomans by JF Fabrics (Drama), custom dining chairs, and a custom YIBS dining table in Walnut with a Zebra band; Roman shades by Globaltex (Fortuna-Mocha); throw pillows by Glant (Couture Basket Weave-Limestone) and Beacon Hill (Romandie-Tourmaline); Sagastune satin nickel push-pull hardware; recessed lighting by Cantaluppi in satin nickel; and four Sonneman Plinth 6055.50 lamps in black nickel.

Galley

Designed as both a professional culinary workspace and a convivial hub, the galley mirrors the yacht's fine woodwork, hardware, and craftsmanship. Expansive counters culminate in a true walk-in pantry measuring 3' x 4', while three windowed sides flood the room with natural light. Forward, a generous settee comfortably seats eight. A large center island adds a second sink, an ice maker, a recycling station, additional Sub-Zero refrigerator drawers, and approximately 132 sq ft of organized storage. Aurora Granite countertops complement Porcelanosa V50915001 porcelain plank flooring in a driftwood tone; Gloss Walnut cabinetry frames Sub-Zero and GE appliances; square brushed-nickel push-pull hardware by Lamp and brushed-nickel lighting by Cantaluppi reinforce the modern aesthetic. The settee and bar stools are upholstered in Textillery Barcelona 51 ivory leather. Three Franke sinks serve the space, supported by one Grohe pot filler and three Grohe Lady Lux satin nickel faucets.

Day head

The Day Head celebrates a singular sculptural focal point: a 39" satin nickel wall-mounted Graff faucet, framed by a vertical marble backdrop sized just inches beyond the water supply to create a functional work of art. Beneath, a solid slab of marble flooring is lightly sprinkled with 3/4" square stainless steel tiles, inlaid to shimmer with subtle sophistication. Furnishings include a 48" asymmetrical Walnut cabinet, a Cream Kaduna marble vanity, a sculptural brushed-nickel faucet, a vertical marble panel behind the faucet, a mirrored ceiling, and Gloss Walnut walls and cabinetry. The sink is a Virgo Sintra Espresso vessel paired with the Graff Luna satin nickel faucet at 39" high, while the marble floor is Cream Kaduna with 1" x 1" stainless steel inlays.

Port, starboard hall and dog house

The starboard hallway links the Day Head, galley, pilothouse, and VIP, its floor reading like abstract art in Cream Kaduna marble with linear Pearlato Suevo inlays. To port, the matching design leads to the guest stairs and forward to the on-deck stewardess's walk-in pantry and laundry facility, where an additional Sub-Zero wine cooler holds 132 bottles. The dog house/laundry benefits from its own dedicated AC unit and generous preparation and folding space for the stewardess. Furnishings comprise Cream Kaduna and Pearlato Suevo marble flooring, Gloss Walnut cabinetry, a GE 3.1 cu ft front-load washer and 5.7 cu ft front-load dryer, a Sub-Zero 427G wine cooler for 132 bottles, and dog house flooring in 4" teak planks.

Pilot house

A serious, multi-functional helm, the pilothouse pairs a Stidd captain's chair with a dedicated desk and filing area, while an expansive 270-degree view

invites owners and guests to relax in motion or conversation. Furnishings include the Stidd helm chair in Ultraleather Milkweed; sofas by J. Robert Scott (Myconos/Mica with Ebony accents); stainless handrails wrapped in Textillery Barcelona 51 ivory leather; RM Coco throw pillows (2010CB/Cork and WO83112/12); Majilite Legend Elegance cream wall upholstery; and 4" teak plank flooring.

