OVERVIEW

MCP Yachts MY 140

Put simply, the MCP MY 140 is the largest pleasure craft ever built in Latin America—and in a single word, it is breathtaking. Admired, photographed, filmed, instantly recognizable from afar and unmatched by comparison, this luxury motor yacht stands alone in its class for presence and personality.

Known as the Hemisphere MCP MY 140, this remarkable vessel has joined the rarefied circle of global “celebrities” among superyachts—not only for setting historic benchmarks in Brazilian yachting and for being the biggest leisure boat constructed in the region, which would already secure its renown, but also for its arresting silhouette and commanding scale.

Watch the MCP MY 140 glide and the fluid grace of its navigation almost makes you forget that it stretches nearly 44 meters, spans four decks, and carries a displacement of 200 tons, all delivered with poise that belies its megayacht proportions.

Inside, the volume is extraordinary, accommodating 12 guests across five generous staterooms—four expansive suites and one cabin fitted with four bunk beds. The secluded owner’s suite is entirely private. Conceived for a tall yachtsman, every ergonomic detail reflects stature and comfort: from stair risers and cabin dimensions to headroom, bed heights, corridors, bathrooms, and doorways. A refined, minimalist interior amplifies the yacht’s elegance, enriched by fabrics and finishes sourced from Europe and the United States. Craftsmanship is a highlight, with timeless walnut and radical joinery lending a classic, conservative character. In harmonious counterpoint, extensive glass invites light and balance throughout the interior.

An illuminated glass spiral staircase connects the main and upper decks, while a sauna, jacuzzi, and expansive exterior terraces weave together multiple

lounges, living areas, and dining spaces—perfectly composed for relaxation and sophisticated entertaining.

Polished stainless-steel accents bring a contemporary edge, emphasized by luminous, open transitions between rooms. Guest privacy is carefully preserved, with discreet crew circulation via separate access routes ensuring seamless service on board this ocean-going yacht.

This semi-displacement aluminum superyacht is built to meet Lloyd's requirements and, powered by twin Caterpillar C32 engines delivering 1,925 BHP each, reaches a top speed of 19 knots. At a comfortable cruise, it offers the range for bluewater, transoceanic passages in virtually any weather and sea state, uniting performance, autonomy, and unwavering confidence.

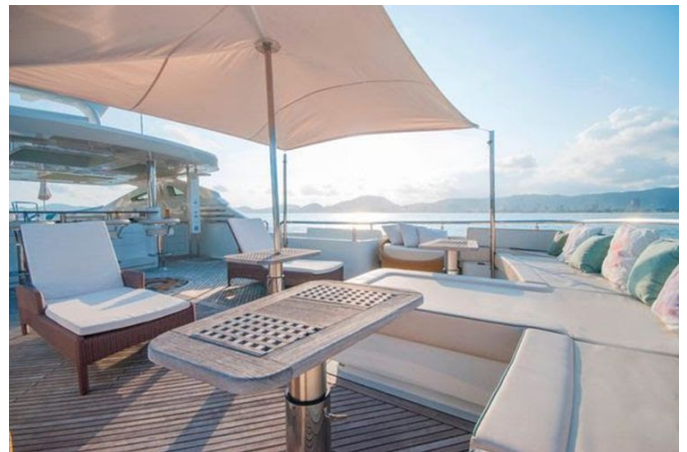
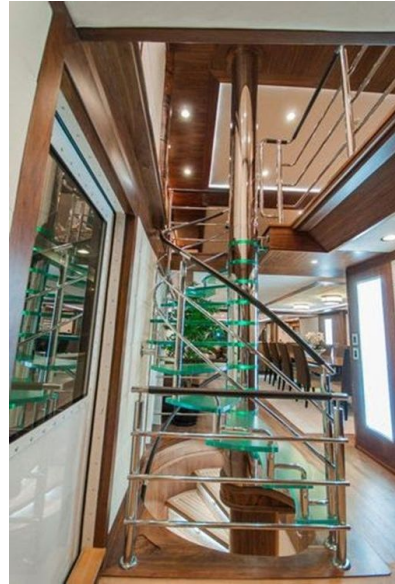

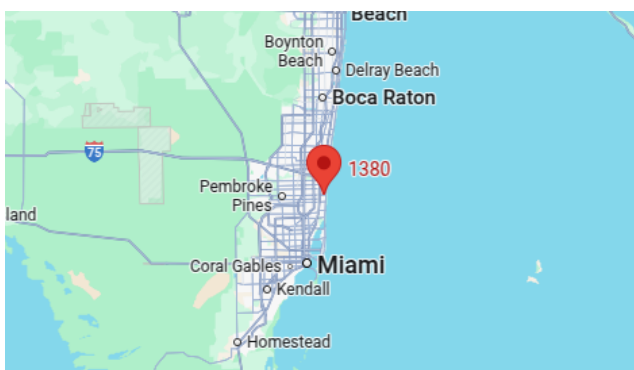
