## OVERVIEW

A striking embodiment of contemporary seafaring and discreet luxury, this 2027, 190-foot steel motor yacht emerges to market as an American-based superyacht that marries bluewater steadiness with sumptuous onboard living. Her steel hull and steel decks convey elemental sturdiness, while a commanding 39-foot beam and a purposeful deep draft announce transoceanic intent and inspire confidence in open water, every inch composed and resolute as she slips through long sea miles.

Propulsion is entrusted to twin MTU diesel inboards that deliver serene, dependable thrust: a steady 12-knot cruising speed with the ability to reach up to 15 knots when required. Those speeds are underpinned by extraordinary range, with fuel stores in excess of 34,000 gallons and freshwater capacity exceeding 7,600 gallons, granting long-legged passages and exceptional autonomy for owners who prize explorer spirit without sacrificing five-star comfort.

Deck volumes are generous and thoughtfully layered for effortless entertaining. A sunlit foredeck invites morning practice or relaxed cocktails, while panoramic upper terraces create intimate settings for starlit dinners and languid afternoons at anchor. Bridge and sky lounges open as quiet, light-filled sanctuaries framed by full-height glazing, where conversation drifts and horizons broaden. A broad aft platform and a beach-club style waterside area convert anchorages into a private resort, with seamless access to tenders and toys stowed in a capacious garage designed for ease of launch and retrieval.

Within, the interior palette is contemporary and timeless—warm textiles, refined stone surfaces, and exactingly tailored furnishings form a calm, gallery-like environment for art and life at sea. The owner's suite occupies an expansive footprint, offering panoramic views and spa-inspired amenities that elevate privacy and wellness. Guest cabins are equally indulgent:

sound-insulated, beautifully lit, and appointed for restorative sleep whether underway or in port. Discreet crew circulation and professional crew quarters are arranged to ensure attentive, five-star service while preserving owner and guest privacy.

Onboard systems reflect modern seafaring demands: a comprehensive navigation and communications suite, advanced ship systems, and thoughtfully designed redundancy combine to make her a confident world traveler. Low-vibration engineering and meticulous noise attenuation maintain hushed conversations and uninterrupted rest, even on long passages. Whether imagined as a private family sanctuary or a charter-ready mega yacht with global appeal, she balances comfort underway, operational efficiency, and a gracious flow between interior and exterior living.

Lying in the United States and presented as a 2027 build and model year, this steel-hulled luxury superyacht unites ocean-going capability, elegant design, and uncompromised construction. For owners seeking the presence of a mega yacht alongside the versatility of an expedition-capable cruiser and the polish required of a premier charter vessel, she stands as a benchmark—poised, powerful, and impeccably prepared for the next horizon.

This partnership fuses RMK's decades of craftsmanship and technical mastery with Lagaria's fresh perspective and refined aesthetic, delivering a bold, contemporary vision of the modern superyacht experience. Once under contract, Project Orca can be delivered within 24 months and built to commercial class standards, and there is still time for the owner to select their interior design. The RMK Orca 58M is sophisticated in both form and function, its advanced solutions wrapped in a sleek, minimalistic profile that embraces innovation while honoring timeless style. From the first glance, Project Orca captivates with clean, angular lines and a contemporary silhouette, her sculpted profile striking a poised balance between strength and elegance—confident without ever appearing ostentatious. Crisp horizontal lines sweep from bow to stern to impart a sleek, elongated feel that underscores her 190-foot length, while expansive glazing not only frames panoramic views but bathes the interiors in natural light, creating a seamless conversation between inside and out. Aft, cascading terraces are visually striking and unique, extending the profile into the sea so the yacht appears to flow into the water itself, and the use of contrasting superstructure colors adds a refined, modern edge without disturbing the harmony of the whole. At home in St. Tropez and equally composed at anchor off a remote island in the Maldives, Project Orca is contemporary, timeless, and effortlessly versatile. Crucially, she is not only about presence but about elevated living at sea. The main deck aft features fold-down bulwarks and a flush 20' x 10' pool, transforming the area into a vast sea-level lounge and conjuring a beach-club

atmosphere without sacrificing precious deck space. Generous deck overhangs and thoughtfully shaded areas ensure true four-season usability; whether sun-drenched or rain-swept, every deck remains a protected and welcoming environment. Step-down aft platforms provide direct access to the water and an amphitheater-like arrangement that is perfect for entertaining or quiet contemplation of the horizon. Across all levels, multiple outdoor lounging and dining zones heighten privacy and deliver unmatched flexibility for both guest enjoyment and crew service. A wide beam and high-volume architecture—approximately 1,000 GT—promise substantial interior space, enabling customizable layouts with generous cabins, a gym, a skylounge, or any configuration the owner desires.

## Project orca

From the very first glance, Project Orca commands attention with clean, angular lines and a contemporary silhouette, her sculpted profile balancing strength and elegance with a quiet confidence that never needs to shout. Horizontal strokes run crisply from bow to stern to create a sleek, elongated stance that emphasizes her 58-meter (190 ft) length, while expanses of glazing draw the outside in, flooding interiors with natural light and establishing an effortless dialogue between sea and sanctuary. Aft, cascading terraces extend the profile into the water, making the yacht appear to flow into the sea itself, and contrasting superstructure colors add a layer of modern sophistication without disturbing the design's harmony. Equally at ease in St. Tropez or anchored off a secluded Maldivian isle, Project Orca is contemporary, timeless, and remarkably versatile. Beyond aesthetics, she is engineered for elevated living at sea: the main deck aft features fold-down bulwarks and a flush 6 x 3 m pool that transforms the area into a vast sea-level lounge, summoning an almost beach-club ambiance without compromising deck space. Generous overhangs and shaded retreats make every deck genuinely usable in all

climates; whether sunlit or rain-washed, each setting remains protected and inviting. Step-down aft platforms offer direct access to the water and an amphitheater-like arrangement—perfect for entertaining, relaxing, or simply appreciating the horizon. Multiple outdoor lounging and dining zones across all levels heighten privacy, variety, and flexibility for both guest experience and crew service. A wide beam and high-volume concept—approximately 1000 GT—unlock substantial interior space for customizable layouts, expansive cabins, a gym, a skylounge, or any configuration the owner envisions.