Lower foyer and stairs to guest staterooms

The descent to the guest deck is intentionally open and effortless. At the stairhead, an open connection to the starboard hallway reveals a petite balcony with an art glass and stainless steel balustrade. As the staircase approaches the lower foyer, it widens from 36" to 54", culminating in a grand semi-circular sweep that centers perfectly on a mirrored console crowned by a 5"-thick Cream Kaduna slab, its perimeter framed in mirror and topped with a dramatic sculpture reflected below. The foyer floor composes Cream Kaduna marble with custom stainless inlays, and all four corners conceal thoughtfully allocated storage for linens, towels, refrigeration and beverages, and cleaning supplies. Finishes include Majilite Legend Elegance cream wall upholstery; Kaduna Cream marble flooring with custom stainless inlays; a Gloss Walnut console with a Kaduna Cream marble surround framing the mirror by 4"; a ceiling with a perimeter crown and large open semi-circle; handrails wrapped in Textillery Barcelona 51 ivory leather with stainless accents; and a U-Line 1175R refrigerator.

Master stateroom

Echoing the Main Salon's aesthetic, the master suite places the bed at center stage, with every supporting element framing and amplifying its luxury. The headboard wall continues the drama: 18"-wide Zebra panels oriented

horizontally at 60" high over each nightstand flank a richly upholstered center that ties into a detailed ceiling soffit echoing the salon and artfully framing the bed. Appointments include Majilite Legend Elegance cream wall upholstery; plush wool carpeting; Fine Art sconces 790050; a bedspread and shams by JF Fabrics (Champion); Euro shams by J. Robert Scott (Cannon Plaid/Celadon); a Kravet neck roll (Rufiji/Fieldstone); Kravet Roman shades 9774-16 in linen with silver Lurex; and Cantaluppi satin nickel lighting.

Master bath

A true his-and-hers arrangement with a spacious shared shower at center, the master bath provides expansive vanities where paired sconces are precisely centered on each mirror for ideal illumination. Outboard heads in each bath are screened by unique privacy glass panels. The marble palette reprises Cream Kaduna and Pearlato Suevo with stainless inlays, and storage is abundant, with plentiful natural and task lighting. Furnishings include four Ashley 21309 sconces; Gloss Walnut cabinetry; Cream Kaduna flooring with Pearlato Suevo and stainless inlays; Pearlato Suevo vanity tops with a bold 4" front edge; an art glass privacy panel; and an all-marble shower with dual entrances and recessed niches for bath items.

VIP forward stateroom

Forward of the galley in the bow and reached via a private stair, the VIP offers the same refined storage and aesthetic detailing as the guest deck—along with the added privacy of its forward position. Twin closets of over 3' each accompany a large eight-drawer dresser and generous supplemental storage. The headboard is uniquely articulated in a crisscross of horizontal and vertical Zebra wood. Appointments include Majilite Legend Elegance cream wall upholstery; wool carpeting TBD; Cantaluppi lamps in satin nickel; a JF Fabrics

bedspread (Bombay/93J4841); Euro shams by Beacon Hill (Flash Point/Silver Screen); decorative pillows by Lee Jofa (Gp&GB-Fretwork/Teal); RM Coco Roman shades (Wilco/Linen); and Cantaluppi satin nickel lighting.

VIP forward bath

Executed in Cream Kaduna marble with Emperador Dark accents, the VIP bath features dual rectangular sinks and abundant storage. The vanity blends open and enclosed elements with plentiful drawers, while the floor is elegantly bordered by a dark brown marble inset. Outboard beneath the porthole, an expansive countertop provides additional storage and a dedicated vanity area. Furnishings include Cream Kaduna marble flooring with Emperador Dark inlays, Emperador Dark marble vanity tops, two Ginger 2881SN sconces, Gloss Walnut cabinetry, and a frameless glass shower door with an Emperador Dark footrest/seat.

