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OVERVIEW

Built in aluminum by Italy's renowned Baglietto and penned by Tommaso Spadolini, the luxury motor yacht M/Y AQUILA was delivered in 2004 to fashion icon Roberto Cavalli and has benefited from extensive refits in 2020 and again in 2023–2024. The Italian-crafted performance yacht accommodates up to ten guests across five cabins: a full-beam owner's suite complete with walk-in wardrobes and an en suite bathroom; two lower-deck VIP staterooms, each featuring a walk-in wardrobe and en suite bathroom; a twin cabin with its own en suite shower room; and a double cabin with a private en suite. Her interiors revolve around a full-beam main saloon that marries a refined lounge with formal dining, while the generous foredeck provides an inviting sunbathing expanse. The upper deck houses a dedicated cinema room, and the flybridge is arranged for alfresco dining for twelve around a convivial bar, perfect for entertaining. Propelled by twin 3,700 hp MTU diesel engines, AQUILA achieves 26 knots, and zero-speed stabilisers ensure exceptional comfort both underway and at anchor for effortless bluewater cruising.


















DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Machinery

The yacht's propulsion is anchored by robust ZF 7550 NR gearboxes driving KAMEWA stainless-steel shafts and KAMEWA propellers to deliver smooth, efficient thrust under way; shipboard electrical power is provided by two Kohler 80 kW main generators, with autonomy and battery management handled by Mastervolt batteries and chargers. Endurance and operational planning are simplified by clearly stated consumptions of 500 L/hr at 13.5 knots and 1000 L/hr at 21 knots, while freshwater independence is assured by two Idromar International Model MC10 Puplex watermakers, giving long-range comfort and self-sufficiency.

Ancillary equipment

Precision maneuvering is delivered by KAMEWA jets for both propulsion and steering, with ABT TRAC "Zero Speed" stabilizers ensuring comfort at anchor and underway; Rolls Royce KAMEWA rudder angle indicators supply exact helm feedback, and close-quarters handling is aided by an AMERCIAN Electric bow thruster. Fuel hygiene is maintained with Racors filtration and an Alfa Laval fuel oil separator, while heavy-duty Gianneschi ACM502BT pumps rated at six Bars perform bilge and fire duties. Domestic hot water is produced by two Boiler 400 Verticale inox 400 L units, black water is processed through a Hamann AG sewage treatment plant feeding Tema electric WCs, and climate control is provided by CLION Marine air conditioning with comprehensive Gianneschi ventilation throughout the vessel.

Safety & security equipment

Safety equipment is comprehensive and commercially specified: four life rafts each rated for twenty-five persons, four life rings, McMurdo EPIRBs and eighteen flares ensure offshore distress capability, while medical readiness is covered by a Med-Air provision including a full MCA medical kit. Fire protection combines a CO2 system with thirty-seven portable fire extinguishers distributed for rapid response, and vessel security is provided by an IP CCTV system with two screens and five cameras for continuous monitoring.

Communication equipment

Global and local communications are comprehensively specified with Furuno Sat C SATCOM and Starlink SAT internet for worldwide connectivity, supported by cellular redundancy via two Pepwave units. The onboard radio suite includes two Furuno FS2575-C VHF radiotelephones, dedicated FURUNO watchkeeping and receiver units, and a PABX Panasonic telephone and intercom system to manage internal and external communications with professional reliability.

Navigation equipment

The bridge suite is arranged for precise, redundant navigation: a C-Plath magnetic compass and a Sperry Navigat X MK2 gyro compass work in tandem with a Sperry Navipilot 4000 automatic pilot and a Sperry Navinot III log, while situational awareness is delivered by Furuno Navnet echo sounding and radar systems and TimeZero chart plotting for integrated voyage planning. Positioning and advisory systems include two Furuno GP 39 GPS units, a Furuno NX 700 NAVTEX, Thrane & Thrane GMDSS, B7G wind instruments and a Furuno FA150 AIS to ensure reliable positional data and meteorological

inputs for confident passage-making.

