The 131' Sunseeker MARIN is a commanding, performance-focused superyacht that pairs sporty exterior lines with refined contemporary luxury. Launched in 2014, she offers extensive outdoor living areas including a flybridge sun deck with a spa pool, multiple al fresco dining options and a series of inviting lounge spaces designed for both entertaining and quiet relaxation. Below deck, satin-finish walnut joinery and a modern interior palette create a warm, elegant atmosphere that flows through the spacious salon and skylounge. Comfortably accommodating up to 10 guests across five beautifully appointed staterooms, MARIN delivers both seakeeping capability and a genuine blue-water cruising experience from her Fort Lauderdale base. 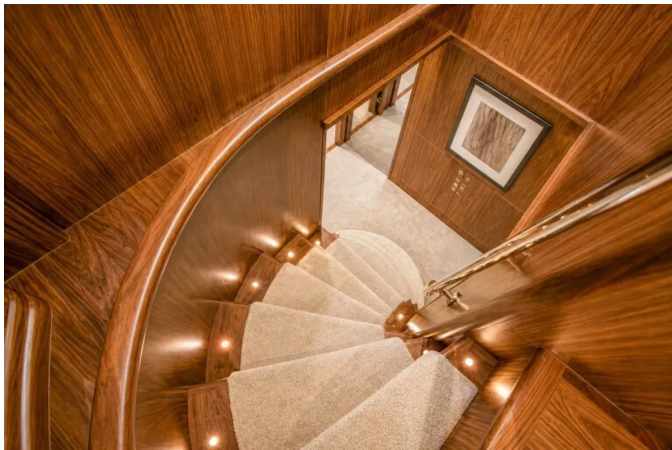






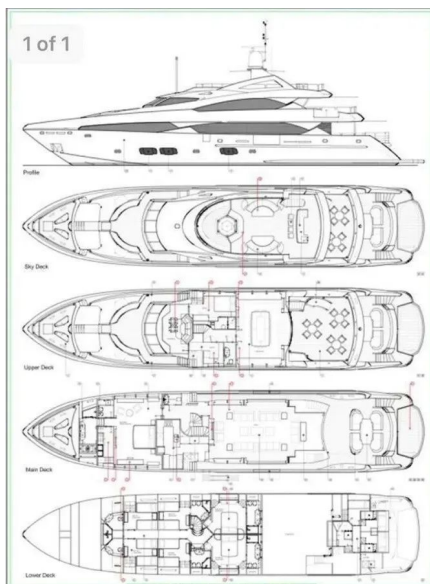


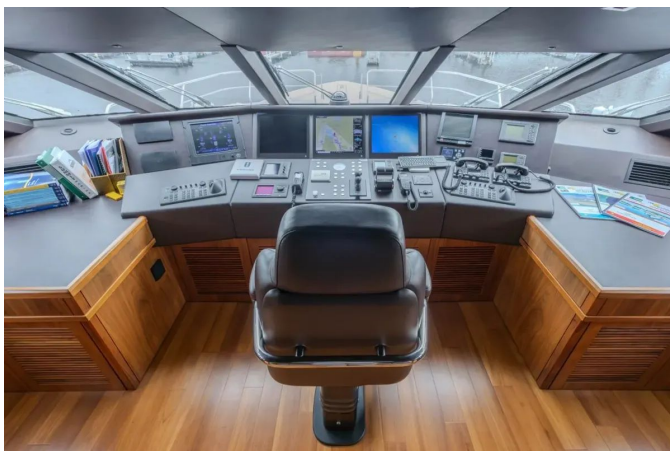












DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Accommodations

Configured to welcome up to twelve guests across five staterooms, Marin pairs generous interior volume with sophisticated finishes. The full-beam master suite on the main deck creates a tranquil private sanctuary, appointed with a chaise lounge, a large television, a dressing table and plentiful built-in storage. Its expansive en suite bathroom is fitted with double vanities, a rainfall shower and a separate toilet room for added convenience.

Beneath the main deck are four further guest cabins carefully arranged for comfort and flexibility. Two mirrored VIP staterooms each feature queen-size beds, walk-in closets, dressing tables and en suite bathrooms complete with dual vanities and rainfall showers. The remaining two guest cabins are highly adaptable and can accommodate up to three guests apiece, each offering two single berths that convert into a queen plus a Pullman berth for an additional guest; both include a television and an en suite bathroom with a rainfall shower.

This versatile layout therefore provides a full-beam primary suite with en suite bath, three generous VIP/double guest cabins and one twin guest stateroom. Crew accommodation is provided for up to seven, with segregated crew and guest circulation routes to preserve privacy and ensure discreet, professional service throughout the yacht.

Salon and galley

Sunseeker's in-house contemporary design sets a sophisticated tone throughout, with satin walnut joinery accentuating the generous proportions of the main salon. Floor-to-ceiling panoramic windows on both sides bathe the

interior in natural light and uninterrupted sea views, while comfortable lounge seating encourages relaxation and conversation. A large hideaway television is neatly integrated into the styling for discreet entertainment, and the interior plan is arranged to provide a seamless connection between indoor and outdoor social zones. The resulting atmosphere is warm and refined, perfectly suited to extended cruising or elegant entertaining and deliberately configured to support high-end onboard events.

