OVERVIEW

MARLINDA is a distinguished 132-foot Northwest luxury motor yacht built by the renowned Delta Marine yard in Seattle, where superyacht pedigree meets time-honored regional craftsmanship. Carefully maintained to an exceptional standard and thoughtfully modernized through a succession of upgrades and refits, she embodies more than twenty years of devoted stewardship by her current owner. Stored in freshwater on Lake Union for over a decade during off-seasons, she has benefited from that gentler environment, and her current home slip—paid through October—may be transferred to her next owner if desired.

Designed for serene, private cruising rather than large charter affairs, MARLINDA's interior is a study in classic American workmanship, richly appointed in mahogany with meticulous joinery throughout. Boarding from the main deck aft, guests are welcomed into an elegant salon featuring a portside bar ideal for refined entertaining. Forward, a formal dining area opens directly to a spacious, professionally appointed galley to port, while to starboard a day head accompanies a generous library that can readily be converted to an on-deck owner's suite if preferred. Belowdecks, accommodations comprise three well-proportioned guest staterooms and a full-beam master amidships, creating a harmonious balance of comfort and privacy suited to private ownership.

Underway she is powered by reliable CAT engines and fitted with Naiad fin stabilizers, a combination that delivers passagemaker capability and expedition yacht poise, with a long-range endurance exceeding 4,000 nautical miles and excellent seakeeping and comfort underway. The fully enclosed, climate-controlled California deck invites year-round enjoyment, while the expansive aft cockpit supports fishing, relaxed cruising, and active time on the water. The wheelhouse is bright and welcoming with superb sightlines, a

dedicated day head, and an adjacent sky lounge that encourages guests to share the navigation experience. On the boat deck, twin port and starboard davits—each rated at 4,500 pounds—enable effortless handling of tenders up to 26 feet, underscoring her practical superyacht utility.

Offered turnkey, LLC-owned, and to be delivered with full fuel, MARLINDA is ready now for extended cruising, including an Alaskan season. For those seeking a proven, well-regarded motor yacht with deep Northwest heritage that combines luxury elegance, superyacht build quality, and genuine long-range capability, MARLINDA presents a rare opportunity.

DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Flybridge

From sunrise to starlight, the flybridge serves as both command lounge and social hub, where every detail supports effortless entertaining and confident handling; provisions stay perfectly chilled in the Uline Refer while a Coyote BBQ with two propane tanks elevates every open air meal, and service remains seamless with a sink offering hot and cold taps plus an additional hot tap beneath the sink. Control is intuitive and redundantly arranged at dual docking stations fitted with Kobelt controls, RAI, horn, bowthruster, Comnav201 rudder controls and VHF, while the primary helm delivers total situational awareness through a 19" Green Marine display, Kahlenburg horn controls, Ham/Jet RAI, searchlight controls, two B&G H3000 units, thruster controls, Kobelt interfaces, ComNav211 rudder and autopilot controls and Naiad Multisea II systems.

Lazarette

In the lazarette, water quality and operational reliability are elevated by a SpotZero Reverse Osmosis System SZ3000, a new automated system installed in 2/2022, powered through dedicated circuits that simplify on board workflows with two 30 amp receptacles provided for tender power and two 100 amp receptacles for shorepower intake, while an additional SpotZero Reverse Osmosis System SZ3000 aboard reinforces purposeful redundancy for confident, long range cruising.

Tender

The tender suite is mission ready and designed for speed, comfort and

versatility, centered on a Novurania MX460TLR propelled by a Yamaha 90HJP for swift, dry and capable transfers, and complemented by two Kestrel 170T double kayaks that invite quiet exploration of hidden coves and glassy dawns.

Safety

Safety at sea is comprehensively addressed with two ACR RLB-37 EPIRBs ready for rapid deployment, two REVERE ELITE six man container units with service due in 5/2028 and seven REVERE OFFSHORE six man soft pack units with service due in 5/2028, delivering layered, professional readiness for offshore passages and peace of mind for extended voyages.
