The Ocean King Explorer 130 is an expedition superyacht that marries tough, seaworthy engineering with supreme onboard luxury, an elegant option for the most discerning owners seeking true bluewater capability. At 40.26 meters overall, she rides on a robust steel hull engineered for long-range voyaging and built to CE (A) classification, assuring strength, safety and dependable performance on extended ocean passages. Accommodating up to 12 guests across six well-proportioned suites, the Explorer 130 offers generous living volumes and meticulously considered cabins designed to deliver restorative comfort after a day at sea. With a 3.30 meter draft and a maximum speed of 14 kn, this motor yacht balances unhurried cruising efficiency with the capability to undertake ambitious expeditions across varied conditions. Expansive exterior decks provide graceful spaces for relaxation and entertaining, while interiors—finished with refined materials and contemporary amenities—create an atmosphere of understated elegance and seamless comfort throughout. DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Technical details

Built by Ocean King, the Explorer 130 is a full displacement yacht featuring a pronounced bow bulb, a robust steel hull and an aluminum superstructure. She extends 40.26 m/132 ft overall with a waterline length of 36.33 m/119.1 ft, a maximum beam of 10.20 m/33.4 ft and a draught at half load of 3.30 m/10.8 ft. Displacement measures 650 t at half load and 728 t at full load, while accommodation is configured for twelve guests across six staterooms and for nine crew in five cabins, and the vessel registers a gross tonnage of less than 500 gt.

The Explorer 130 is driven by two CAT C32 Acer V12 RAT.A engines, each delivering 970 kW/1320 Cv at 2,100 rpm at 100/MCR and coupled through Reintjes WAF 484 gearboxes. Propulsion is by direct shaft line with two Vulkan ProFlex flexible couplings turning a NiBrAl class "S" five blade propeller engineered for optimal comfort and efficiency; shafts are AISI 630 with a Ø 120 mm diameter and the rudders are formed from AISI 316 stainless steel. Performance figures include a maximum speed of 14 knots, a cruising speed of 12 knots and an economical speed of 10 knots, yielding a maximum range at economical speed of 16,800 nm. Onboard electrical power is supplied by two 118 kW gensets @ 50 Hz 400V plus one 65 kW genset @ 50 Hz 400V, with air conditioning capacity rated at 240,000 btu/h. Tankage is generous, comprising 194,000 liters/51,254 gallons of fuel, 21,000 liters/5,548 gallons of fresh water, 18,000 liters/4,755 gallons for black/grey water, 2,200 liters/581 gallons for lube oil, 2,200 liters/581 gallons for dirty oil lube, 2,200 liters/581 gallons for bilge and a 1,000 liters/264 gallons overflow tank. The yacht is able to carry a tender up to 8.5 m/27.8 ft in length.

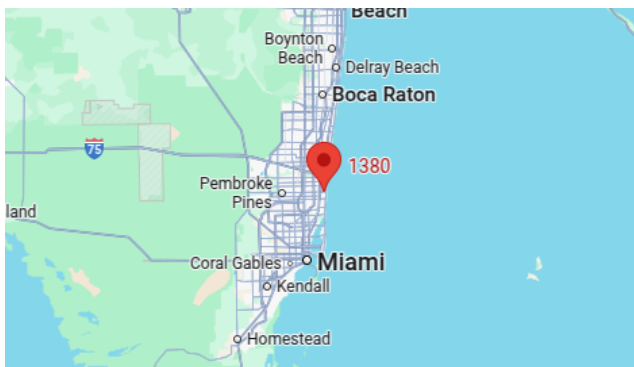