Port and starboard guest staterooms

Each guest stateroom anticipates every need, with large TVs integrated into armoire-style entertainment cabinets. Outboard, a generous curved settee invites lounging, while an adjacent 5' closet is meticulously appointed with shoe racks, extra drawers, and abundant hanging space. The bed delights as a king with beautiful upholstery and Zebra wood detailing, converting easily to twin beds with full walk-around access in either configuration; wide lower drawers store all extra bedding without encroaching on closet space. Appointments include Majilite Legend Elegance cream wall upholstery; wool carpeting; Sonneman Mitra lamps in satin nickel; a Maxwell bedspread (Neo/#4Stone); decorative pillows by Rodolph (MMW/8350H) to starboard and by Romo (Casca Hemp) to port; Roman shades by RM Coco (Live Dust) to starboard and by Duralee (14225/Taupe) to port; Cantaluppi satin nickel

lighting; and guest baths finished with Cream Kaduna marble floors and vanities.

Crew area

Aft, the crew lounge and quarters enjoy enclosed access from the port deck and from the stern. Amenities include a crew settee and a compact kitchenette with cabinet storage, sink, and a full-height refrigerator, along with a dedicated washer/dryer for crew use. The captain's stateroom functions as a true suite with a dresser, work station, 42" flat-screen TV, a large double-door closet, a queen bed with full walk-around, and a concealed Pullman berth for additional crew during deliveries, plus a private bath. The other two crew staterooms each offer two twin bunks and a private bath. Furnishings encompass three staterooms, three baths, a lounge, and a kitchenette; teak flooring; Gloss Walnut walls; Aurora Granite countertops; a GE 2700 washer/dryer; a GE GSCS3KGYSS refrigerator; and a Kohler Compass sink.

Crew staterooms

The captain's stateroom presents a suite-level experience with a dresser, work station, 42" flat-screen TV, a large double-door closet, a queen bed with full walk-around, and a concealed Pullman berth for additional crew on deliveries, as well as a private bath. The other two crew staterooms are each arranged with two twin bunks and a private bath.

Aft deck

Conceived to host a crowd in equal comfort for relaxation or dining, the Aft Deck table seats fourteen and converts when its center section is removed into two cocktail tables for more casual gatherings. A 32" flat-screen TV is

positioned behind a fully professional bar with four contemporary square bar stools, all upholstered—like the bar front itself—in pale mist Aqua leather outlined by polished stainless steel. The bartop gleams in gloss teak, while the deck is laid in natural teak. Furnishings include Fabric Tent Sail Clothe Shara cushions for the settee and teak chairs; Spinneybeck Aqua Leather Mist 606 on the bar stools and bar front; a gloss teak aft table measuring 126" x 56"; Delaney & Long Tender Mist throw pillows; a U-Line CLR 2160 ice maker; a 32" Aquios TV; custom stainless steel spiral stairs to the flybridge; and a headroom of 7'-9".

Flybridge

On the flybridge, twin forward-facing double benches—starboard at the helm and port opposite—anchor a social layout planned for fourteen, with a professional service bar seating six. Aft of the bar, a cooking station delivers sixteen linear feet of preparation or buffet surface over two Sub-Zero refrigerator drawers, a 30" beverage ice cooler, an electric grill, a gas grill, a utility sink, and ample storage, all set on natural teak decking beneath the hardtop. Opposite, a large spa tub is paired with its own intimate bar and two stools facing the water; a substantial sun pad offers deep storage beneath, and aft, four lounge chairs with side tables complete the retreat. Furnishings include three Sub-Zero 700BR refrigeration drawers; a U-Line CLR2160 ice maker; a U-Line 2175WC wine cooler; two Edgestar FP860 freezers; a TBD grill; an Elag BGR530426 cooktop; a Spa City Sunbelt Apollo tub; natural teak flooring; eight custom stainless bar stools and custom stainless helm benches upholstered in Majilite Ovation Cappuccino; Fabric Tent Dupion Sand settees; and throw pillows in Bangladesh Dune with Samuel & Sons Firewood trim and Great Outdoors Aqua Velvet Coco.

