She comfortably accommodates up to 12 guests across six generously proportioned staterooms, marrying sumptuous living quarters with a layout ideal for family cruising. A testament to Lurssen's exacting craftsmanship, BELLA VITA features expansive open decks that flow seamlessly into an elegantly finished interior, creating gracious spaces for both entertaining and repose. Thorough refits in 2021 and 2024 have refreshed her systems and finishes, leaving the yacht in pristine, like-new condition. Available in her current boat location, BELLA VITA presents a rare opportunity on the yacht market to acquire a vessel that promises refined luxury and adventurous voyaging.





DETAILED DESCRIPTION

General

This magnificent yacht, crafted by the renowned builder Lürssen, is a testament to luxury and engineering excellence, originally launched in 2010 and meticulously refitted in 2021 to meet the highest expectations of modern yachting; spanning an impressive 60.00 meters (196.86 feet) in length with a beam of 11.43 meters (37.50 feet) and a draft of 3.50 meters (11.50 feet), she combines stability and spaciousness for sublime time on the open seas, while classification under Lloyd's and MCA compliance ensure uncompromising standards of safety and quality. Weighing in at 1,218 gross tons, the yacht presents a harmonious marriage of form and function, with an exterior penned by the acclaimed designer Espen Oeino and naval architecture masterfully executed by Lürssen in Germany, while the interior ambience reflects the sophisticated touch of FM Glade Johnson Design from the USA complemented by the elegant fit-out by Kemble Interiors, also from the USA, resulting in an international collaboration that yields a vessel as beautiful as it is capable and ready to deliver an unparalleled yachting experience.

Capacities

This yacht is engineered to provide an exceptional cruising experience with a refined balance of speed, range and onboard capacity, offering a comfortable cruising speed of approximately 12.04 knots and the ability to reach a maximum speed of around 16.0 knots while delivering an impressive range of about 5,000 nautical miles that enables extended voyages without frequent refuelling; the substantial fuel capacity of approximately 159,200 liters supports long passages with confidence, complemented by a freshwater capacity of 43,200 liters and a watermaker capable of producing 28,000 liters

to ensure continuous fresh water supply during prolonged trips, and a lube oil capacity of 1,000 liters underscores the yacht's readiness for long-distance operation and reliable performance throughout your journey.

Machinery

Power and control systems aboard this yacht have been specified for reliability and refined performance, driven by a robust diesel fuel system and steered by an advanced Rolls Royce electro-hydraulic steering gear featuring rotary vanes with two rudder actuators and electrical synchronization for precise, responsive handling; stability and comfort are enhanced by Quantum Active and Zero Speed stabilizers, supported by three generators—Port Gen with a capacity of 42,265, Stbd Fwd at 39,360 and Stbd Aft at 29,429—while the main engines couple to Reintjes gearboxes with a four to one ratio to optimise power transmission and efficiency, and propulsion is delivered through Piening fixed-pitch propellers, together creating a sophisticated machinery setup that emphasises performance, dependability and passenger comfort.

Accommodation

The yacht's accommodation is conceived as a sanctuary of refined comfort and social elegance, sleeping up to twelve guests in the owner's party across six beautifully appointed staterooms while providing comfortable quarters for up to fifteen crew members in eight cabins; the main salon is a luminous, masterfully designed space dressed in handcrafted woods, contrasting fabrics and expert lighting that together create an expansive and inviting atmosphere ideal for entertaining, with all lighting, window treatments and audiovisual systems seamlessly controlled via iPad-integrated remote controls for ease and sophistication. The owner's suite occupies the full beam of the main deck and is bathed in natural light from six large oval windows that accentuate a

generous seating area and a stately king-sized mattress framed in black beauty anigre, complemented by a Sony 70" LED HD TV for onboard entertainment and a carefully curated lighting design that produces a rich, exotic ambiance; the en suite master bathroom is a private spa featuring a Jacuzzi tub set against dark handcrafted wood and marble flooring, dual vanities and an aromatherapy shower spacious enough for two, all arranged to deliver unparalleled comfort and elegance on every voyage.

Galley & laundry equipment

The galley and laundry installations have been specified to support fine dining and flawless service, with cooking equipment that includes two Rational steam ovens installed in 2016 and a two-burner induction cooktop from the same year, complemented by a Miele microwave oven, a grill and a deep fryer also new in 2016, an overhead exhaust system for a fresh cooking environment, a compactor for efficient waste management and Foster refrigerators to keep provisions in prime condition, while a Miele dishwasher makes cleanup effortless. The laundry area is fitted with top-of-the-line Miele Pro washer and dryer units, including two Miele PW 6055 dryers and Miele 7136 washers, a Miele roller press iron HM 21-140 for crisply pressed linens and clothing, and a stainless steel sink that provides a practical, durable workspace, together ensuring that culinary and housekeeping operations run smoothly and elevate the onboard experience.

