OVERVIEW

Acciaio 130 is the third hull in Cantiere delle Marche's sophisticated semi custom series, following the celebrated Acciaio 105 Gatto and Acciaio 123 Astrum. Born from the same proven naval platform as the RJ 130—whose polar expedition reached the 88th parallel—this full displacement explorer motor yacht carries an unmistakable expedition lineage while offering contemporary superyacht refinement.

Her profile announces bluewater capability with a commanding flared bow and a long, unbroken sheer that flows elegantly from fore to aft, producing a poised, modern tri deck silhouette. Sculpted fashion plates sweep down from the crown of the superstructure to the main, upper, and sun decks, artfully framing the yacht's signature glazing so that curves and light play across her surfaces, reinforcing both a luxurious presence and the intent for long range passage making.

At 415 GT she stands among the most voluminous yachts of her size, and inside Giorgio Cassetta's award winning interiors marry warmth, tactile materials, and contemporary Italian sensibility to create living spaces tuned for an ocean going lifestyle. The partially enclosed sun deck houses a third salon, a tranquil observatory ideal for wildlife viewing in cooler latitudes or an intimate retreat for private gatherings at the vessel's highest vantage, heightening the tri deck superyacht experience.

Aft, a full beam staircase cascades from the main deck cockpit to the swim platform, composing a layered social arena that is equally gracious at anchor. The beach club theme continues below into the lazarette where a Finnish sauna elevates post adventure relaxation, combining expedition spirit with resort style amenities. Accommodation is thoughtfully arranged for up to 12 guests across five cabins, including a generous on deck owner's suite, while two Pullman berths extend flexible sleeping configurations for families or

charter use. A professional crew of seven moves discreetly through dedicated internal stairways linking lower and upper decks, preserving privacy and seamless service.

Measured at 39.42 m (130 ft) overall with an 8 m (26'2") beam and a shallow 2.4 m (7'8") draft suited to Bahamas and Caribbean cruising, Acciaio 130 displaces roughly 388 tons and is optimized for efficiency. Her robust steel hull, complemented by a bulbous bow, reduces resistance and fuel consumption to favor true long range oceangoing capability. Twin MAN engines rated at 749 kW apiece provide a 13.5 knot top speed while an economical 10 knot cruise unlocks a range in excess of 5,000 nautical miles, a combination that delivers autonomy, comfort, and the confidence required of a serious bluewater cruiser.

This vessel blends expedition purpose with semi custom luxury, a tri deck full displacement motor yacht that reads as both purposeful and elegant at sea — explorer yacht, expedition yacht, full displacement motor yacht, tri deck superyacht, luxury yacht, long range cruiser, steel hull, ocean going, semi custom.





DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Description

The Acciaio 130 is a 39.4 metre explorer yacht built by Cantiere delle Marche (CDM), the Ancona based shipyard renowned for crafting robust, ocean going vessels that fuse Italian design flair with engineering excellence. Following the acclaimed Acciaio 105 and Acciaio 123, it evolves the same proven platform that has ventured as far as the eighty eighth parallel in the Arctic, a compelling testament to authentic explorer pedigree. Exterior design by HydroTec presents an imposing flared bow and elegant, flowing lines that communicate strength and sophistication in perfect balance, and with a gross tonnage of 415 GT she offers one of the most voluminous interiors in her class, delivering the impression of a far larger yacht while remaining remarkably efficient. Twin MAN engines rated at 749 kW each drive her to a top speed of 13.5 knots, with an ocean spanning range of 5,000 nautical miles at 10 knots, marrying steady long distance capability with comfortable cruising pace. Interiors by Giorgio Cassetta distill the essence of timeless Italian luxury: warm tones, natural textures and generous glazing create a refined ambience for total relaxation, and accommodation is configured for twelve guests across five staterooms, including a full beam owner's suite on the main deck, two double cabins and two twin cabins with Pullman beds. A crew of seven is housed in three separate cabins with independent access routes to ensure seamless service with complete discretion. Among the yacht's signature spaces, the partially enclosed sun deck is conceived as a third salon and sky lounge — a panoramic haven that becomes a serene observation area in cooler latitudes or a private retreat for entertaining beneath the stars — while a tiered stern beach club cascades over multiple levels, united by a full beam staircase that flows from the main deck cockpit down to the hydraulic Opacmare platform, which serves

both as a swim platform and as a launch system for tenders and water toys. The beach club experience is elevated by a Finnish sauna and skylights that softly illuminate the spaces below deck, and outdoor living is enriched with a bar featuring a grill and an ice maker, teak finished dining tables and convertible seating that adapts effortlessly to every mood, from languid afternoons at anchor to elegant dinners by the sea. Onboard systems are engineered for comfort and autonomy: two CAT generators of 80 kW each, zero speed electric stabilizers, a bow thruster, a watermaker, comprehensive air conditioning and heating and Wi-Fi prewiring make life on board smooth and effortless, while the professional standard galley is appointed with an induction cooktop, oven, refrigerator, freezer, dishwasher and microwave, and a dedicated laundry provides washer and dryer units for extended cruising. Blending the steadfastness of a steel expedition vessel with the elegance and refinement expected of an Italian luxury yacht, the Acciaio 130 is conceived for owners who wish to explore the world in absolute comfort — whether crossing oceans or slipping into secluded bays of the Mediterranean.