Factory installed equipment

Built with cruising confidence at its core, the yacht features 2" deck fills for fuel and water; a 700-gallon stainless steel water tank; a V-shaped keel with longitudinal stringers; a fiberglass hand-laid hull and stringers vacuum-bagged with foam core reinforcement; stringers bonded to the hull and encapsulated in multiple layers of glass cloth and resin; and a deck and superstructure reinforced with foam cores beneath fiberglass. Structural integrity extends with FRP bulkheads; interior structural components bonded to the hull, including bulkheads and frames; FRP main deck and floors; and teak on the main exterior decks. Exterior durability is assured by FRP portholes; a fiberglass swim platform; stainless steel 316 alloy handrails, stanchions, and fittings; and stainless steel cleats and chocks numbering eight, with stainless corner hawse pipes, rollers, and cleats at both port and starboard aft corners. On the foredeck, a stainless frame hatch with a grey Lexan cover complements a built-in handheld shower at the swim platform. The propulsion train is upgraded with long 4" stainless steel shafts equivalent to Aquamet 22, zincs on shafts, rudders, and transom as required, 5-blade Faster bronze propellers, main bronze struts for the 4" shafts plus an additional pair of bronze struts to support the extended shafts, FRP stern tubes for 4" shafts, an emergency tiller, and stainless steel rudders. Engines sit on fiberglass beds bonded to the hull with loads distributed on steel channels, and engine room quiet is secured by double layers of sound and heat insulation on forward, aft, and ceiling bulkheads, with additional insulation where required for main and lower deck ceilings, plus a third insulation layer at the master bulkhead. The helm grants easy access to all dashboard controls and gauges, with remote windlass operation from both the pilothouse and flybridge. Filtration includes Racor 1000 FG fuel filter/water separators for each engine, two units total, and a Headhunter 200 GPD waste treatment system. Manoeuvrability and safety benefit from an upgraded hydraulic bow thruster Model 16 at 60 HP, Hynautic

hydraulic steering adaptable to autopilot, and a CAT-supplied engine alarm system for low oil pressure and high temperature. The engine room is well-served with 24V lights and 110V receptacles, four each, a fresh water filling faucet, and custom underwater engine exhaust with idle bypass. Electrical architecture is comprehensive: VIMAR sockets and switches throughout; 220V/110V, 60Hz power; color-coded wiring; seven Rule sump pumps with float switches; a Y-valve for dockside pump-out from the holding tank; eight 200 Ah batteries for engine and ship service; two separate 120 Ah generator batteries; all batteries in FRP boxes; a main electrical panel with separate AC power control and circuit breakers; and 110V duplex receptacles located throughout, including the engine room. Interior refinements include indirect rope lighting under valances in the salon, staterooms, and galley; polished stainless interior door hardware and stops; satin nickel drawer and cabinet pulls; a recessed tray ceiling in the salon; micro-switch-activated closet lighting; Cantaloupe 24V brushed-nickel ceiling lights; Roman shades in each stateroom, the main salon, and the galley; hydraulic-lift beds in the Master and VIP; generous forward deck storage; a boat panel indicator; granite countertops in the galley; and marble or granite countertops in all bathrooms, including a full walk-in master shower. Exterior protections comprise black Textilene front window covers, flybridge vinyl seat covers, helm and passenger seats on the flybridge, a Lexan hatch from aft deck to flybridge, and full CAT instrumentation at the helm (tachometer, oil pressure, engine temperature, transmission pressure, and hours). Shoreside connectivity includes two city water inlets and two TV/telephone inlets, while washdowns are provided at three locations—bow, aft deck, and flybridge. The hull is protected by two coats of Sea Hawk bottom paint, a sea chest, white perforated insulation panels in the engine room, and three windshield wipers with blades and a digital control panel.

