OVERVIEW

Presenting SMOOTH OPERATOR, a 39m Jongert planing superyacht whose sculpted silhouette and assured bearing declare speed and refinement in equal measure. This luxury motor yacht unites Jongert's revered Dutch craftsmanship and design heritage with an energetic performance ethos, creating a vessel tailored for the discerning owner who prizes effortless circulation, considered amenities, and an ambience of quiet sophistication. The result is a performance yacht that carries true superyacht poise.

Built to the RINA LY2 commercial code, SMOOTH OPERATOR achieves a rare equilibrium of pace, polish, and timeless style, earning its place among the most compelling flybridge yachts in her class. The full-beam owner's suite is a tranquil haven, centered around an elegant bath beneath an electrically operated skylight that dims at the touch of a button, while the stateroom provides direct access to a private gym and a steam room discreetly housed in the forepeak for a spa-like retreat aboard.

The semi-sheltered flybridge invites conviviality with a full-service bar, a plush lounge and a generous sun deck, all illuminated by a glass-inset dodger roof that floods the space with natural light while discreet blinds offer shade when required. A voluminous garage accommodates a 4.5-meter tender for effortless coastal exploration and smooth shore transfers, and a carefully selected complement of watersports equipment — including jet skis and inflatable towables — promises spirited days on the water, embodying the yacht's promise of unforgettable seagoing adventures.




















DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Key features

Fresh from her five-year Rina inspection, completed in November 2024 with shafts pulled, this yacht fuses exhilarating performance with exceptional composure to deliver a smooth, quiet ride and a verified top speed of 26.4 kn. A generous, family-friendly layout offers five staterooms for twelve guests, balancing privacy and effortless flow for life on board, while long-range ambitions are underpinned by a large fuel tank so capacious you may only need to refuel twice in a season. Everyday comfort, entertainment and security have been elevated with new TVs, SONOS audio throughout and a new camera system, ensuring every passage is as enjoyable as it is assured.

Galley & laundry equipment

Designed for serious cruising and effortless hosting, the galley is equipped with a Gaggenau ninety-centimetre oven paired with a Gaggenau dishwasher and efficient extractor fans, while cold storage is secured by a Frigomar fridge and a Vitrifrigo fridge in the salon, complemented by a WAECO wine cooler that maintains perfect service temperatures. Shipboard care is equally refined with a Miele washing machine and a Siemens Ironing 4 burn, keeping wardrobes immaculate on every passage.

Communication & navigation

A professional-grade bridge integrates two Transas Navi 4000 workstations, two Furuno radars and two Sailor VHF radios, complemented by Inmarsat Mini C for reliable satellite messaging. Position and depth data are assured by two Furuno GP32 GPS units and two echo sounders, while situational awareness is

enhanced with a Furuno FA150 AIS, Furuno BR510 BNWAS and Furuno FI-50 wind instruments. Precision steering is delivered via a Sperry Marine Navigat x MK2 gyrocompass and a Sperry Marine Navipilot 4000 autopilot with wheel and tiller control, offering both NFU and FU modes for exacting helmsmanship.

Entertainment

Life on board is elevated by new TVs and immersive new SONOS audio throughout, complemented by new cameras that add security and peace of mind, and for seamless downtime every cabin is equipped with a SKY decoder so favourite channels and movies are available in each private retreat.

Tender & watertoys

Adventures unfold with a Castoldi jet tender powered by a one hundred and fifty horsepower Yanmar diesel for swift, dry transfers, and a Sea Doo jetski driven by a two hundred and sixty horsepower Rotax engine for thrilling sprints across open water. At anchor a welcoming beach pool expands your private terrace at sea, creating a safe, salt-free playground for all ages.

Accommodation

Thoughtfully arranged for flexible family cruising, the yacht offers five staterooms for twelve guests, including a full-beam owner's cabin that bathes in natural light. The guest quarters span VIP cabins with king-size beds and additional VIP cabins with French-size beds, while versatile twin cabins combine a double bed with a convenient Pullman berth. Crew are comfortably housed in two cabins, all ensuite, accommodating five members for discreet, round-the-clock service.

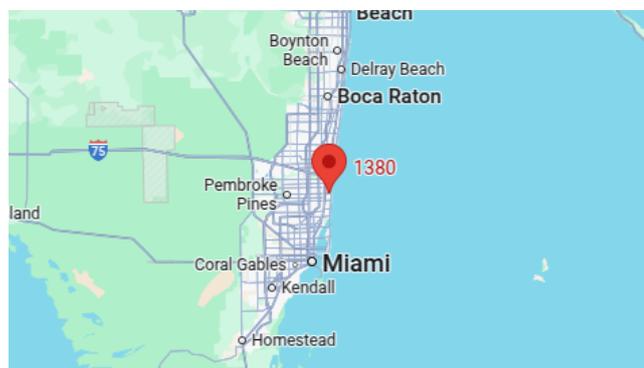
