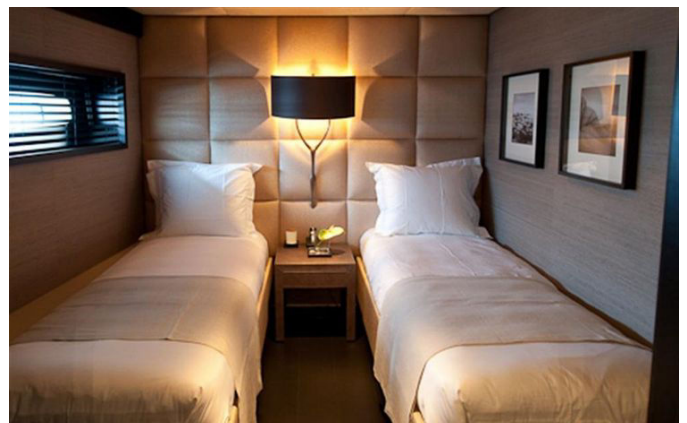

DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Hull

The yacht's hull and superstructure are constructed from fully welded aluminum, meeting the rigorous standards set by ABS. A hydraulically controlled aluminum watertight transom door grants access to the tender garage, combining practicality with security. The design focused on creating a hull that moves effortlessly through the water, with an emphasis on maximizing propulsion efficiency and fuel savings. Achieving optimal cruising speed was a key objective, and Computational Fluid Dynamics were utilized to perfect the hull's shape. This innovation played a crucial role in the development of the Fast Displacement Hull Form by Van Oossanen & Associates, for which a patent is pending.

This remarkable vessel is powered by twin MTU 16V2000M93 engines, enabling it to reach a maximum speed of 20.7 knots and a swift cruising speed over 16 knots. The yacht's fuel efficiency is outstanding, using only 7.8 liters per nautical mile at 12 knots and 14 liters per nautical mile at 16 knots, even with standard generator use, although actual performance may vary with sea conditions.

The hull is primarily of the round-bilge design, with spray rails in the forward section. Trim wedges are installed within the propeller tunnels, providing enough lift at the stern to keep the running trim nearly horizontal throughout the speed range. A bulbous bow is included to reduce wave resistance. Significant attention has been given to the design of the propeller shafts, appendages, and the propellers themselves, achieving impressively low noise levels of less than 55 dBA at 75% MCR. Furthermore, the yacht is fitted with zero speed stabilizers, enhancing comfort and stability while at anchor.

Accommodations

The owners of my LATITUDE, experienced yachting aficionados, teamed up with Cor D. Rover to create a triple-deck yacht that provides generous living areas both inside and out. The design focused on wrapping this increased space in a sleek and sporty exterior. Accommodations for the owner and guests include five staterooms, with an additional sixth stateroom option in the sky-lounge, comfortably hosting up to 12 guests. The lower deck features two expansive full-beam VIP staterooms, along with two guest cabins, each with its own en-suite bathroom. The owner's stateroom is located forward on the main deck, offering a luxurious and private sanctuary.

The sky-lounge, complete with full bathroom amenities, can be used flexibly as a gym or as a sixth stateroom with an en-suite. The main saloon and dining area feature a chic bar, and all exterior decks are equipped with ample seating, ideal for entertaining large groups. The interior showcases a modern design, combining wood, fabrics, and leather, highlighted by vibrant colors, all crafted by the esteemed Dutch interior designer Piet Boon of Piet Boon Design.

The sundeck is a retreat for relaxation, featuring a jacuzzi and an additional bar area equipped with a barbeque, icemaker, and fridge. Crew accommodations are planned for a total of six, plus the captain, with three double crew cabins with twin bunks and a captain's cabin with a double bed. A distinctive feature of this yacht is the direct staircase on the port side, connecting the sundeck to the sunbathing area on the Portuguese bridge, allowing owners and guests to move freely without entering the interior spaces.

Audio and visual equipment

The yacht boasts top-tier audio and visual systems, delivering an unparalleled entertainment experience on board. At the heart of this arrangement is an

all-encompassing Creston system, flawlessly integrated with Kaleidescape players, granting access to an extensive collection of films and music at your command. This advanced system also offers intuitive management of lighting, blinds, and intercom, elevating the ambiance and ease of use. Furthermore, the yacht is equipped with a CCTV system from Art Cinema, providing security and reassurance for all guests.

Galley/laundry

The yacht features a bespoke stainless steel galley crafted to professional specifications, guaranteeing an exceptional culinary experience at sea. This fully equipped kitchen includes a microwave from M-system, model MCM600IX, and two 58-liter ovens, also by M-system, model SEN-601X. The cooking area is further enhanced by a six-burner ceramic hob from CERAN, model PCVE-40DB, paired with a custom fan hood for optimal ventilation. For seamless cleaning, a Rhima dishwasher, model DR50 S, is part of the setup. The galley provides ample storage with around 1,000 liters of freezer capacity and an additional 1,000 liters of refrigeration. An ice maker with an 11.5 kg capacity and a trash compactor complete this professional kitchen.

In the laundry section, convenience and efficiency are key, featuring an ironing table and iron, along with two Miele washing machines, model W 2105, and two Miele tumble dryers, model T 4223 C. This well-rounded arrangement ensures all laundry tasks are handled with ease and precision, upholding the highest standards of onboard service.