Interior equipment

The interior specification showcases Walnut wood throughout, Majilite upholstery, and leather-wrapped handrails on the stairway from the main deck to the VIP and other guest cabins, with two additional customized stainless steel handrails wrapped in leather in the pilothouse and an upgraded leather-wrapped handrail ascending from the hallway to the pilothouse. Custom hardwood edges with recesses and bespoke crown moldings run the length of the vessel. Soft luxuries include fifty-one additional decorator pillows. Electrical refinement comes via Vimar switches with twenty-one dimmers; Cantalupi matte brushed-nickel wall lamps in the VIP and both port and starboard guest cabins; and a Nutone CV450 central vacuum with eight outlets. Acoustic serenity is enhanced by SanDam K-Pro insulation between the VIP wall and the master cabin, while five in-cabin safes provide security. Practical upgrades include WDI soundproof galley flooring; under-mount sinks for the galley and on-deck head; two custom bar stools in the galley; a Rev-A-Shelf chrome blind-corner pullout with full extension and a Rev-A-Shelf white recycling center with heavy-duty slides and full extension in the galley. The vessel is fitted with nine Headhunter heads; Awl Grip finishes in six shower stalls; a marble floor at the salon's aft-deck entry; marble-topped niches in the salon; marble counters to port and starboard of the salon dining table; a marble-topped forward console in the salon; a marble bar top for the starboard aft bar in the salon; a Marzi PD undermount bone sink and a Grohe Allure 32128 000 faucet in the salon; and a mirrored ceiling in the Day Head with one Virgo Sintra Espresso sink and one 39" Graff Luna satin-nickel faucet, a 7"-wide marble wall panel behind the faucet, one Graff satin-nickel towel ring, one Graff satin-nickel toilet paper holder, one Graff satin-nickel robe hook, specialty wall covering, and a Cream Kaduna marble floor with stainless inlays per the floor design. Master storage includes two custom angled shoe racks inside the closet, a granite-top nightstand, 3/4" platinum vinyl strips for

the bed headboard, a marble shower seat, marble on the shower walls and floor, stainless floor inlay ties in the bathroom, two textured glass panels flanking the toilet area, three recessed shelves with sea rail in the shower, and four Ashley 21309 brushed-nickel sconces. In the VIP, there is a marble nightstand top; marble shower and floors; marble bathroom and shower flooring; a marble shower seat; a Kohler sink; a Graff G-2301 satin-nickel sink faucet; and a Grohe 27 010 3000 brushed-nickel shower system. Port guest upgrades include a marble nightstand top, a marble shower seat, a marble shower floor, and a marble bathroom floor; sliding mechanisms allow two single beds to glide in both port and starboard guest cabins. Starboard guest enhancements mirror with a marble nightstand top, a marble shower seat, a marble shower floor, and a marble bathroom floor. Premium glazing includes glass doors for the master shower, VIP, and both guest cabins; one Ginger 504L soap caddy and one Ginger 505 shampoo caddy in the VIP, port, and starboard guest showers; Graff G-2301 satin-nickel sink faucets in the VIP, port, and starboard guests and in both master bathrooms; one C.R. Laurence shower door handle in the VIP, port, and starboard guest and both master baths; Graff satin-nickel towel bars—three in the VIP, two in the port guest, two in the starboard guest, and four in the master bath; one Equip satin-nickel toilet paper holder in the VIP, port, and starboard guest and both master baths; one satin-nickel robe hook in the VIP, port, and starboard guest and both master baths; and U-channel hardware for shower glass walls set into marble in the VIP, port, starboard, and master showers. Additional lighting includes two Ginger 2881 satin-nickel sconces in the VIP port and guest bathrooms; showers in the master and both guest cabins feature Grohe Aquatower 3000 systems; and Kohler Verticyl K-2882-96 sinks outfit the port and starboard guest bathrooms, each with drain covers in the VIP, master, port, and starboard guest. The captain's suite gains a framed dresser mirror, a Kohler Ladena K-2214 sink, and a granite shower seat, while the forward crew shower features a granite seat as well. Entertainment expands with four

