OVERVIEW

AMELS pedigree and Terence Disdale refinement unite in this 180-foot luxury motor yacht, a full-displacement superyacht currently lying in Monaco. Launched in 2003 and built to Northern European standards, her steel hull and steel decks give a reassuring solidity and quiet dignity that speak to ocean-going purpose and enduring quality.

With a generous 31-foot beam and approximately 802 GT of internal volume, the interior feels both expansive and intimately detailed. Disdale's characteristic sensibility is evident in calming color schemes, tactile surfaces, and a fluid spatial arrangement that encourages relaxed living and effortless entertaining. Sun-washed lounges flow seamlessly into formal and informal dining areas, while large windows frame cinematic vistas of sea and sky. Accommodations are serene and carefully finished, offering privacy and comfort across well-appointed cabins supported by five heads for guest convenience.

Designed for bluewater cruising, her full-displacement hull delivers composed motion and reassuring stability on passage. Twin Caterpillar diesel inboard engines strike a refined balance between performance and economy, allowing a comfortable cruise at 11 knots with the capacity to reach up to 16 knots when desired. A draft of approximately 10.24 feet and the inherent strength of steel construction emphasize capability and composure on extended voyages. Autonomy and practicality are built into her systems. Substantial tankage—over 26,000 gallons of fuel and more than 7,600 gallons of fresh water—permits long-range itineraries and flexible routing, while abundant storage and well-thought service areas keep life aboard effortless whether hosting an intimate weekend or an extended expedition. From the tranquility of interior lounges to versatile open decks arranged for sun, shade, and elegant al fresco moments, every element has been considered for refined

living at sea.

This Monaco-based AMELS is a rare expression of timeless character: purposeful yet indulgent, powerful yet quiet. Shaped by the collaboration of AMELS and Terence Disdale Design, she embodies the essence of the modern superyacht—beauty, comfort, and true seakeeping in equal measure. Superyacht.
