This opulent vessel was delivered to a discerning owner in 1992 and underwent an extensive refit in 2017, ensuring it upholds the highest standards of luxury and comfort. With accommodations for up to 10 guests across 5 elegantly designed staterooms, it also offers quarters for 8 crew members in 4 thoughtfully arranged cabins. For those considering yacht purchases in the current boat location, this presents an extraordinary chance to own a yacht that embodies sophistication and elegance.



DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Section name

Never Enough offers a rare chance to own one of the most renowned Feadships to grace the waters of South Florida. Initially launched as Gallant Lady, this yacht was crafted for a loyal Feadship client whose high standards were fully realized in this vessel. The yacht's luxurious charm is highlighted by meticulous attention to detail, featuring premium materials like mahogany woodwork and marble finishes.

In 2017, the yacht underwent a significant refit, which included the installation of new C32A Caterpillar engines, new generators, a fresh paint job, and extensions to both the aft deck and swim platform. Furthermore, a new A/C chiller, updated electronics, and new teak were added, ensuring the yacht is outfitted with the latest in technology and comfort. The interior saw a complete refresh of all soft goods in December 2022, further enhancing its elegance and comfort.

The yacht boasts five staterooms, providing lavish accommodation for up to ten guests. The Owner's stateroom spans the full beam on the main deck and features a king-size bed along with his and hers ensuite bathrooms. Below deck, four spacious guest staterooms include two with queen beds and two with twin beds. Each stateroom is well-appointed with generous closet space, ensuite bathrooms, and entertainment systems, guaranteeing a luxurious stay for all guests.

Walkthrough

Stepping aboard the yacht from the forward starboard side brings you to the formal foyer entrance of the main salon. Yet, the favored entry is through the

boarding gates on either side of the expansive covered aft deck. This area provides casual seating, ideal for gathering to watch water sports on the large swim platform, whether the yacht is docked stern-to or accessed by tender. You can also reach the aft deck from the swim platform by stepping up from either port or starboard.

Entering the main salon from the aft deck through custom double glass sliding doors reveals an elegant and stylish lounge perfect for entertaining guests. The portside bar is fully equipped with all necessary amenities, while the seating area boasts large custom sofas, multiple chairs, adjustable coffee tables, and a game table. The main salon feels spacious and open, with excellent visibility through large windows on both sides. The formal dining area, one of three dining spots on board, features a custom rectangular table seating ten guests, with abundant natural light streaming through the large side windows. Ample storage to port is available for china, crystal, and stemware, and an automatic door to port serves as a service entrance between the galley and dining salon. The large professional galley is situated forward to port of the dining salon, with access from the midship port side deck for easy crew access and supply stocking. Entering the butler's pantry from the dining area, you'll find an ice machine and dishwasher. All galley appliances are stainless steel, including two large side-by-side True refrigerators, a steamer oven, dishwashers, a two-drawer freezer, a cooktop, two double wall ovens, and a microwave.

Moving forward to starboard on the main deck, you'll find the on-deck powder room. Entering the on-deck Owner's Suite, you'll discover a settee to starboard, a king-size bed with a bedside table, and a built-in desk to port forward. There is ample storage and closet space, and the large ensuite is designed as his and hers, complete with a shower and tub. The master suite also includes a 50-inch TV.

Descending the starboard main foyer stairwell to the lower foyer, you access four large guest staterooms. Two mirror-image staterooms feature queen-size

beds, each with an ensuite that includes a shower/tub combo and ample storage and hanging space in the closet. Additionally, there are two mirror twin cabins, each with two twin berths and ensuites with shower/tub combos.

Ascending the winding stairs from the guest foyer up two levels, you pass the main deck to reach the bridge deck dining room. Moving aft, you pass a well-appointed bridge deck powder room and continue into the expansive skylounge, which features a very large dining table. Walking further aft through a set of glass double doors leads to the third dining area on the spacious upper aft deck, featuring a custom teak table accommodating ten guests. Forward on this deck is the spacious pilothouse, equipped with a leather settee and table for guests to enjoy the view without disturbing the captain. A large captain's office with a navigation work desk, chart table, and drawers is located aft and to starboard. The bridge includes three captain's chairs and plenty of storage, with docking stations on the bridge wings port and starboard. Access via the Portuguese bridge over a central catwalk in the deckhouse leads to the working foredeck, which houses two Wave Runners.

