OVERVIEW

An extraordinary opportunity to acquire one of the truly outstanding, painstakingly restored Boston Whaler 15' Super Sport center consoles—an heirloom-quality boat that reads as both a museum piece and a thoroughly modern small craft. Delivered to a single family and kept undercover its entire life, this 1987 Boston Whaler 150 Super Sport Center Console has been returned to factory-correct appearance while being subtly and sensibly upgraded with contemporary systems that preserve the boat's original soul.

Refitted as a tribute to the owner's father, the restoration is the product of meticulous craft, exacting detail, and an insistence on authenticity. The result is a concours-level classic enhanced for 2025-level reliability and convenience: a full Awlgrip/Awlcraft 2000 Eggshell White paint system on hull and topsides, original brass and chrome hardware fully refurbished, original stainless fittings preserved and polished, and custom copper drains executed to match vintage Whaler detail. All original Boston Whaler identification and U.S. Coast Guard plates have been retained, maintaining provenance and authenticity.

Power and performance combine practicality and care. The Whaler is driven by a 2020 Yamaha F70 four-stroke outboard, maintained with obsessive attention and freshwater-flushed after every outing, mounted on a transom fitted with 5° wedges for optimal trim and performance. Fuel capacity is handled by a custom 60-litre tank with an integrated, calibrated fuel sender linked through the Yamaha/Garmin network.

The interior timberwork is exemplary: original mahogany restored using the Awlgrip Awlwood system with ten atomized spray coats to achieve a superyacht-calibre gloss, UV resilience, and virtually no maintenance. Complementing the mahogany are custom solid teak inserts at the helm, pull-switches, and stern-light mounts, finished to the same Awlwood gloss, and a custom removable vented timber hatch fitted into the original console

opening—every wooden element refitted with reverence and durability in mind.

Every electrical system was rebuilt to modern marine standards. The boat has been fully rewired bow-to-stern with marine-grade, triple-tinned copper cabling, the original fuse box relocated into the console and paired with a Blue Sea Systems distribution panel. Starting power is provided by a Century Marine Pro 780 (100Ah) Australian-made, oversized-spec battery; the wiring is pre-configured for a secondary lithium trolling motor battery and controlled via a BEP dual battery switch. Wiring runs are waterproofed, concealed with service access, and include an integrated power socket at the stern-light base. Lighting and safety systems include LED navigation and stern lights to Boston Whaler USA spec, underfloor indirect lighting, and an automatic Rule bilge pump.

Electronics are thoughtfully integrated yet discreet. A Garmin GPSMAP 8410XSV 10" multifunction display provides charting and sonar, tied into Yamaha engine data; sonar capability is supplied by a Garmin GT56UHD-TM transducer (High Wide CHIRP, ClearVü, SideVü). Instrumentation includes Yamaha dual digital gauges and binnacle control, a Blue Sea Systems voltmeter, and a Ritchie illuminated compass linked to the navigation lights for traditional backup clarity.

Fittings and gear balance period correctness with modern utility: a custom EVA foam deck armor floor, a custom-trimmed helm seat cushion, four stainless steel cup holders and two rod holders, and genuine Boston Whaler OEM parts sourced from the USA—including a vented fuel filler, fuel tank vent, gunnel rail, and harpoon transom plates. Comfort and practicality are furthered by a Yeti 45-litre cooler, the original and remarkably preserved 1987 Perspex windscreen, a custom cover, and a spare Yamaha service kit (including oil) supplied with the sale.

Trailing and deployment are turnkey. A 2022 Evolution braked trailer

equipped with keel rollers, slides, LED lighting, and rated lifting points accompanies the boat, making it ideal as a superyacht tender or chase boat for Fleming, Grand Banks, Norman Wright, sportfish, or expedition yachts, as well as a refined, trailerable dayboat or runabout.

This is far from a typical Whaler; it is a lovingly executed, concours-level restoration that fuses Boston Whaler's timeless hull form with contemporary reliability, electrics, and functionality. Every screw, wire, and fitting has been considered and conserved where appropriate. Equally at home as a collector's piece, a premium tender to a superyacht, or an elegant weekend dayboat, the vessel sits ready for inspection by appointment.