Communications, navigation & entertainment equipment

A comprehensive suite of communications, navigation and entertainment equipment keeps the yacht connected, informed and comfortable on every passage, with SATcom by Thrane & Thrane and two Sailor TT-3000 ELRIT Mini-C

units alongside a Cisco BE 6000 telephone system, two Thrane & Thrane Sailor 500 Fleet Broadband units for broadband connectivity, a Raytheon-Thrane & Thrane RT5024/5020 DSC VHF system and an Erikson cellular phone system for voice communications, while intercom and talkback are handled by a Dynacord Pro Matrix DPC 4520 and Phontech CIS 3101, and MF/HF radiotelephony via CU5100 Raytheon-Thrane & Thrane. Entertainment is enhanced by a KVH TracVision HD11 satellite TV system installed in 2016 and a Sailor 9000 VSAT antenna added in 2019. Navigation systems include radar suites such as NSC 25/36 900-025-027 and NSC 450-033-035 chart radar together with Raytheon X Band and S Band radars, two Anschutz (Raytheon) standard 22 gyrocompasses and a Raytheon (Sonde) Cassens & Plath magnetic compass, an Anschutz Nautopilot NP 2015 autopilot and a Furuno FE-800 dual frequency depth display. GPS navigation is managed by a PSC GPS-receiver type R4 and two Saab R4 navigation systems, while BNWAS functions are supplied by Besecke with the beWatch system complete with GPS antennas and receivers, alarm relays and control display units. The ship's IT backbone comprises six Dell computers located in the ship's office, crew mess and control room connected via CAT 6 wired network, the wind and speed log is a Skipper EML 224 with a 10.4" colour display, and an NCR-333 NAVTEX receiver and antenna ensure timely reception of navigational and weather information, together forming a robust, modern and integrated onboard electronics environment.

Security, fire fighting & safety equipment

Safety aboard is comprehensive and professionally specified, with a LAN-based CCTV camera server that includes three fixed cameras for ship's entry surveillance, an Axis-Q6125-LE model installed in 2019 and a pan/tilt camera for deck monitoring, all recorded to a central video storage unit with an impressive twenty-four thousand hour capacity retaining full PAL resolution and frame rate; fire fighting systems comprise three Marioff HiFog systems,

two manually operated call points, an extensive network of twenty-three fire hydrants and fifteen fire hoses with nozzles, emergency escape breathing devices, a portable foam applicator, four sets of breathing apparatus, fire suits, two international shore connections and a total of thirty-five fire extinguishers in foam, CO2 and powder types, with alarms monitored by a Tyco alarm monitoring system to ensure swift response. Safety and survival equipment include two life rings, two life rings with lines, two life rings with lights and two life rings with both light and smoke, a Globalfix Pro GMDSS EPIRB, two McMurdo S4 units, two red rockets, ten handheld devices and two orange smoke signals; life-preserving equipment inventory lists eighty-one adult life jackets plus three oversize and three child-sized jackets, with an additional twenty-eight adult, two oversize and three child-sized jackets. Medical and emergency readiness is supported by three eye wash stations, three medical lockers, a Tempus IC machine, a defibrillator, an oxygen kit, an oxygen machine, two stretchers, a paediatric kit and two crash packs, together delivering a complete protective package that provides peace of mind for every guest and crew member.

Deck equipment

Deck equipment has been specified for robust, safe and efficient operations, with anchoring managed by two Steen vertical windlasses designed for powerful and dependable holding and complemented by aft warping capstans from Steen to facilitate secure mooring and manoeuvring; the yacht carries two Schmitt stockless high holding anchors each weighing 580 kg, connected by a galvanized anchor stud link chain with six shots on both port and starboard sides to ensure durability and strength. Handling of tenders and water toys is catered for with a SOLAS rescue crane on the foredeck manufactured by Hymartec Hydraulics with a capacity of 1000 kg, and a gantry crane in the tender garage on the lower deck composed of two bridle beams

with rollers in stainless steel to allow efficient launch and retrieval of tenders and toys on both port and starboard sides, while a passerelle with Hydro control and Hymartec systems ensures easy and safe embarkation and disembarkation, completing a deck equipment package designed for convenience, safety and seamless maritime operation.
