





























DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Description

Motor Yacht STARSHIP is a one hundred forty three foot classic luxury icon offered in Fort Lauderdale, FL, with an asking price of \$2,995,000, blending timeless exterior lines with modern livability after high value refits in 2004, 2015, and 2017 and diligent ongoing upgrades. Built by Van Mill in 1988 to naval architecture by Pieter Beeldsnijder Design and Murray & Associates, she welcomes guests in an interior where marble floors, rich polished woods, and elegant soft furnishings frame a grand main foyer crowned by a graceful spiral staircase. Accommodation for up to twelve guests is arranged across five staterooms—a full beam master suite, two VIPs, a double, and a twin with a Pullman berth—while capacity for up to nine professional crew ensures attentive, discreet service throughout every voyage. Powered in the description by two MTU diesel engines, STARSHIP offers reliable performance and smooth, confident cruising, complemented by expansive decks and gracious social areas crafted for effortless entertaining or quiet relaxation. Her onboard amenities encompass full air conditioning, Wi Fi, a deck Jacuzzi, a well equipped gym, and stabilizers at anchor for serene comfort, and she is fully outfitted for on the water adventure with tenders, jet skis, sailboards, water skis, and diving equipment, making every anchorage a private playground and a compelling choice for discerning private ownership or global charter.

Key features

Crafted by Van Mill, this one hundred forty three foot classic motor yacht showcases elegant naval architecture by Pieter Beeldsnijder Design and Murray & Associates, with a build year of 1988 and comprehensive refits

completed in 2004, 2015, and 2017 that preserve her classic profile while upgrading systems for contemporary comfort. She sleeps twelve guests in five staterooms—Master, two VIPs, a Double, and a Twin with a Pullman berth—supported by crew capacity for nine professionals and a grand main foyer with marble floors and a sweeping spiral staircase that sets a sophisticated tone. Rich polished woodwork and luxurious soft furnishings elevate every lounge and salon, while expansive social areas and refined dining salons invite effortless entertaining, complemented by air conditioning throughout, Wi-Fi, a deck Jacuzzi, a dedicated gym with exercise equipment, and stabilizers at anchor for maximum comfort. Reliable propulsion is described in other sections and the yacht is fully geared for watersports with tenders, wave runners, sailboards, water skis, and a dive compressor—everything required for spirited days on the water.

Accommodations

Designed for indulgent comfort, STARSHIP sleeps up to twelve guests in five thoughtfully arranged staterooms comprising a master suite, two VIP staterooms, one double cabin, and one twin cabin complemented by a Pullman berth, each space appointed to balance privacy and sociability with refined finishes and generous proportions. Service is seamless and discreet with capacity for up to nine professional crew, supported by four dedicated crew cabins and a separate Captain's cabin to ensure impeccable operations around the clock and an organized, guest-focused onboard experience.

On deck

Life on deck unfolds across expansive terraces and convivial lounges ideal for entertaining or unwinding at any pace, where sunning, dining, and socialising feel effortless thanks to generous layout and elegant appointments. A soothing

deck Jacuzzi beckons after sun-drenched days, while a well-equipped gym with exercise gear keeps wellness in easy reach, and stabilizers at anchor preserve a calm, level ride for relaxed evenings and peaceful sleep. Full-boat air conditioning with Wi-Fi throughout ensures effortless comfort and connectivity wherever you cruise, making the decks prime spaces for both lively gatherings and quiet contemplation.

Engine & performance

Delivering a combined 4500 hp, her Caterpillar diesel engines provide smooth, reliable cruising with the poised confidence expected of a yacht in this class, pairing superb seakeeping with the thrill of on-the-water pursuits. The spirited platform supports both comfortable long-distance passages and lively days at anchor, and she is fully equipped for watersports and activities, including tenders, wave runners, motor scooters, sailboards, water skis, and a dive compressor—ensuring that performance offshore translates seamlessly into play when at rest.

Tenders & toys

The toys inventory is curated for adventure: a 2011 forty-foot Intrepid main tender with triple 350 Yamaha outboards and full fishing gear stands ready for swift transfers and sportfishing, complemented by a Novarania second tender powered by a 115 Yamaha for versatile utility. Five Yamaha waverunners amplify the fun, while two Honda Metropolitan motor scooters extend exploration ashore. On the water, two waterskis, a towering water slide, and two Seabobs spark endless play, supported by one Bauer, Brownies dive compressor for sustained underwater pursuits. Rounding out the offering are free weights and Precor fitness gear with a treadmill, along with kayaks, a banana, and a wakeboard to keep every day fresh and exhilarating.

Communication

Seamless connectivity comes via V Sat Seatell satcom, while a Panasonic telephone system with eight lines and eighteen extensions keeps onboard communications organized and reliable. For ship to ship and ship to shore operations, three I Com fixed VHF units pair with thirteen I Com handheld VHF's to cover all operational needs, and a suite of Custom Computers and Apple hardware supports navigation and administration, complemented by an HP Photosmart ship's printer for onboard documentation.

Navigation equipment

The bridge is comprehensively outfitted with two Furuno radars, an Anschutz autopilot, and an Anschutz gyrocompass for precision heading control, while depth information is provided by B&G and Furuno sounders. Position fixing is assured by two Northstar 951 GPS units and one Furuno GP30, with a Transas laser plotter streamlining voyage planning and Furuno weather fax plus B&G wind and speed instrumentation delivering the essential data confidence demanded by serious passagemaking.

Entertainment

Entertainment is thoughtfully distributed throughout the yacht, with one TV on the aft deck for open air viewing, two Panasonic TVs on the upper deck, and one Sony TV anchoring the main salon, ensuring both communal and private viewing options. Nine additional Panasonic TVs serve the guest and crew cabins, and DVDs are available in every room, delivering personalized content and effortless downtime wherever you choose to unwind.

Mechanical equipment

Engineering systems are specified for endurance and comfort, starting with two Caterpillar generators rated at 90 kW and 1800 RPM each to secure dependable onboard power. Climate control is delivered by four Cruise Air ten ton chillers feeding twenty six air handlers, while three 1200 gpd watermakers support independent cruising. Quantum Zero Speed Stabilizer technology and a Quantum bow thruster ensure composed handling at rest and in close quarters. Fuel is polished by an Alfa Laval filtration system, blackwater is managed by a Headhunter sewage system, and steering precision is safeguarded by a KaMeWa steering system with a KaMeWa emergency backup to maintain control under all conditions.

Deck equipment

Deck gear is robust and practical, featuring two anchors with five hundred ft of chain per side for versatile holding in varied bottom conditions, and two capstans on the forward deck plus two aft to simplify line handling. Lifting needs are met by a Marquipt main tender davit rated at 2,500 lb and two additional Marquipt cranes rated at 1,000 lb, while boarding is effortless via Marquipt seven step accommodation ladders and a hydraulic stern boarding gangway by Nautical Structures streamlines embarkation at any quay.

Galley

The main galley is outfitted for gourmet service with two Viking stoves, a Viking six burner cooktop, a Viking microwave, and a Miele dishwasher, allowing the chef to move effortlessly from preparation to impeccable presentation and deliver restaurant quality meals at sea.

Other areas

For provisioning and service, five Scottsman icemakers keep drinks perfectly chilled, supported by seven refrigerators and three freezers to accommodate extended cruising and effortless hospitality wherever you roam.