Electronics

The yacht is outfitted with a comprehensive suite of cutting-edge electronics, guaranteeing smooth navigation and communication while at sea. Central to the navigation system is the Navigat X MK2 gyro compass, paired with a

Merkur S-R magnetic compass for precise directional accuracy. The vessel is equipped with a Furuno FE-700 echosounder and a Naviknot 350E speedlog, delivering precise depth and speed data. For positioning, the GP 150 GPS receiver is employed, and radar capabilities are bolstered by the Furuno FAR 2117 and an additional radar system, the Furuno NavNet II.

Communication is robust, featuring an RT 5022 VHF radio telephone and a Thrane & Thrane TT 3000E Inmarsat C system. The yacht also includes a Furuno NX 700B Navtex receiver and Jotron TR 20 GMDSS portable transceivers for safety and information. Emergency systems comprise a Tron 40S E.P.I.R.B. and a Jotron TronSART radar transponder. The Furuno FA 150 AIS system and Navipilot 4000 autopilot with an electric main steering system ensure smooth and secure navigation.

To further enhance communication, the yacht is equipped with Sailor FleetBroadBand 250 Inmarsat Fleet Equipment and a Panasonic KXTDA 100 telephone exchange. The Globesurefer II Triple Band GSM and DSC Biscaya antenna system ensure reliable connectivity. For navigation, the NaviSailor 3000 electronic chart software is utilized, and external communication is facilitated through Livewire connections. The yacht also features Inventica Yacht Spot external WiFi equipment and six Icom IC-F25SR portable radios for onboard communication.

Entertainment and information are provided by the SeaTel Coastal 30 satellite TV system, ensuring guests have access to a wide array of channels while at sea. This extensive array of electronics ensures the yacht is fully equipped for any voyage, offering both safety and convenience to its passengers.

Electrical system

The yacht's electrical system is both powerful and precisely engineered to cater to the unique requirements of its users and onboard systems, fully compliant with ABS standards. Central to this setup are dual Kohler

generators, each delivering 99KW of energy. These generators function in parallel mode automatically, guaranteeing a consistent and dependable power supply. The system is configured to operate on a 24v - 230/400 VAC, 3 phase 50Hz setup, perfectly suited to the yacht's varied electrical needs.

For shore power, a 65-meter shore cable is conveniently stored in the lazarette, featuring a Hubbel power cord connection for straightforward and efficient linking to shore power sources. This well-rounded electrical arrangement ensures that all onboard systems run effortlessly, offering comfort and ease to all guests.

Mechanical equipment

The yacht is outfitted with an advanced collection of mechanical equipment, guaranteeing peak performance and dependability. Central to its propulsion system is the ZF4660 gearbox, coupled with Shaffran 5-bladed propellers and Amartech shafts, ensuring smooth and efficient navigation through the water. The Trydo steering gear provides precise maneuverability, while Marquip exhaust systems optimize engine efficiency.

For stability, the yacht is equipped with Naiad zero speed stabilizers, effective even when anchored, enhancing onboard comfort. Anchoring is facilitated by the Maxwell 8000 windlass, and maneuverability is further improved by a Kalkman 60KW tunnel bow thruster. The custom passerelle by Prozee in Holland adds a bespoke touch, while lifting needs are addressed by a Prozee custom crane in the lazarette and an Opacmare crane on the foredeck.

The yacht's exterior is coated with Alexseal paint, offering a sleek and resilient finish. Onboard water requirements are met by the HEM 30/2 100 Modular watermaker, capable of producing 12,000 liters daily. Waste management is efficiently handled by the Hamann sewage system, ensuring environmental compliance.

The yacht's control and monitoring are overseen by the Marble MS 3080 system, providing comprehensive management of all onboard systems. Climate control is maintained by Heinen & Hopman air conditioning, ensuring a comfortable atmosphere in any weather. This extensive array of mechanical equipment ensures the yacht operates smoothly and efficiently, delivering a luxurious and dependable experience for everyone on board.

Tenders

The yacht offers a diverse array of tenders to elevate your nautical adventures. Leading the selection is the Castoldi Jet Tender 17, celebrated for its exceptional performance and dependability, making it perfect for both relaxing outings and efficient transport. Accompanying it is the Zodiac Fastroller, serving as the Man Overboard (MOB) tender, which adds an extra level of safety and swift response capability. Together, these tenders guarantee that all your aquatic activities are conducted with both efficiency and elegance.

Water sports

The yacht boasts an extensive selection of water sports gear, promising endless excitement and adventure on the water. Central to the collection is the Castoldi jet turbo drive, spanning 5.3 meters, offering exhilarating rides over the waves. For those craving speed, two SEADOO RXP 255RS wave runners are available, ideal for racing across the water. On land, mobility is enhanced with two Piaggio scooters, perfect for exploring coastal regions with ease.

Wind enthusiasts will appreciate the windsurfing setup, while wakeboarding aficionados can choose from both adult and youth JOBE wakeboards. Cycling fans are well-catered to with two SCOTT Scale 80 cross-country bikes and two BROMPTON folding bikes, providing flexibility and convenience. The excitement continues with a towable banana boat, delivering a classic water

sport thrill.

Water skiing options include both adult and youth JOBE waterskis, along with an adult monoski for those eager to challenge their skills. Scuba diving and snorkeling gear are also available, inviting guests to discover the vibrant underwater world. This comprehensive array of water sports equipment ensures that every guest finds an activity to enjoy, turning each day on the yacht into an adventure.