Forward of the main salon, a formal dining space is laid out to seat up to twelve guests, marrying refined aesthetics with practical circulation. The arrangement facilitates efficient crew movement while maintaining guest privacy, making it equally appropriate for private ownership or charter use.

The galley is appointed to professional standards with Miele appliances delivering dependable performance and efficiency. Extensive cold storage runs along one wall in the form of multiple refrigerators and freezers to keep provisions well organized and readily accessible, while large windows above the sink ensure the workspace remains bright. A dedicated butler's pantry expands preparation capacity and incorporates a dumbwaiter to enable smooth, discreet service.

The sky lounge provides an inviting retreat with a generous U-shaped seating configuration, an additional television and abundant storage. A secondary dining area, relaxed in character yet perfectly capable of hosting formal meals, is sited nearby alongside a convenient day head fitted with an integrated shower. For effortless entertaining the space also includes a wine fridge and further refrigeration, enhancing the yacht's ability to stage refined, memorable gatherings.

Electrical and mechanical

The helm is a refined command center, centered on a substantial captain's chair with an adjacent companion bench so guests remain part of the

experience while underway. A bank of screens dedicated to engine monitoring, navigation information and radar surrounds the helm, and ergonomically placed controls—including an integrated autopilot and powerful bow thrusters—ensure composed handling in tight quarters. Immediately aft of the bridge, the captain's cabin provides a private, highly functional refuge complete with its own en suite.

Marin attains a maximum speed of 24 knots and finds an efficient cruise at 19 knots, while a 23,500-litre fuel tank configuration allows for a 1,500 nautical mile range at 12 knots. Her semi-displacement hull has been carefully engineered to combine generous interior volume with spirited performance, and she will transition into planing-hull behavior when conditions call for it.

Propulsion comes from twin MTU 12V 4000 M93 diesel engines, each developing 3,180 hp within a robust diesel-driven system. Both the port and starboard engines show more than three thousand engine hours, reflecting a hard-working yet well-maintained MTU platform prepared for real-world operation. Built to superyacht standards, the entire engineering package is optimised for long-range cruising, with efficient, thoughtfully integrated systems intended for extended passages.

Capacities have been specified for serious autonomy, with a total fuel capacity of 23,560 litres and fresh water capacity of 4,950 litres, a complement that sits comfortably alongside her performance and range credentials.

Deck and exterior

Conceived for effortless outdoor living, Marin presents an expansive sun deck centered around a spa pool and jacuzzi, complemented by multiple alfresco dining settings and abundant lounge and sunbathing areas. The entire deck layout is arranged with entertaining in mind, facilitating easy circulation across well-appointed terraces that encourage long, leisurely days at sea.

Aft, the yacht's social nucleus offers a fluid transition between interior and exterior living, with relaxed seating areas that serve equally well for intimate family moments or spirited gatherings, making the layout perfectly suited to private use or charter service. A hydraulic swim platform and a dedicated tender garage simplify access to the water and the deployment of toys, while a circular table on the aft deck and casual bean bag seating provide a versatile and welcoming arrangement.

On the bridge deck, two teak tables and a sectional sofa occupy a sheltered space beneath a partial awning, where a television and an ice maker enhance open air dining and lounging. The uppermost sun deck furthers the sense of indulgence with a sectional sofa, a generous teak dining table, a sun pad and a jacuzzi, all supported by entertainment and service amenities including a TV, two grills, a refrigerator and ice makers to ensure effortless hospitality. Track Vision Systems and satellite TV are mounted to the mast, keeping guests connected and entertained whether underway or at anchor.

Marin's exterior lines are refined by a raked bow that improves both performance and aesthetic presence. The decks are finished in premium teak for lasting resilience and a classic nautical character, while the yacht's striking profile is defined by a sleek black hull set against a white superstructure. The black finish continues below the waterline and the boot top is likewise black, reinforcing a cohesive and sophisticated design language.

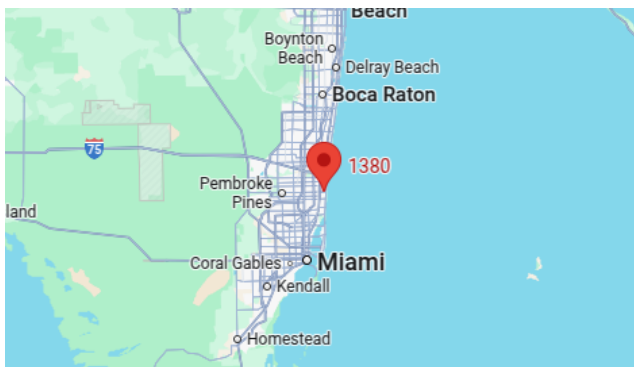
