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OVERVIEW

2018 Custom Line 120' — M/Y RANDY BETH. On view at the Palm Beach International Boat Show from March 25–29 at D Dock, Slip 105, Palm Harbor Marina.

This commanding 120-foot superyacht, the work of the Ferretti Group, presents Italian artistry and modern poise in equal measure, marrying generous interior volume with refined performance. Styled as a flybridge motor yacht, she was conceived for owners who seek long-range comfort and discreet sophistication, equally suited to private ownership or operation as a premier charter vessel. Clean, contemporary lines and the unmistakable Custom Line silhouette are softened by broad ribbons of glass that flood the living spaces with daylight, fostering a continuous interplay between inside and out that is ideal for effortless entertaining, coastal cruising, or true bluewater passages. As a planing performance yacht with pedigree engineering, she balances speed and stability while maintaining a quiet, composed ride.

The main salon unfolds as a calm, expansive retreat framed by panoramic glazing that draws the sea into every view. A graceful sequence from lounge to formal dining creates an elegant social heart for family gatherings or sophisticated soirées, with premium materials, refined woodwork, and exacting finishes that attest to the shipyard's dedication to timeless design. The accommodation plan is generous and intelligently arranged: a full-beam, on-deck owner's suite affords exceptional privacy, abundant storage, and a spa-like ensuite, while the lower deck guest staterooms each feature private ensuites and together accommodate up to twelve guests in five-star comfort. The interior layout delivers both intimacy and flexibility, whether imagined as a private escape or a high-demand charter platform.

Outdoor living is celebrated across multiple decks. The expansive flybridge provides distinct zones for dining and lounging, perfect for alfresco meals from

dawn to starlight; the foredeck and aft deck offer additional spaces for sunbathing, leisurely lunches, or quiet contemplation at anchor. A welcoming beach club keeps you close to the water and a Jacuzzi lends resort-style indulgence. Boarding is simplified by a hydraulic passerelle, while a 7'2" draft broadens the cruising envelope.

Systems and engineering are presented to match the yacht's stature. Twin MTU 16V2000 engines rated at 2,638 hp, with approximately 1,700 hours, deliver smooth, confident cruising and enduring reliability. Attitude and comfort are enhanced by zero-speed fins and three factory-installed Seakeepers, and hydraulic bow and stern thrusters make tight maneuvering reassuringly simple. Electrical and hotel systems include dual 70 kW Kohler generators with about 3,500 hours, a tropical A/C package, a comprehensive waste treatment system, and twenty-two new underwater lights. ASEA shore power frequency converters expand global operability, and RINA commercial registration with unlimited charter restrictions, backed by a five-year commercial class survey completed in 2023, underscore her world-ready credentials.

Recent, meticulous maintenance further distinguishes this yacht: hull and topsides were professionally repainted in DuPont finishes in 2024 with a transferable warranty, and yard periods in July 2024 and August 2025 reflect diligent stewardship. For those seeking a pedigree Custom Line superyacht that blends enduring style with real-world capability, M/Y RANDY BETH represents a rare and compelling opportunity in the 120-foot motor yacht class.

DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Broker description

On display at the Palm Beach Boat Show from March 25 to 29 at Dock, Palm Harbor Marina, the 2018 Custom Line 120' M/Y RANDY BETH embodies the apex of Italian yacht design, built by the Ferretti Group to unite range, volume, and a quietly confident aesthetic. Her sleek, contemporary profile and expansive glazing bathe interiors in natural light, while the layout is equally attuned to private ownership and premium charter, harmonizing indoor refinement with alfresco living. The main salon welcomes with panoramic windows and a fluid connection to the sea, its lounge and dining zones curated for relaxed passages and polished entertaining alike, while rich materials, fine woodwork, and meticulous detailing speak to Custom Line's timeless craftsmanship. Accommodations are generous and smartly orchestrated: a full beam, on deck owner's suite promises privacy, abundant storage, and a luxurious ensuite; below, guest staterooms deliver five star comfort with individual ensuites—ideal for extended cruising with family and friends. Outdoor living is a signature: an expansive flybridge invites day to night lounging and dining, complemented by versatile aft and foredecks for sunning, meals, or quiet repose whether underway or at anchor. Power comes from reliable, high performance MTU 16V2000 engines rated at 2638 hp, delivering smooth, confident cruising with excellent range and stability, supported by advanced onboard systems, professional grade equipment, and proven Ferretti Group engineering for effortless operation and peace of mind. Highlights underscore her pedigree and capability: two MTU 16V2000 2638 hp engines showing 1700 hours; two 70 kW Kohler generators at 3500 hours; an on deck master within a five stateroom arrangement; hydraulic bow and stern thrusters; a beach club; a 7' 2" draft; a Jacuzzi; accommodations for

twelve; a passerelle; a tropical air conditioning package; a waste treatment system; twenty two all new underwater lights; zero speed fins paired with three factory installed Seakeepers; ASEA shore power frequency converters enabling true global operation; and RINA commercial registration with no charter restrictions. Recent care is exemplary, including yard periods in July 2024 and August 2025, a 2024 hull and topsides repaint with DuPont coatings backed by a transferable warranty, and completion of the RINA five year commercial class survey in 2023. The result is a rare opportunity to acquire a pedigree Custom Line 120' with enduring style, outstanding comfort, and the versatility to serve impeccably as a private yacht or a top tier charter platform. Additional descriptions