fold-down TVs in the forward and aft crew cabins, and the captain and crew cabins and lounge receive teak panel flooring and six stainless Cantalupi Ragno reading lights shared between captain, forward, and aft crew. The aft crew bathroom is equipped with a Kohler Compass K-2298-96 sink and a granite shower seat, while the crew lounge gains a Marzi PD:48 100R Bisque sink and one Grohe 33153 stainless sink faucet, a granite countertop, and an upgraded hi/low table with a cushion to convert the settee and tabletop into a berth. Architectural flourishes continue with a marble frame with mitered corners in the lower foyer, a marble foyer floor with stainless inlays, marble hallway floors to port and starboard per the flooring design, and three custom sliding doors in the port and starboard hallway. The headliner fabric is General Plastic Voyager Mystic off-white 422773 with tricot foam backing (200 yards). Navigation upgrades include a Danforth 5" compass at the upper helm and one Stidd Slimline Low Back stainless helm chair with cupholder in the pilothouse.

Audio and visual equipment

Entertainment is engineered for every space: a Shakespeare 2030 TV antenna crowns the hardtop, managed by a Shakespeare 2025 CP controller in the pilothouse. A Digital 500 Series 8' AM/FM antenna feeds a Concord TV distribution board with AM/FM. Satellite capability arrives via KVH 2011 TracVision HD7 USA in an M9 dome, a second KVH 2011 TracVision M9 empty dome, and two Edson 6" towers for the KVH M9, plus a KVH HD7 tuner expansion kit. In the Main Salon, a Samsung UN60D8000 pairs with a Motivated Design 65" PLSM/LCD pop-up lift bottom mount and Motivated Design remote kit with Vimar wall DC relay, driven by a Bose Lifestyle V35 (white, flush-mounted), a Samsung BD-D6700 3D Blu-ray player, a DirecTV HD DVR receiver (leased), a Tripp Lite HTR07-1U, and a Middle Atlantic sliding rack assembly. Speakercraft AccuFit CRS7 One speakers serve both dining and

salon areas, powered by a Bose SA-2 stereo amp with a Bose RC-355 V-Class RF remote. Aft Deck sound is delivered by two JL Audio M770 CCX marine speakers (white), two Bose SA-3 Lifestyle stereo amplifiers, and a Bose RC-355 V-Class RF remote. In the pilothouse, two Speakercraft AccuFit CRS7 Ones pair with a Bose SA-3 and a Bose RC-355 V-Class RF remote. The galley enjoys a Samsung 32" HD LED UN32D6000 on a Concord mount, a leased DirecTV HD DVR, a Samsung BDC5500 Blu-ray, a Sonance FS-23 iPod dock, two Bose SA-3 amplifiers, a Bose RC-355 RF remote, four Speakercraft AccuFit CRS7 Ones, and a JL Audio M770 CCX marine speaker (white). Forward, the bow area is served by a Bose SZ-3 Lifestyle stereo amplifier with a Bose RC-355 RF remote. On the flybridge, a Fusion AM/FM/iPod stereo drives four JL Audio M770 CCX marine speakers (white), with two Fusion MS-WR600C wired remotes in chrome at the helm and bar, and a Fusion 500-watt four-channel marine amplifier. The VIP features a Samsung 40" HD LED UN40D6400 on a Concord mount, a Samsung BDC5500 Blu-ray, a leased DirecTV HD DVR, and a Sonance FS-23 iPod dock. Both port and starboard guest staterooms each carry a Samsung 40" HD LED UN40D6400 on a Concord mount, a leased DirecTV HD DSS receiver, a Samsung BDC5500 Blu-ray, and a Sonance FS-23 iPod dock. The Master enjoys a Samsung 50" HD LED UN40D6400 on a Concord mount, a Bose Lifestyle V35 (white, flush-mounted), a Samsung BDC550 Blu-ray, a leased DirecTV HD DVR receiver, and a Middle Atlantic sliding rack. The Captain's stateroom adds a Samsung 40" HD LED UN40D6400 on a Concord mount, a leased DirecTV HD DSS receiver, and a Sonance FS-23 iPod dock. Crew areas include four Audiovox 10" drop-down LCD DVD TVs across Crew 1 and 2, two Xantech AV-61 units and two leased DirecTV Basic DSS receivers across Crew 1 and 2, plus a Samsung 32" HD LED UN32D6000 on a Concord mount in the crew lounge with a Samsung BDC5500 Blu-ray and a Sonance FS-23 iPod dock.

