OVERVIEW

Launched by CBI Navi in 2011, the 50m semi-displacement luxury motor yacht M/Y BELITA combines Hydro Tec naval architecture with refined exterior and interior styling by Studio Vafiadis, presenting 498 GT of exceptionally generous volume that translates into expansive living areas across every deck. Her six-cabin arrangement accommodates up to 14 guests, centred on a full-beam Owner's suite privately located on the Upper Deck, accompanied by three VIP staterooms on the Lower Deck and two Twin cabins on the Main Deck. The Owner's apartment is a defining feature of BELITA, offering an intimate private salon appointed with sumptuous seating and a grand piano. Outside, the open decks are laid out for sophisticated al fresco dining, relaxed lounging and elegant entertaining, with a Jacuzzi plunge pool and an extensive aft swim platform providing effortless access to the water. Propelled by twin MTU 16V 4000 M93s, BELITA reaches a top speed of 23 knots while offering flexible cruising at economical 13.5 knots up to 17 knots, delivering the performance expected of a contemporary superyacht.