At the helm, four 24 inch displays integrate Furuno, onboard cameras, TimeZero, and FLIR, complemented by two additional 24 inch screens dedicated to Naviop and MTU controls. The suite includes Furuno NavNet TZtouch first generation, ABT Trac zero speed control, three Seakeeper 16 control heads, a Simrad autopilot, MTU engine controls, two Sailor VHF radios, a Furuno BNWAS, the main breaker panel, a captain's lounge area, and bow and stern thruster controls, with FLIR thermal vision enhancing night navigation. Aft, the transom transforms into a beach club with tender launch capability and a garage sized for a Sea Doo Spark and a 565 Diesel Turbo JetTender; the tender does not convey with the sale. A diesel fill station is intelligently positioned for swift watersports turnarounds. The aft deck offers U shaped floating style lounge seating around a pine table, augmented by three foldable chairs to create seating for ten. A hydraulic retractable salon door dissolves the boundary between interior and exterior, while an additional lounge area invites easy conversation at anchor or underway. Forward, two large sunpads dominate the bow, paired with a forward U shaped settee and

two teak tables. Substantial ground tackle, a secure bow railing, a bosun's locker, an integrated audio system, and a teak sole complete a foredeck arranged for both sunlit afternoons and elegant sundowners. The bridge deck becomes the heartbeat of alfresco life, with a Jacuzzi, three lounge chairs, and an aft bridge staircase flowing to a teak table that comfortably seats ten. L shaped lounge seating faces a well equipped wet bar with refrigerator, ice maker, electric grill, sink, and two stainless barstools. An upper helm station with full controls sits beneath the hardtop, all set on a teak sole for enduring beauty and grip. The galley is designed for professional service and family ease alike, featuring an additional freezer and refrigerator, a full size Siemens refrigerator, a Miele microwave and conventional oven, a Miele five burner cooktop with extractor, a Miele dishwasher, granite countertops, a double sink, a trash compactor, abundant cabinetry, and a large window that floods the workspace with light. In the salon, electric curtains dress every window, and a privacy curtain can separate the formal dining area when desired. An elegant L shaped sofa, coffee table, and a lounge chair face a drop down 55 inch Samsung TV, with a discreet refrigerator at hand. Polk Audio surround sound, pervasive LED lighting, and hardwood floors create a warm, contemporary atmosphere. The formal dining area centers on a quartz table with seating for ten, supported by dedicated dining storage. Christofle china and silverware for ten, plus Christofle champagne, wine, and cocktail stemware, set the tone for sophisticated evenings, enhanced by LED lighting and hardwood flooring. A gracious foyer with a sliding glass door leads to the lower staterooms, the AV room, a day head, and a crew entry, managing circulation with quiet efficiency. The on deck master suite exudes sanctuary calm, with a makeup station, a walk in closet with safe and pull out drawers, two lounge chairs and a cocktail table, and a king size bed laid over soft carpet. A 55 inch Samsung TV serves as the entertainment focal point. Large port and starboard windows, with privacy and blackout curtains, bring the horizon in, while dimmable LED lighting and extensive storage underscore the suite's considered luxury. The

master ensuite features a centerline walk in shower with marble walls and floor, a rain shower head and hand wand, dual his and hers sinks with mirrored cabinetry above and storage below, and his and hers toilets with bidet. Large windows with a porthole, window blinds, and a private door maintain discretion, while dimmable LED lighting, skylights above each sink, a full size linen cabinet, and dedicated A/C control complete the space. VIP staterooms two and three each present a king bed, comprehensive cabinet storage, a makeup station, hanging closets, a safe, mirrors, carpet underfoot, and two nightstands. Large hull windows with two opening portholes invite sea air, with blackout and privacy curtains when desired. Dimmable LED lighting, surround sound, a 55 inch TV on a high/low lift, and individual A/C controls deliver a bespoke guest experience. Their ensuites offer a centerline sink with mirrored cabinet above and storage below, a marble lined walk in shower with rain head, handheld wand, and a large window with porthole and privacy blinds, plus a toilet and bidet behind a privacy door, all softly lit by dimmable LEDs. Staterooms four and five are thoughtfully arranged bunk rooms with side by side berths and a Pullman, a nightstand, a large window with porthole and privacy and blackout curtains, surround sound speakers for TV and radio, a hanging closet, dimmable LED lighting, a 43 inch TV, carpet underfoot, and individual A/C controls. Their private ensuites mirror the yacht's elevated standard, each with a center sink and mirrored cabinetry, a marble walk in shower with rain head and wand, a toilet and bidet, a large window with porthole and privacy blinds, and dimmable LED lighting. A dedicated laundry room houses a full size Miele washer and dryer, a sink, and cabinetry, streamlining service. The crew area comprises four cabins sleeping a total of six to seven, a comfortable crew lounge, a deep freezer below the sole, and a full size Miele washer and dryer—optimizing autonomy on long passages. The mechanical space attests to engineering depth: two MTU M96L engines rated at 2638 hp at 2450 rpm with 1700 hours; two Kohler 70 kW generators, port 3500 hours and starboard 3500 hours; a utility workstation; two Idromar

watermakers; four Dometic chillers, one brand new, delivering 280,000 total BTU; the main breaker panel; an ASEA shore power converter accepting a single three phase 480 V feed or two 220 V cords; a 120 V converter; three Seakeeper 16 units; an oil exchange pump; and a Clean A Hull system connected to all through hulls, with a watertight double door bulkhead to the tender garage. Exclusions are straightforward: upon a buyer's request, the owner's exclusion list will be provided. The Williams 565 Turbo JetTender does not convey. 