Access to the sundeck from the bridge deck aft is via a set of stairs centerline. The spacious deck includes a large jacuzzi, a full bar setup, ample lounge areas, and a full helm station. On the aft part of the sundeck, several comfortable lounge chairs are available for relaxation.

Accommodations

The owner's suite is an opulent full-beam retreat located at the front of the main deck, featuring a king-size bed on the port side and a spacious settee on the starboard side. This refined area is enhanced by separate his and hers bathrooms, a walk-in closet, and a comprehensive AV system with satellite TV and Apple TV access, ensuring a luxurious and connected stay.

The yacht also includes four generous guest cabins on the lower deck. Two of these are fitted with queen-size beds, while the other two have twin beds,

accommodating diverse guest needs. Each cabin is equipped with ensuite bathrooms that include a bidet and tub/shower combinations, adding a layer of luxury and practicality. Guests can also enjoy a complete AV system with satellite TV and Apple TV, along with plenty of storage in hanging lockers and drawers.

For the crew, the accommodations are carefully planned to house up to eight members in four cabins, providing them with a comfortable living environment. The captain's cabin is located on the bridge deck, offering convenient access to the helm. The crew mess is spacious and well-appointed with a galley, walk-in refrigerator and freezer, and two sets of washers and dryers from Samsung and LG, ensuring the crew can uphold the yacht's high standards of service and hospitality.

Machinery

The yacht is driven by two powerful CAT C32 Acert diesel engines, each producing 1450 horsepower. These engines, introduced in 2015, have accumulated 1,625 hours by June 2022, demonstrating their dependability and performance. Supporting the main engines are two John Deere generators, each delivering 100kw of power. These generators, also installed in 2015, have reached 6,510 hours by June 2022, ensuring a consistent and efficient power supply for all onboard systems.

Regarding tankage, the yacht is well-prepared with fuel tanks holding 13,000 US gallons, allowing for extended journeys without frequent refueling. The capacity for potable water is 5,300 US gallons, while both the lube oil and sludge oil tanks hold 310 US gallons each. Additionally, the yacht is equipped with blackwater and greywater tanks, each with a capacity of 219 US gallons, ensuring effective waste management.

The auxiliary equipment on board is crafted to enhance the yacht's performance and comfort. It includes Koopnautic Zero Speed stabilizers for a

smooth journey and a Holland Roerpropeller bow thruster for precise navigation. The fuel separator, an Alpha Laval MIB 303, ensures a clean fuel supply. Watermakers with a capacity of 3,000 gallons per day each provide ample fresh water, while the Marine Air Chiller, new in 2015, maintains optimal climate control. The yacht is fitted with an Atlas 90kva shorepower system, accommodating both 50 and 60hz frequencies, and a Hamaan sewage treatment system for environmental compliance. The Akerboom shaft seals, installed in 2019, further boost the yacht's operational efficiency and reliability.

Communication and navigation equipment

The yacht boasts cutting-edge communication and navigation systems to guarantee a smooth and secure voyage. It includes three 19-inch and two 13-inch flatscreens that display navigation information, radar, and camera feeds, offering comprehensive situational awareness. The TimeZero Navigation system operates on PCs, providing sophisticated chart plotting and route planning features. The Nightwatch system enhances safety during nighttime operations.

For radar capabilities, the yacht is equipped with two new Furuno RCU-014 Blackbox Radars, ensuring precise and dependable detection of nearby vessels and obstacles. Navigation is further supported by two Furuno GPS Navigators and a Furuno FCU-12002 Color Sounder, delivering detailed underwater insights. The Furuno Doppler Speed Log provides accurate speed readings, while the Pilot Star Autopilot and Anschutz Compass ensure precise course maintenance.

Communication is facilitated by two Furuno VHF radios and a Furuno Universal AIS, which improves vessel tracking and identification. The yacht also features Koopnautic Zero Speed Stabilizers for enhanced comfort while at anchor. For satellite communication, the Satcom Sailor Fleet Broadband FBB500 offers both voice and data services, ensuring connectivity even in remote areas. The

Panasonic KXT 7630 PABX telephone system, with phones in all cabins, ensures efficient and reliable internal communication.

