OVERVIEW

The 44-metre motor yacht Kijo, a creation of the renowned Heesen Yachts in the Netherlands, exemplifies refined naval architecture and thoughtful craftsmanship. Produced by a shipyard based in Oss, inland yet celebrated across Northern Europe, she carries the imprint of a company founded by Frans Heesen, whose lifelong focus on aluminium superyachts has yielded vessels that marry swift performance with elegant lines and economical operation, all wrapped in richly appointed interiors. The tasteful hand of Terence Disdale is visible in Kijo's aesthetic, enhancing an already distinguished pedigree and helping to preserve Heesen's strong market standing—an important consideration for both resale and charter prospects.

Launched in 2003, Kijo combines contemporary styling with high-performance capability. Built with an aluminium hull and superstructure, she benefits from a lightweight, resilient construction that underpins her seakeeping and efficiency. Her engineering delivers a top speed of 25 knots and a comfortable cruising speed of 17 knots, offering spirited passages without sacrificing economy. Internally she is arranged to host up to 12 guests across five beautifully appointed cabins, including a full-beam master suite that provides generous privacy and comfort. The salon and dining spaces are executed with premium materials and modern furnishings, while expansive windows admit abundant natural light, creating an airy, inviting atmosphere throughout.

Exterior decks extend the living space with gracious outdoor areas: the aft deck presents generous lounging and al fresco dining options, a sunlit flybridge invites open-air relaxation and entertaining, and a swim platform affords easy access to the water. Beneath her handsome lines Kijo is equipped with advanced systems, from cutting-edge electronics to an effective stabilization package that ensures a smooth and comfortable voyage. Propulsion comes from twin MTU engines that provide both the power and reliability expected

for extended cruising; notably, the main engine has been recommissioned to zero hours following comprehensive engineering work carried out at a cost in excess of €3M.

Whether navigating the Mediterranean or exploring more distant, exotic anchorages, M/Y Kijo offers a harmonious blend of speed, style and substance. Located at her current boat location, she represents a rare opportunity to acquire a yacht that so eloquently balances luxury and performance.