Deck equipment

Deck operations are supported by a Maxwell 4000 anchor windlass system handling the primary ground tackle with two 140 m anchor chains, while Maxwell 2000 warping capstans aft assist mooring and manoeuvring; tender launch and recovery are managed by Nautical Structure boat crane and davits, and night and search duties are covered by two high output searchlights for extended visibility.

Audio/visual systems

Entertainment aboard is designed for immersive enjoyment with projector screens in the main salon and main deck dining, while aft main deck speakers are integrated into the central entertainment system to deliver distributed audio. A dedicated cinema features an eighty six inch Samsung display, the sun deck is appointed with a fifty six inch Samsung, the owner's cabin presents a sixty six inch Samsung, the VIP cabin a forty six inch Samsung, all guest cabins are fitted with forty two inch Samsung displays, and the crew mess also benefits from a forty two inch Samsung, creating a consistent high quality media experience throughout.

Office equipment

A dedicated onboard office is equipped with a PC with internet access to support administrative and operational needs, an independent PC dedicated to the CCTV circuit for security monitoring, and an HP fax/photocopie unit to streamline correspondence and document handling while underway.

Domestic equipment

The main galley features professional Miele cooking equipment paired with Miele refrigeration and freezer capacity, supported by two dishwashers and one ice machine to sustain service at full guest capacity. The laundry is fully outfitted with two Miele washing machines, two Miele dryers and a Miele iron, while the pantry provisions include two fridges, an ice machine and a coffee machine; the bridge deck pantry also includes a fridge and coffee machine, and an additional ice machine serves the crew mess to ensure culinary and housekeeping efficiency across all service areas.

Other

Leisure and wellbeing amenities include a foredeck Jacuzzi for relaxed sunlit gatherings, secure ship's safes allocated for both Captain and Master, a comprehensively equipped gym with free weights and bench for on board fitness, and a swimming pool that elevates the yacht's recreational offering for guests seeking both activity and relaxation.

Tender and toys

The tender and toys inventory is substantial and carefully curated: a thirty seven foot Axopar tender powered by two 350 hp Mercury outboards offers versatile dayboat performance, accompanied by a crew tender and rescue Novurania RIB of 4.2 m SOLAS specification (2008 model) with a fifteen hp Yamaha outboard. Personal watercraft and boards include a Sea Doo GP 230 two seater, a Seadoo Rotax two seater, a Jetsurf Factory GP100 2018 and a Jetsurf Race 2018, together with three SeaBob F5 units for underwater exploration. Additional watersports equipment comprises a Flyboard 18M X Armor, two stand up paddle boards, three inflatable Seabob docks, two

liferafts, one trampoline, dive equipment, water skis, a wakeboard, a banana and tow tubes, delivering a complete program of on water fun.

Refit

A comprehensive modernization program has reinforced the yacht's pedigree: the previous owner completed a full exterior paint in 2021–2022 and a full interior refit in 2021–2022, including laying a new teak deck on all decks in 2021–2022 with a twenty year specification; a W5 major overhaul of the main engines was performed at four thousand hours and completed in December 2023, generators were replaced new in 2022 and services remain current, a new AC plant was installed in September 2024, and the RINA class survey was concluded in January 2024 following the major refit period. During 2023–2024 the program continued with a full rebuild of main engine and generator exhausts; all tanks were cleaned and restorations performed as necessary, various pipe works were completed, and all through hull valves were removed for service or replacement. The passerelle was removed and overhauled, as was the swim ladder; paint touch ups and repairs were executed, accompanied by a ten year KaMeWa jets overhaul including shafts and main bearing seals. The Alfa Laval unit was overhauled, all pumps were serviced or replaced as required, the watermakers were fully overhauled, all windlasses and capstans were removed and overhauled, and the stabilizers were serviced. Tender and toys were also addressed as part of this extensive program.