Appliances

Appliance appointments elevate both hospitality and service: in the Main Salon, a U-Line CLR2160 black ice maker; in the lower foyer, a Dometic CR-1110U/F fridge. The galley carries a Sub Zero BI 42 stainless refrigerator, two Sub Zero 700BR white refrigerator drawers, a U Line CLR2160 stainless ice maker, a GE Profile black PP975BMBB cooktop paired with a GE Profile PT916SMSS stainless oven, a GE Profile JV930SCBR stainless hood, a GE Profile PVM1870SMSS stainless microwave, a GE Profile GDWT160RSS stainless dishwasher, a GE Profile GCG1580RSS stainless trash compactor, three GE Profile GFC720F satin nickel disposals actuated by three InSinkErator sink top satin nickel switches, a Franke KBX120 43 stainless sink, two Blanco 157 140 ST stainless pull out hand spray faucets, an InSinkErator F HC1100 satin nickel instant hot dual temp faucet with an InSinkErator SST FLTR stainless instant hot tank and filter, a Franke GNX 110 16 stainless island sink, a Grohe LadyLux PRO 31042 SDO satin nickel pot filler, and a Grohe Atrio 20 074 AVO satin nickel island faucet. In the doghouse, a GE WSXH208HWW white 120V/60Hz washer and a GE DSXH43EFFF white 120V/60Hz dryer flank a Sub Zero 427G Classic stainless wine cooler. The crew lounge features a GE Profile PSIC5RGXBV black refrigerator, a Panasonic NN SD3773 stainless microwave, and a GE WSM2700DWW white washer/dryer. On deck, the aft deck hosts a Sub Zero UC 15l overlay panel ice maker; the flybridge includes a U Line 2175WC wine cooler, two Sub Zero 700BR white FRP face fridges by the hot tub, Sub Zero 700BR white FRP face 115VAC/60Hz fridge drawers behind the flybridge bar, a Sub Zero UC 15l overlay panel 115VAC/60Hz ice maker, a U Line CLR2160 black 115VAC/60Hz ice maker, a Fire Magic 3C S1S1P A deluxe stainless gas BBQ grill, and an Edgestar FP800 grey 115VAC/60Hz freezer.

Electronics

Navigation and command are entrusted to six KEP Marine KEPL L 19 sunlight readable displays in the pilothouse, driven by two Furuno NavNet 3D black box MFD processors. Radar coverage is dual: a Furuno NavNet 3D 12kW, 72 n.m., 6' array on the hardtop and a Furuno NavNet 3D 4kW, 48 n.m., 3.5' array on the radar arch, each paired with a Furuno BBWGPS WAAS antenna on the hardtop. Traffic and weather intelligence include a Furuno FA150 AIS with a Digital 500 Series 4' AIS antenna and a Furuno PB200 weather sensor on the hardtop. Control complements feature a Concord computer tower (empty) in the pilothouse, a Nauticomp panel mount mouse, and a Concord RF keyboard/mouse (Logitech). Position, data, and wind systems comprise a Furuno GP33 color GPS in the pilothouse, two Furuno RD323 NMEA color repeaters at the lower helm, a Furuno 235 MSLF 235kHz smart sensor forward on the hull, a Furuno FI50 wind display and sensor at the lower helm, Furuno NMEA2000 micro MA terminators (two), a Furuno NavPilot 700 at the lower helm, a Furuno PG500R heading sensor, and a Furuno NavPilot HRP 17 24 pump set in the engine room. Communications include a Furuno FM4000 25 watt VHF and mic at the lower helm, a Digital 500 Series 16' VHF antenna on the hardtop, and a Newmar 60/40 hailer horn on the hardtop. The upper helm mirrors capability with a KEP Marine KEPL 15 sunlight readable display, a Furuno NavNet 3D 12" MFD, two Furuno NavNet 3D BB control keyboards for MFDBB 1 2, a Nauticomp panel mount mouse for NAV computer control, two Furuno RD33 NMEA color repeaters (depth/speed/temperature and depth), a second station Furuno NavPilot 700, a Furuno FM4000 25 watt VHF with a remote mic second station, a Digital 500 Series 16' VHF antenna, and a Newmar 60/40 hailer horn. Power and video management include a Newmar 32 12 50 DC DC converter, two Sea See DND 60 wide white ball cams on the aft deck, two Sea See DND 60 wide white ball cams in the engine room, a Sea See quad switcher and keyboard at the lower helm with a keypad at the upper