Entertainment equipment

The yacht boasts an extensive entertainment system crafted to offer guests a diverse array of viewing options, regardless of their global location. It includes a Seatel Series 04 KuBand antenna, ensuring uninterrupted television reception throughout Europe and the Caribbean. For those in the United States, the KVH TracVision HD7 antenna provides high-definition TV, granting access to a vast selection of channels. The entertainment experience is further elevated with Apple TV, enabling guests to effortlessly stream their favorite shows and films. Moreover, the yacht is fitted with TV receivers and ten US Direct TV HD receivers, ensuring every guest can indulge in high-definition entertainment in their personal space. This comprehensive setup ensures that everyone on board can remain connected to their preferred entertainment, whether unwinding in a private cabin or socializing in a shared area.

Galley and laundry equipment

The yacht's galley is outfitted to satisfy the most demanding culinary expectations, boasting a Garland 6-burner range and a Garland oven for a variety of cooking possibilities. The True refrigerator and True freezer offer generous space for storing fresh and frozen goods, while the Vulcan Steam Quick and Vulcan plate heaters guarantee that dishes are cooked and served at the ideal temperature. A Hobart dishwasher and a microwave enhance the galley's efficiency, and two separate sinks provide ease for food preparation and cleaning.

In the laundry section, the yacht is fitted with two sets of Samsung washers and dryers, along with two sets of LG washers and dryers, all newly installed in

2019. This arrangement ensures that all laundry requirements are handled smoothly and effectively, keeping the yacht's linens and guest attire in immaculate condition.

The crew mess is crafted for both comfort and practicality, featuring a Uline refrigerator and a GE microwave for quick meals and snacks. A Bosch dishwasher and an ice maker complete the amenities, ensuring that the crew can uphold high service standards while enjoying their own space.

Tenders and toys

The yacht comes with a pair of SeaDoo Waverunners, both newly acquired in 2019, promising thrilling water sports adventures for guests. These Waverunners offer an ideal way to explore the nearby waters, infusing any journey with a sense of adventure and excitement. Whether you wish to take a relaxed ride or crave an exhilarating high-speed experience, these Waverunners are crafted to provide outstanding performance and enjoyment on the water.

Refit 2017

In 2017, the yacht experienced a significant refit at LMC, ensuring it stays at the pinnacle of luxury and performance. This thorough renovation involved the installation of new Caterpillar C32 Acert engines and John Deere 100KW generators, delivering strong and dependable power. The refit also included new exhaust systems for both engines and generators, boosting efficiency and lowering emissions.

A new Atlas SPA-11 90KVA shore power converter was added, guaranteeing smooth power management while docked. The yacht's exterior was refreshed with a new coat of paint by Luu Marine, rejuvenating its look, and new teak decks were laid to improve both aesthetics and durability. The addition of a

new chiller plant ensures optimal climate control throughout the vessel.

The refit also saw the implementation of a new power management system and the installation of a Nightwatch alarm and monitoring system, enhancing safety and operational efficiency. Furthermore, new navigation and communication electronics were installed in both the pilothouse and flybridge, ensuring cutting-edge technology is readily available to the captain. This refit has not only brought the yacht up to date but also ensured it continues to offer an outstanding yachting experience.

Never Enough, formerly known as Gallant Lady and Kismet, has been meticulously maintained and upgraded throughout her existence. In 2017, she received significant enhancements, including new engines and generators, a brand-new air conditioning system, fresh paint, new teak decks, and updated electronics. To further elevate her allure, all soft furnishings were replaced in December 2022, ensuring a contemporary and inviting interior.

This yacht is a superbly constructed five-stateroom vessel with remarkable volume throughout. The main salon and skylounge span the full width, offering an expansive interior that provides plenty of seating and lounging areas. The aft bridge deck and sundeck are perfect for dining and outdoor entertainment, providing flexible spaces for relaxation and socializing. Never Enough is outfitted with all the amenities and a layout ideal for both private enjoyment and charter use, making her a versatile and appealing choice for any discerning yacht owner.

Refit 2022

In December 2022, the yacht experienced a thorough interior renovation, highlighted by the full replacement of all soft furnishings. This careful update

ensured that every fabric, upholstery, and textile component on board was renewed, creating a contemporary and welcoming ambiance. The refit not only improved the visual allure of the interior spaces but also heightened the overall comfort and luxury enjoyed by guests. This meticulous attention to detail in choosing and installing new materials underscores the yacht's dedication to upholding the highest standards of elegance and sophistication.