helm, a Sea See 1x4 video amp, a Concord 110VAC/12VDC 10 amp unit, an Extron 8 in/8 out switcher, a Concord DC AC pure sine wave inverter, and twin ACR RCL100D 24VDC spotlights.

Exterior equipment

Outdoor living excels with custom aft deck seating and one 440" TV forward of the aft deck wet bar. The aft deck wet bar features a granite top and is upholstered in Aqua leather with stainless bands and cuffs, complemented by four custom stainless bar stools. Service includes a Scandvik 10242 stainless sink and one Scandvik 70130 polished chrome faucet at the aft deck bar. Dining versatility comes via a teak aft table on two Aritex hi/low electric angled table bases with slides. On the flybridge, a Franke GNX 110 16 stainless sink pairs with an additional 10" stainless sink and a Scandvik 70103 polished chrome faucet, plus a Scandvik 10242 stainless sink for the forward flybridge bar. The hull sides are accented by extra 2 3/8" oval stainless banding with a solid wood insert and 4" offset. The flybridge wet bar seats six on stainless stools, and a secondary flybridge bar by the hot tub offers two more stools. One aft flybridge table with a teak top rests on an Aritex hi/low electric angled base suited to the curved seating beside the hot tub. Gloss teak bartops finish both the flybridge bar and hot tub bar, supported by two Aritex hi/low electric angled table bases with slides for the flybridge table and one such base for the aft flybridge table. Removable teak tabletops fit between seats aft and on the flybridge. Teak decking is upgraded on the flybridge, aft deck, and bathing platform to 3" wide planks. Boarding practicality includes a dedicated ladder locker, an automatic/manual aft deck door with a stainless frame and tinted glass, four wicker deck chairs, and five U shaped 2" handrails on the swim platform. A Kahlenberg D OA air horn stands by, as do two quartz floodlights. Bow arrangements feature a non skid enclosed FRP storage box with seat, reinforced structure for a davit and standpipe, eight waterproof bow deck

lights, and two stainless steel Hargrave 16" logos. Engine access is via a stainless engine room door and a Freeman watertight hatch 30" x 30" to the swim platform. There are thirteen custom openable fiberglass portholes 24" x 12". Comfort at the upper helm is improved by a stainless footrest rail for the port and starboard navigation seats on the boat deck. Night ambience is achieved with fifty Cantalupi Diana 105 stainless exterior lights and staple style 2" stainless exterior handrails on the aft and flybridge decks. The hardtop shelters a custom hot tub box with an FRP storage chest with a hinged lift up panel, a sun pad on top, and FRP seating on the boat deck; the hot tub integrates access steps, safety rail, an integrated seat, an access hatch to storage below, and tailored covers and cushions to convert the area for sunning. A custom staircase connects the aft deck to the flybridge with internal storage, while custom pillars grace the sidewalk ways and a custom helm console crowns the flybridge. Mooring is simplified with two Maxwell VC3500 capstans on the aft deck, one per side, and two FRP recessed lift ring holders for life rings.
